LUG-NOTES

It Takes Two: Because of Friday's postponement due to hazardous air quality, today marks the culmination of the Lugnuts' second two-game series of the season. Way back in April, Lansing and Dayton were postponed in the scheduled finale of their three-game season-opening series, shortening the set to two games and forcing the game to be made up as part of a seven-game, six-day series later in the month. Similarly, the Lugnuts and TinCaps will make up Friday's scheduled game as part of a doubleheader on September 2; the scheduled LAFCU Fireworks show will now be held on September 4; and the scheduled Jacob Wilson Bobblehead Giveaway will now be held on September 5, Fan Appreciation Night.

Welcome to the Show x2: On Friday, 2025 Lugnuts Tommy White and Yuniur Tur made their Major League Baseball debuts, with White going 1-for-4 with a double and Tur allowing six runs in two innings of relief. Four 2025 Lugnuts in all took part in the game: White, Tur, starting pitcher Gage Jump and third baseman Joshua Kuroda-Grauer. Other notables...

- This is the second time in franchise history that four players have vaulted from the Lugnuts to MLB in one season, joining 2023.
- There are 12 former Nuts on the Athletics' active roster: pitchers Jump, Tur, Brady Basso, Hogan Harris and Jack Perkins; infielders Kuroda-Grauer, White and Jacob Wilson; and outfielders Henry Bolte, Lawrence Butler, Tyler Soderstrom and Colby Thomas.
- With White's and Tur's arrival, nine former Lugnuts have made their MLB debut this season and 209 have achieved the feat all-time.

Welcome to the Lugnuts: Since the last time the Nuts were at home, the ballclub added a bunch of newcomers: pitcher Ben Hansen, catchers Bryan Arendt and Logan Sauve, infielder Daniel Bucciero and outfielder Jake Reinisch. The Lugnuts have used 46 total players this season (24 pitchers, 22 position players), bringing the total to 1,006 all-time Nuts in 30 years of Lansing baseball.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 14 (Steven Echavarria), No. 16 (Zane Taylor), No. 28 (Nathan Dettmer) and No. 30 (Daniel Bucciero). Baseball America's re-ranking of A's prospects placed Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and Nathan Dettmer at No. 21.

Lugnut All-Stars: In the 2026 Major League All-Star Game, 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. was voted to start at first base for the A.L., but took the game off; 2019 Nut Otto López (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve) went 1-for-2 with a single and a strikeout; and 2022 Nut Mason Miller (San Diego Padres closer) struck out the only batter he faced, the White Sox' Munetaka Murakami.

Lugnut League Leaders:

- Zane Taylor leads the MWL in ERA (3.22), ranks 3rd in innings (81), 2nd in WHIP (1.21) and 3rd in opponent avg. (.234).
- Samuel Dutton is 4th in the league in innings (80 1/3) and 4th in ERA (4.71).
- Steven Echavarria is 6th in innings (75 1/3), 3rd in lowest average (.235), 5th in WHIP (1.39) and tied for 2nd in starts (16).

Booster Club Player of the Month, presented by Sofi: Before today's game, the Lugnuts Booster Club honored pitcher Jorge Marcheco as the June Lugnuts Player of the Month. Marcheco did not allow a run in June, amid a scoreless streak that saw him go from May 23-June 30 without surrendering a run. Marcheco enters tonight with a 2.05 ERA, allowing just five runs in 22 innings.

Cooperstown Bound: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, Carlos Beltrán went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

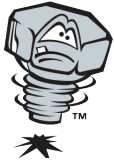

JULY 19 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: A pair of unusual coaching ejections occurred as the Lugnuts were swept in a doubleheader at Beloit, 2-1 and 7-1. In Game 1, hitting coach / 1st base coach Kenny Graham was thumbed out in the seventh inning following Shane Opitz getting picked off. In Game 2, it was pitching coach Vince Horsman who was ejected in the sixth inning.

2017: Oh, this wasn't fun. Ronnie Dawson homered twice in a nine-run second inning, Josh Rojas also homered twice, and the Quad Cities River Bandits opened up a three-game home series by steamrolling the Lugnuts, 20-3, at Modern Woodmen Park. The Bandits led 15-0 after the third inning and 18-0 after the fifth. The game set Lansing's franchise record with a 17-run margin of defeat and tied franchise records with 20 runs allowed and six home runs allowed. Rodrigo Orozco singled, walked and doubled before getting robbed by first baseman Troy Seiber on a line drive down the line, ending a streak of eight straight plate appearances reaching base.
