NOTES AND NUGGETS

DOUBLE THE TROUBLE

Today, the Storm Chasers play a doubleheader against Indianapolis, Omaha's fourth twin-bill of 2026 and the Indians' third ... it is also the second of this series.

The Chasers split a doubleheader at home with Buffalo on Saturday, April 4 and swept a doubleheader at Iowa on Friday, April 10, before splitting a doubleheader in Indianapolis this Wednesday ... this is Omaha's 6th doubleheader against Indianapolis since 2021 and the 5th played at Victory Field.

This is the Storm Chasers' 4th doubleheader, all coming in the last 35 days, the most doubleheaders Omaha has played within 40 days since 4 doubleheaders were played in a 21-day stretch from May 1 to 21, 2017.

In the Modern Omaha Era (since 2005), Omaha is 105-11 in doubleheader games ... since 2005, this is the 15th time Omaha has played multiple doubleheaders in a 4-day span, the 9th time playing multiple doubleheaders in the same series.

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The Storm Chasers opened the 2026 season 0-4, then won 3 straight series, but Omaha enters this week having lost back-to-back series.

After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville, the Storm Chasers went 12-5 between April 7 and 21, with series wins over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha proceeded to lose 7 straight games, from April 22 to 29 ... since April 22, the Chasers are 3-11, dropping 2 of the first 3 games to the Indians.

Last Thursday's losing-streak snapping win over Louisville gave Omaha a winning month of April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, Omaha had one winning month, going 15-11 in August.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by one of the league's best baserunners.

Omaha's 85.4% stolen base rate (41-for-48) ranks 1st both in the International League and at the Triple-A level and is 12th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams.

John Rave leads Omaha and is tied 13th in the International League in steals (10) ... Gavin Cross has 7 steals, Kameron Misner has swiped 6 bags and Tyler Tolbert has 5 steals ... Misner and Tolbert join Cross as 3 of 5 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught this year.

PITCH, PLEASE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

The Storm Chasers are seeing 4.002 pitches per plate appearance, 5th-most in the International League and 8th at the Triple-A level.

Among 357 Triple-A players with 50+ plate appearances this year, Kameron Misner ranks 15th in pitches seen/PA (4.406) while John Rave ranks 16th (4.404).

VICTORY FIELD SCREECH

The Chasers have seen more success in recent years against Indianapolis than any other International League club, with a 58-34 record in 92 games since 2021 and have especially thrived against the Indians in the Circle City itself.

A .630 winning percentage vs. Indianapolis is Omaha's best among the 7 opponents the Chasers have seen at least 20 times since 2021 ... among 54 International League matchups that have happened at least 20 times since 2021, Omaha's .630 winning percentage against Indianapolis is the 5th-best.

Since 2021, Omaha and Indianapolis have played 16 series, with 10 going 6+ games ... Omaha has won 11 of 17 (including 7 of the last 9), while the Indians have won 3 and there have been 3 series splits.

Since 2023, Omaha has won 22 of 30 games at Victory Field (.733 winning percentage) - the most wins Omaha has at an opposing venue in that timeframe ... the .733 winning % at Victory Field since 2023 is the 4th-highest among 564 road team matchups of 24+ games in the Minor Leagues.

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Storm Chasers are tied for the 8th-best fielding percentage in the International League with a .980 mark (1st: Louisville, .987), committing just 24 errors in 35 games.

The clean play extends throughout the roster - 4 of Omaha's 15 qualified fielders (min. 60.0 inn.) have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, while another 6 of those 15 have committed just 1 error on the season.

Omaha's 36 double plays turned are tied 3rd-most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10 or more double plays, led by Abraham Toro's 24, tied 3rd-most of any Minor League player.

Sanchez has played parts of 8 Major League seasons with Toronto (2014-19), Houston (2019), San Francisco (2021), Washington (2022) and Minnesota (2022) ... he has also played parts of 7 years in Triple-A and Omaha is his 6th Triple-A team.
- ✓ Sanchez has faced Indianapolis three times, twice while with the St. Paul Saints in **2023** and once for the Storm Chasers at Werner Park this April.

THE SANCH FACTOR

- ✓ **ROAD BACK TO THE SHOW:** Sanchez last appeared in the Major Leagues 1,313 days ago on October 4, **2022** with the Minnesota Twins, as he worked 1.2 innings of relief ... he has since pitched 43 games (41 starts) in the Minor Leagues, but has not pitched in the Majors the last 3 years.
- ✓ **EARLY TROUBLE:** Sanchez has largely pitched as a starter in his professional career, with 113 of 174 Major League outings coming as starts as well as 146 of 166 Minor League appearances ... his last relief appearances came with the St. Paul Saints in June and July, **2023**.
