- Behind nine-strikeouts from Juaron Watts-Brown and five hitless innings from the bullpen, Dunedin defeated Jupiter 5-0 on Wednesday night at TD Ballpark.
- Yhoangel Aponte put the Jays ahead with a three-run homer in the third part of a 4-4 day for the outfielder.
- Watts-Brown worked through the first three innings with relative ease, but ran into trouble in the fourth, loading the bases with one out. The righty buckled down for back-to-back punch outs to finish his outing.
- Edward Duran scored on a wild pitch in the sixth to make it 4-0, and Jean Joseph pushed the lead to 5-0 with an eighth inning sac fly.
- The win is the Blue Jays first of the season against Jupiter, after the Hammerheads took the first seven games of the season series.

YOU GET NOTHING!

The Blue Jays pitching staff collected its second shutout victory of the season last night, using 14 strikeouts - one shy of a season high. Two hits allowed by the Jays ties a season low.

BRAVO. BULLPEN

Entering last night's game with a 7.44 ERA across the last nine games, the Blue Jays' bullpen turned in a strong effort, as Yondrei Rojas (2 innings), Irv Carter (1), and Eliander Alcalde (2) nailed down the shutout with five no-hit innings. The shutout effort marked the first time in five games the bullpen did not surrender a run.

HITS ON HITS ON HITS

Dunedin bats racked up 12 hits for the second straight game last night, marking the third consecutive contest the Blue Jays have compiled double digit hits. The streak is the first of its kind for Dunedin this season. Across the last 10 games, the Blue Jays are hitting .244 as a team across the last 10 games after hitting .163 in the prior 10 games.

STAYING UP LATE

Dunedin continued its trend of scoring late runs last night with an eighth inning sac fly. The Blue Jays have scored in the seventh inning or later in 12 of their last 13 games. The Blue Jays hold a +10 run differential in the final three innings this season (59 runs scored, 49 runs allowed).

GOOD THINGS COME IN FOURS

Blue Jays No. 25 prospect Yhoangel Aponte went 4-4 last night, boosting his batting average from .205 to .233 in one night. The four hit game is Aponte's second this year. He is the only D-Jay to have collected a four hit game this year.

STRONG FIRST IMPRESSION

Blue Jays outfielder Jean Joseph is off to a strong start in Single-A, having reached in all 15 games he's played with Dunedin. The on-base streak is Dunedin's longest streak of the season and one of five active on base streaks 15 games or longer in the league. Joseph has batted leadoff in each of the last six games.

FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

Blue Jays slugger Cristian Feliz collected three hits Tuesday night - marking his first three-hit outing of the season. The big night extends a hot start to May, as Feliz is batting .267 with a .896 OPS. The 6-foot, 4-inch first baseman has ripped six homers this season, good for the team lead and second in the Florida State League.

TRACK MEET

After the Hammerheads stole seven bases in Tuesday night's game - the most allowed by Dunedin in a single game this season-thee Jays only allowed one last night. In eight games against the Blue Jays, Jupiter has stolen 30 bases on 40 tries (74%). On the other side of the scorebook, Dunedin hasn't stolen a base in two games this week.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

23 of the Blue Jays 35 games this season have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 8-15 record in those games, including Tuesday night's loss.
