INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians broke up a shutout bid with three round-trippers courtesy of Billy McKinney, Henry Davis and Jose Rojas, but could not overcome an early deficit as their nine-game win streak was snapped by the Toledo Mud Hens on Friday night at Victory Field, 5-4. Toledo opened the game with three runs on six hits between the first and second innings. Spencer Torkelson and Jace Jung traded places with doubles against Mike Burrows in the first. A pair of homers got to Burrows in the second and fourth innings, with Riley Unroe launching his first in a two-run second and Stephen Scott following with a solo shot in the righty's final frame. Indianapolis responded in the fifth with McKinney's third homer of the year before Unroe's second home run of the game led off the sixth. The Indians then scored three unanswered runs courtesy of Davis' two-run blast and Rojas' 20th home run of the season before the comeback attempt fell short. Devin Sweet punched out one hitter and put a damper on the Indians' hope of a comeback with a 1-2-3 ninth inning.

STREAK SNAPPED: The Indians had their nine-game winning streak snapped yesterday with a loss to Toledo. The stretch from July 23-Aug. 1 was the second-longest win streak since they logged a Victory Field era-record 14 consecutive wins from July 28-Aug. 9, 1997. The nine-game win streak is tied with Omaha (May 29-June 6) for the second-longest streak in the International League this season, trailing St. Paul's 11-gamer from June 11-22.

JOSE'S HOMERS: Jose Rojas launched his second eighth-inning home run of the series last night and is now tied for the fifth-most home runs in the International League with 20 this season. Rojas, playing in just his fifth game with the Indians, now ranks fourth among IL qualifiers with a .561 slugging percentage and ninth with a .913 OPS in 72 total Triple-A games. The slugger began the season with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and hit .254 (58-for-228) with 14 doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 57 RBI, a .561 slugging percentage and .920 OPS before being released and signing with Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent. He launched a career-high 31 home runs in 126 games with Triple-A Salt Lake in 2019.

HANK'S HOMER: After having his career-high 11-game hitting streak since July 13 snapped on Thursday night, Henry Davis picked up where he left off with a massive two-run home run in the sixth inning to bring the Indians within two runs. Since his streak began, he is hitting .365 (19-for-52) with 11 runs, three doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .421 on-base percentage and 1.075 OPS. He homered in consecutive games from July 13-14 and then capped his series at lowa with a pinch-hit home run on July 28. He now has 12 total home runs this season between Indy (11) and Pittsburgh (1) after launching a career-high 19 homers between Double-A Altoona (10), Indianapolis (2) and Pittsburgh (7) in 117 total games last season.

BILLY BOMB: Billy McKinney launched his third homer of the season and first since May 2 vs. Buffalo last night to break up Toledo's shutout bid. Since returning to the Indians lineup on July 24 after a lengthy stint on the injured list, he has hit safely in four of five games with a .333 batting average (6-for-18) with five runs, one RBI and four walks. In 38 total games between Indianapolis and High-A Greensboro this season, he is hitting .263 (31-for-118) with 21 runs, six doubles, three homers, 14 RBI and 24 walks.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH: The Indianapolis Indians yesterday named third baseman Malcom Nuñez as their July Player of the Month after he hit safely in 15 of 18 games while leading the team in doubles. The 23-year-old hit .329 (23-for-70) with seven doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .377 OBP and .891 OPS in July. In addition to roping two more doubles than any teammate, he ranked among team leaders in extra-base hits (T-1st), slugging percentage (2nd, .514), OPS (2nd), hits (T-2nd), on-base percentage (3rd), batting average (3rd), total bases (3rd, 36), stolen bases (T-3rd, 3), home runs (T-4th), walks (4th, 6) and runs (T-5th, 11). Nuñez's torrid month was highlighted by a trio of season-high three-hit games and a seven-game hitting streak from July 23-31 that carried into August with a two-hit performance last night. During the seven-game stretch, Nuñez hit .379 (11-for-29) with three extra-base hits, six RBI, a .438 OBP

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their six-game homestand vs. the Toledo Mud Hens, Triple-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, at Victory Field tonight at 7:05 PM. With three victories already, the Indians have clinched at least a series split this week. Continuing the series tonight for Indy is RHP Domingo Germán (6-4, 5.16), who made his Indians debut against the Mud Hens on May 19 (1) and took the loss after allowing six runs (four earned) in 5.0 innings. Countering for the Mud Hens is RHP Austin Berner (0-0, 11.57), who faced Indianapolis twice from April 9-14 and allowed six earned runs over 5.2 innings. In four career starts vs. the Indians, he is 0-1 with 14 earned runs allowed in 12.1 innings.

GERMÁN'S GOT SIX: Domingo Germán extended his winning streak to six games since June 18 with arguably his best start in an Indianapolis Indians uniform last Sunday to defeat lowa. He allowed just one run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.2 innings, throwing 49 of his 72 pitches for strikes. Germán has now tossed at least 5.0 innings in 10 of 12 starts with Indianapolis since making his Indians debut on May 19 (1) vs. Toledo after being signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent. During his winning streak, he has a 3.96 ERA (16er/36.1ip) and 36 strikeouts with two-or-less runs allowed in five of those seven starts.

THIS DATE IN 2018: With a 3-1 lead through four innings at Toledo, Wyatt Mathisen launched his first career grand slam to plate insurance runs for the Indians in the fifth in an eventual 12-7 win over their International League West rival. The blast proved useful, too, as the Indians surrendered five runs in the bottom half of the inning but still held a lead. Pablo Reyes also contributed to the offense, notching his second four-hit game of the season and seventh of his career, Reves and Mathisen combined for six RBI and five runs scored.

Domingo Germán: Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his eighth home start of the year against Toledo, this evening at 7:05 PM ET at Victory Field.

Last Outing: Germán toed the rubber against lowa on 7/28 for the fifth time this season as he punched out five batters across 5.2 innings while picking up his sixth win.

Against the Mud Hens: Germán made one start vs. Toledo on 5/19. He's pitched 5.2 innings with 3 strikeouts while allowing 6 runs (4 earned).

Historic Germán: Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on 6/28 at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on 8/2 and missed the remainder of the season.

Miscellaneous: Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
