Toledo Mud Hens LHP Nick Margevicius (NR) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Brian Van Belle (0-0, 1.26)

Even Better – The Worcester Red Sox – who have won back-to-back games the past two nights to even this 6-game series with the Toledo Mud Hens at two victories apiece – try to build on their 6-5 mark during this 13-game homestand and their 16-14 record overall on the season when they play game number 5 of the series today at 4:05 pm at Polar Park. Toledo (AAA-Detroit) won the first two games of the series, 4-2 and 2-1 to extend their winning streak to 8 games, but the WooSox have won the past two nights to end their 5-game losing streak, 7-4 and 5-2. The Sox look to gain the upper hand this afternoon in a game that can be seen live on NESN+ and heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. The clubs will close out their series and this long Polar Park homestand tomorrow at 1:05 pm.

Could We Finally Have a Saturday in the (Polar) Park? – The WooSox have had each of their first three scheduled Saturday home games at Polar Park either postponed or cancelled due to inclement weather. The WooSox had their first Saturday home game on March 29th vs. Syracuse postponed due to rain, their second scheduled Saturday game at Polar Park vs. Columbus on April 12 cancelled due to four inches of snow, and then this past Saturday, April 26 due to rain. Thankfully, we hope to enjoy Derby Day today on the first Saturday in May, so we are praying that the Weather Gods are kinder this month. Stay tuned!

This Homestand – Worcester is now 6-5 on this season-high 13-game homestand that began with 4 straight victories over Syracuse, was followed by 5 straight losses (3 to Syracuse and 2 to Toledo), before consecutive WooSox victories the past two nights. As a result, Worcester is now 9-9 here at home compared to 7-5 on the road.

From High Five to Low Five – Worcester has had two season-high 5-game winning streaks from April 13-18 and again from April 20-24. Their season-high 5-game losing streak from April 25-30 was their longest since a 2024 season-long 6-game losing streak last May 22-28. Over a longer stretch, the WooSox have won 12 of their last 18 games since April 13.

Below and Above – The WooSox were a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) on April 11 and turned things around quickly to reach a season-high of 5-games above .500 on April 24 (14-9). They are now 2-games over the .500 mark at 16-14.

Holy Toledo! - Toledo and Worcester have played 28 times since first meeting on May 3, 2022 and the Mud Hens have won 17 of those 28 games including a 9-7 record here at Polar Park and an 8-4 record at Fifth Third Field in Ohio.

Rank and File – Worcester ranks 2nd in the 20-team International League in a host of offensive categories including batting average (.271), runs scored (172) – they led the league in runs last season with 869 – hits (267), and OBP (.360). They are 1st in doubles (67), total bases (433), and OPS (.803), and they are 3rd in slugging pct. (.443). The Sox are tied for 7th in HR (31). Not to be forgotten, Worcester pitchers are tied with Scranton/WB for the league-lead with 5 shutouts while their 4.42 ERA is 10th in the IL. The WooSox staff did not earn their 5th shutout victory last season until July 6th which was their 86th game.

What Have You Done for Me Lately – Some recent WooSox standouts (in alphabetical order). Batters...OF **Roman Anthony** had his streak of reaching base safely in 17 games in a row (since April 6) end on Wednesday after going 0-for-4, but has now reached in 19 of his last 20 games. Among those 19 games on base he has had 16 games with at least one hit and the other 3 games with at least one walk. He has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 games (10-for-30, .333) with 2 2B, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 6 BB, and 8 runs scored. INF **Alex Binelas** has hit in 4 of his last 5 games (5-for-14) with 1 2B, 2 RBI, and 6 runs scored. OF **Nate Eaton** has hit in 13 of his last 14 games (17-for-52, .327) with 6 2B, 2 HR, 10 RBI, and 11 runs scored. INF **Vaughn Grissom** has hit in 4 of his last 5 games (6-for-22) with 2 RBI and 4 runs scored. 1B **Nathan Hickey** has hit in 10 of his last 13 games (17-for-52, .327) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, and 8 runs scored. INF **Marcelo Mayer** has hit in 9 of his last 12 games (16-for-46, .348) with 4 2B, 5 HR, 24 RBI, and 9 runs scored. He leads all of professional baseball with 34 RBI on the season and is tied for 2nd in the league with 7 HR. Injured OF **Tyler McDonough** has hit in 3 games in a row (7-for-12) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 3 RBI. OF **Corey Rosier** has hit in 7 straight (11-for-23, .478) with 1 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, and 8 runs scored. INF **Nick Sogard** has hit in 6 of his last 7 games (9-for-25, .360) with 4 2B, 3 RBI, 6 runs scored. And INF **Abraham Toro** has hit safely in 12 of his last 16 games at a .322 clip (19-for-59) with 4 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 9 RBI, and 11 runs scored. Pitchers...Reliever **Nick Burdi** has allowed just 1 run in his 11 relief appearances on the season (14.2 IP) going 2-0 with 2 SV with just 3 BB with 22 SO. Starters RHP **Cooper Criswell** has given up just 2 ER in his 17 IP (4 games) and LHP **Shane Drohan** has allowed just 5 ER in his 23.2 IP on only 14 hits with 35 SO in his 6 games.

Take Home a Dozen or More – This current 13-game homestand (WooSox are 6-5 thus far) is the longest in terms of games for Worcester this season. The WooSox do have another double figure homestand from July 29 – August 10 that will be 12-games including six vs. Lehigh Valley and six vs. Buffalo. Worcester has played seven extended homestands of 12 games or more - featuring two series each - during their first four years of existence. They have had four winners and three losers during their seven “long” homestands in WooSox history (the first two of which included Syracuse)...

Home Run Derby – The WooSox have maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 20 of their total 31 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted 11 solo HR, thirteen 2-run homers, four 3-run blasts & three grand slams.

April History - The WooSox finished 13-13 in April – a month that also included one cold-out, two snow-outs, and one rain-out among three postponements and one cancellation. In their history, Worcester has gone 12-11 in April of 2022, 11-14 in April of 2023, and 10-14 in April of 2024 before posting a 13-13 mark this April. The 2021 WooSox did not play in April as they began their inaugural season on May 4, 2021. Worcester went 14-14 last May. They are scheduled to play 27 games in the 31 days this May and are 2-0 this month.

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was next with 846 runs scored). The Sox also led the IL with 786 walks (Toledo was a distant 2nd with 676 walks). Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359 (Scranton/WB was 2nd at .358). Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795 (Columbus was 1st at .804).

2024 Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league (141 HRA while Nashville had 139 HRA). Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players).

Sea Dog to Woofsters – A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (14-8) lost at New Hampshire last night, 8-2. Blake Wehunt (0-3) was the starter and loser – 4.1 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 4 SO. Blaze Jordan drilled a 2-run HR (#1) in the top of the 9th-inning to avert the shutout.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES –The Red Sox today selected INF **Abraham Toro** from Worcester to take the place of the injured Triston Casas. Also today, the WooSox added catcher **Blake Sabol** who was optioned from Boston on Friday when the Red Sox recalled catcher Connor Wong from his injury rehab assignment with Worcester.

Toro is batting .310 with 7 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR, 13 RBI in 28 games for the WooSox this season. He has played 18 games at 3B, 5 at 1B, 3 at 2B, and 3 as the DH. Toro, 28, appeared in 94 games for the Athletics in 2024, batting .240 with 17 doubles and 6 HR while making 49 starts at 3B, 17 at 2B, 11 as the DH, 4 at 1B, and 1 in LF. The switch-hitter has played in 365 Major League games with Houston (2019-21), Seattle (2021-22), Milwaukee (2023), and the Athletics (2024). Originally selected by the Astros in the 5th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, the Quebec native played for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. Abraham, who speaks fluent French, English, and Spanish, signed with Boston as a Minor League free agent in January, 2025.

Sabol, 27, played eight games for Boston, starting four at catcher and going 2-for-16 with a double and an RBI. The left-handed hitter has also played six games for Worcester this season, batting .250 (5-for-20) with two doubles and four RBI. Originally selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the seventh round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft, the California native has played in 129 career games with the San Francisco Giants (2023-24) and Red Sox (2025), batting .237 (85-for-358) with 13 home runs and 46 RBI.

Since the start of the season (5 weeks) the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (three times), RHP Robert Stock, C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, NF Nick Sogard, RHP Luis Guerrero, RHP Cooper Criswell, and INF Abraham Toro to Boston; although Stock, Sogard, Dobbins, Winckowski, Criswell, and Sabol are all back with Worcester. The Red Sox also recalled rehabbers RHP Lucas Giolito & C Connor Wong from Worcester. Furthermore, Fulmer elected to become a free agent and signed with the Cubs following his outright assignment, RHP Quinn Priester was traded, and OF Corey Rosier and C Enderso Lira were sent to Double-A Portland (although Rosier and Lira have rejoined the WooSox).
