JACKSONVILLE'S COMEBACK FALLS SHORT

Down to their last out, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp left runners on first and second in their 5-4 loss to the Gwinnett Stripers Friday night at Coolray Field. Gwinnett came out on fire in the bottom of the first, plating four runs. Jacksonville cut the deficit in half with two runs in the top of the second. The Jumbo Shrimp got four consecutive hits from **Jake Mangum**, **CJ Hinojosa**, **Xavier Edwards**, and **Jazz Chisholm Jr.** to make the game 4-2. Jacksonville added one run in the top of the fourth but Gwinnett was able to add an insurance run in the sixth. The Jumbo Shrimp were able to get two runners on in the top of the ninth with two outs but they stranded the tying and go-ahead run on first and second.

GONE FISHIN'

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are an extraordinary 27-14 (.659) against the Gwinnett Stripers. Perhaps most dominantly, in 2022, the clubs matched up 23 times, with Jacksonville winning 17 of those contests (.739). Since 2021, Jacksonville has outscored Gwinnett 195 to 174 or an average of 4.7 to 4.2 runs per game. In four different series last year, the Jumbo Shrimp had a clean sweep, going 4-0 against the Stripers. Since 2021, Jacksonville has lost only one series to Gwinnett (9/29 - 10/3).

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, **Brian Miller** had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 25 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 28-for-87 (.322/.388/.437/.825) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 12 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 10.6 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.5 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 25 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 30 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 30 home runs are tied for 19th-most in Triple-A over the last 25 games.

YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 31-41 record is 20th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-three of the club's 72 games, or 73.6 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league with Gwinnett sitting second with 48 games against teams with a winning record. Jacksonville is 23-30 (.434) against teams who have posted a record of at least .500.

APRIL SHOWERS HAVEN'T BROUGHT FLOWERS

Jacksonville finds themselves in the cellar of the International League. After finishing the first month of the season with a 13-12 record, the Jumbo Shrimp haven't found a spark, going 18-29 since May 1. The club posted the sixth-best ERA through the first month of the season at 4.47 in 227.1 innings. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 249 earned runs in 393.0 innings for a 5.70 ERA that ranks tied for 16th in the IL. Through those 47 games, opponents have posted a .270 batting average against Jacksonville pitching which ranks as the fourth-highest batting average against in the league. Through 72 games in 2022, Jacksonville owned a 38-34 record with a posted 4.49 ERA.

FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 12 of their last 16 games, going 7-9 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 86 to 79 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June, Jacksonville has won five of their last 10. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville snapped a four-series losing streak by splitting their series last week with Nashville. After falling in the final two contests last weekend against Memphis, Jacksonville has split their last two series and have now gone without a series win for over one month (May 2-7). The Jumbo Shrimp need wins today and tomorrow to split their series with Gwinnett to avoid going two months without a series win... **Jeff Lindgren** looks to win his third-straight start today.

ABOUT JEFF

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2023, he has already totaled 45 minor league starts in 63 career games.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

2023 SEASON

- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 5-11.
 -Threw seven-inning complete game with one-run allowed on two hits with five strikeouts.

2022 SEASON

-Lindgren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoos between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lindgren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
