The contest began with Henry Davis' first Triple-A homer of the year to put Indy up 1-0. Both teams traded two runs in the third inning before Gorski doubled home Gilberto Celestino from first base with a hard-hit liner into the left-field corner. The Mud Hens then scored one in the top of the fifth and one in the seventh to send the game to extra innings. After Toledo plated four runs in the top of the ninth inning to break a 4-4 tie, Matt Gorski launched a 451-foot homer run out onto the concourse in left field — the second of two Indians homers in the game — to spark a comeback attempt that fell short.
