JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 10-1 TO SOUNDS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp stumbled on Thursday in a 10-1 defeat to the Nashville Sounds. Nashville jumped out to a lead with a four-run third, with three coming on a Keston Hiura home run Lorenzo Ouintana notched an RBI single in the bottom of the third, but that would be the lone tally for Jacksonville in the evening. Hiura homered again, this time a two-run shot in the fifth. He added an RBI single in a four-run ninth for the margin to balloon to 10-1. Parker Bugg tossed 2.0 perfect innings of relief.

WILDFIRES

Late innings have become a sudden issue for the Jumbo Shrimp of late. In the seventh inning-on over five games from April 26-30, Jacksonville yielded just three runs, all earned, on 10 hits (6.9 H/9) in 13.0 frames for a 2.08 ERA. During that span, the club collectively fanned nine batters (6.2 K/9) against just two walks (1.4 BB/9). However, over the last 10 games, in the seventh inning-on, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 28 runs, 26 earned, on 35 hits (11.4 H/9) in 27.2 frames for an 8.46 ERA. The club's hurlers have issued 11 walks (3.6 BB/9) against 30 strikeouts (9.8 K/9) during this run. Consequently, since May 1, Jacksonville has blown five of their eight save opportunities. Positively, the Jumbo Shrimp have managed a 6-4 record during this 10-game stretch, despite losing each of their one-run affairs.

SIX & DIP

Heading into play on Friday, Jacksonville has scored at least six runs in 15 of their last 25 games, and 17 of the club's 33 contests (51.5 percent) this year. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent). When scoring at least six runs this season, Jacksonville is a robust 15-2 (.882).

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville boasts a 12-6 record on the road thus far in 2022, but the club has struggled at home, posting just a 7-8 mark. Interestingly, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit far better on the road, posting a team batting line of .299/.368/.516. The club's resulting .884 OPS places second in Triple-A. When playing at 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville is hitting .232/.329/.375, with the club's .704 OPS ranking 20th at the Trinle-A level

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc has reached base in 17 consecutive games (25-for-66, .379/.431/.545/.976, 5 2B, 2 HR, 13 RBIs, 10 R), the longest such streak in the International League this season. The Laval, Quebic City native has reached base safely in 27 of his 29 games on the year, with multiple trips on in 16 of those contests. On the season, Leblanc ranks second in the International League in batting average (.376), on-base percentage (.444) and OPS (1.059), fourth in hits (41), tied for seventh in RBIs (24), eighth in slugging (.615) and tied for 13th in extra-base hits (14). Among the 126 qualified hitters in the circuit, Leblanc leads the league in both wOBA (.462) and wRC+ (183).

BLEDAY OF THE DEAD

Over the season's first 18 games, Jacksonville outfielder JJ Bleday struggled, going just 10-for-63 at the plate with two doubles and two home runs for a measly batting line of 159/321/286/607 However over the last 13 games Bleday is 14-for-45 with three doubles and four home runs, slashing .311/.456/.644/1.100. Including a nine-game hitting streak from April 28-May 7, Bleday has reached base at least once in 12 of those last 13 contests. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL, Bleday has posted the circuit's highest fly ball rate (58.1 percent), fourth-lowest ground ball rate (28.4 percent) and ninth-lowest line drive rate (13.5 percent).

THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last 17 games. Lorenzo Quintana has gone 24-for-68 at the plate, slashing .353/.421/.721/1.142 with seven doubles, six home runs, 19 RBIs and 16 runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up in the top 20 of the league in OPS (5th; 1.1002), slugging (6th; .622), batting average (8th; .319), home runs (T-9th; 7), extra-base hits (T-10th; 15), RBIs (T-12th; 23), hits (T-13th; 32) and runs (T-18th; 20). Of the 126 qualified hitters in the IL, Quintana has posted the fourth-lowest strikeout rate (12.0%).

SHRIMP SPECKS

The Jumbo Shrimp have mustered just one stolen base in the last 14 games since April 27, the lowest total in MiLB... Bryan Hoeing makes his first home start for Jacksonville in Friday's contest against Nashville

ABOUT BRYAN										

-In high school, Bryan was selected as a 2014 Under Armour All-American and was rated the 131st-best prospect in the nation by Perfect Game in 2015.

-He was ranked as the fourth-best player in the state of Indiana and the third-best righthanded pitcher as a senior in high school.

-Hoeing was named to All-Tournament Teams at 2014 Perfect Game WWBA 17U National Championship and 2013 Perfect Game WWBA 16u National Championship.

2022 SEASON

-Hoeing was transferred to Jacksonville on May 3 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Hoeing was leading the Southern League in both ERA (0.35) and innings pitched (25.2) while ranking second in both batting average against (.211) and WHIP (0.94), tied for fourth in wins (2) and sixth in strikeouts (26).

2021 SEASON

-There, Hoening made 22 appearances (22 GS) going 7-6 with a 4.83 ERA in 121.0 innings, he allowed 65 ER and held opponents to a .267 batting average.

-After posting a 7.91 ERA in May (19.1 IP), 6.12 ERA in June (32.1 IP) and 6.29 ERA in July (24.1 IP), Hoeing closed the season strong. In August, he went 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in four starts (27.0 IP, 16 H, 7 BB, 23 K). In three September starts, the right-hander worked to a 2-0 record and 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 19 H, BB, 11 K).

2019 SEASON

-After being drafted in the seventh round of the MLB draft in 2019, Hoening was sent to the NYPL with the Batavia Muckdogs.

-In nine relief appearances, he tossed 22.1 innings and struck out 17 in his professional debut season

-He tallied his first professional strikeout on 7/18 vs. the Auburn Doubledays

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Originally drafted out of high school by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 32nd round (2015) but elected not to sign.

-Signed with Louisville but also strongly considered UNC, Vanderbilt, Indiana, and Georgia Tech.

-His mom, Donna, is the person whom had the greatest influence on his athletic career. She played basketball at Ball State. Meanwhile, Bryan's cousin, Alex Meyer, plays in the Minnesota Twins' organization.
