LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox were shutout by the Richmond Flying Squirrels 2-0 on Saturday night. Bowie outhit Richmond eight to four but went 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position and stranded nine on base. Richmond scored its lone runs of the game on a two-run homer from Blake Sabol off starting right-hander Cameron Weston. Weston threw four innings and struck out three in his first Double-A start. Ryan Long followed and threw five shutout frames with five strikeouts in relief.

Today, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay

STRUGGLES IN MAY

After batting a league-best .256 in the month of April, Bowie has batted a leagueworst .202 in the month of May. Bowie scored the most runs in the league in the month of April (118) but have scored the second-fewest runs (81) in the month of May. Against the Flying Squirrels this season, Bowie is batting just .178.

BASALLO BLASTS

C Samuel Basallo blasted his second homer of the series on Friday with a 392 foot, 115 mph three-run laser over the right field wall in the third inning. The Orioles No. 2 prospect has now homered four times against Richmond this season, which leads the team. In his last five games, the 19-year-old is batting .333 (6-for-18) with two homers, five RBI and a double. Against Richmond this year, Basallo is batting .333 (12-for-36).

TOP OF THE LEADERBOARD

OF Jud Fabian has six homers in the month of the May, which is tied for the leaguelead with Harrisburg's Brady House. The Orioles No. 12 prospect's 15 RBI this month is tied for the second in the league....1B TT Bowens is tied for fifth in the Eastern League in RBI with 27.... C Samuel Basallo has 41 hits on the season, good for sixth best in the circuit.

BRIGHT AND EARLY

RHP Trace Bright makes his ninth start of the season and his third against Richmond. The Orioles No. 16 prospect threw four innings and allowed four runs on five hits across two walks and six strikeouts in the series opener on Tuesday in a no decision. After recording a 2.41 ERA in April, Bright has posted a 4.15 ERA in the month of May. Against the Squirrels this season, the 23-year-old has a 5.00 ERA over 9.0 innings thrown.

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

Entering this week, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are fifth in the Southwest Division at 17-22 but most recently took five of six against Reading at home. The Double-A affiliate of the Giants took four of six against Bowie in the first meeting of the season at The Diamond. Seven of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster-RHP Havden Birdsong (No. 6), OF Grant McCray (OF), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26), and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Ryan Murphy makes his 10th start of the season for the Squirrels and his third against the Baysox. The 24-year-old gave up three runs on five hits over 3.2 innings pitched in Tuesday's series opener but did strike out six in a no decision. In two starts against the Baysox this season, Murphy has a 4.15 ERA over 8.2 innings thrown. The Poughkeepsie, NY native was drafted in the 5th round of the 2020 Draft by the Giants out of Le Moyne College, which at the time was a Division II baseball school.



Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Curveball (best secondary), Slider, Changeup Ranked the Orioles No. 16 prospect, via MLB Pipeline Has struck out six or more batters in five of eight starts

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster. Delivered 4.0 innings and gave up four runs on five hits over two walks and six strikeouts on Tue. 5/21 vs RIC in no decision. Has punched out six or more batters in five of eight starts. Owns a 5.00 ERA over 9.0 innings in two starts vs RIC this season. Looking to pitch five innings for first time in four starts. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26 at Erie. Struck out five over four scoreless innings on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet activation Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yamouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fun damentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
