### GONE FISHING

Today marks the 7th of 12 First Half matchups between the Shuckers and Blue Wahoos... The Shuckers opened the home slate with a series against the Blue Wahoos from April 7-12... The Shuckers won 4 of 6 in the series, outscoring the Blue Wahoos 42-22 (+20).

- During the opening series, the Shuckers recorded 24 stolen bases in 6 games against the Blue Wahoos, an average of 4.0 per game.
- Standouts in the season series include **1B BLAKE BURKE** (8-for-25, 3 HR, 2B), **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** (9-for-24, 2B, 2 3B) and **2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE** (7-for-19, 3B).

### BURKE'S MAKING HISTORY

With a triple on Sunday, **1B BLAKE BURKE** enters today as the Southern League leader in home runs (7) and extra-base hits (15)... The triple marked the 3rd of his career and his 1st at the Double-A level.

- Burke needs 1 stolen base over the final 3 games of April to become the 3rd Double-A player since 2005 with at least 7 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs and 10 stolen bases in a month.
- Burke would become the first Shucker to reach the mark since **OF COREY RAY** in July, 2018... Only 5 Shuckers have achieved the feat over a full season over the last 2 years.

### RUNNING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

**2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE** set the Shuckers single-game record (since 2015) with 5 stolen bases on Wednesday against the Trash Pandas... O'Rae broke the previous record of 4 which was set and tied 7 different times.

- O'Rae needs 5 stolen bases over the final 3 games of April to become the 3rd Southern League player since 2005 with 20+ stolen bases in a month... O'Rae would join **OF BILLY HAMILTON** (PNS, Aug. 2012, 37) and **OF CHANDLER SIMPSON** (MTG, Aug. 2024, 25).

### RUNNING DOWN A DREAM

The Shuckers enter today with 62 stolen bases, the most by a Double-A team and the 10th-most by a team in Minor League Baseball through 21 games since 2005... The Shuckers have recorded 5+ stolen bases in 7 of 21 games... The Shuckers are on pace for 407 stolen bases... The Southern League stolen base record is 264 set by the 1989 Birmingham Barons... The Minor League record is 363, set by the Aberdeen IronBirds (BAL, A+), in 2024.

### THE ARM BARN IS SLINGING IT

The Shuckers bullpen enters today with a 3.82 ERA, the 2nd-lowest mark in the Southern League and the 4th-lowest in Double-A... The bullpen has also limited batters to a .193 average (T-2nd, Double-A) with a 25% strikeout rate.

- Last series, the Shuckers bullpen held a 3.16 ERA (11r, 31.1ip), the lowest mark in the Southern League.

### ALL ABOUT THE STREAKS

**1B BLAKE BURKE** (21g) and **2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE** (20g) enter today with the 2 longest on-base streaks in Double-A this season... Both players have reached base in every game played this season.

- Burke's streak, a career-high, is the first 20-game streak by a Shuckers player since **1B LUKE ADAMS** reached base in a franchise-record 39 consecutive games between April 29 and June 19, 2025.
- The pair are the first Shuckers teammates to record 20+ game streaks in the same season since 2024, when **OF ADAM HALL** (21g) and **OF CARLOS RODRIGUEZ** (21g) reached the mark.

### BREAKING THE CENTURY MARK

On Wednesday, the Shuckers set the franchise record for the fastest team to reach 100 runs, needing 17 games to reach the mark... This season, the Shuckers have set a franchise record for the fastest team to reach 20 home runs (14g), 50 stolen bases (17g) and 100 walks (14g).

- The Shuckers 129 runs are the most through 21 games in franchise history (since 2015) and the 6th-most by a Southern League team in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005).

### I'M JUST A KID AND I MAKE PITCHERS LIVES A NIGHTMARE

Despite being the youngest player in Double-A, **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** is among the Southern League leaders in hits (T-1st, 26), triples (T-1st, 3), stolen bases (3rd, 11), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 10), walks (T-7th, 15), average (8th, .295) and OPS (10th, .887)... Made will turn 19 on May 9.

### MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

**SS/2B JESÚS MADE** enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

- Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (80 AB), Kevin McGonigle (106 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (105 AB) all reach 130 AB.

### BACK IN THE SADDLE

**MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO** is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 44 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,456 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

**RHP BISHOP LETSON** (0-3, 10.24) makes his 5th start of the season and his 2nd against the Blue Wahoos... Last time out, Letson went a season-high 4.0 innings and 66 pitches.
