INDY BITS

ABOUT GAME 1: The Mud Hens emerged victorious in Game 1 behind a four-run ninth inning in the doubleheader opener on Thursday at Victory Field, 8-6. The contest began with Henry Davis' first Triple-A homer of the year to put Indy up 1-0. Both teams traded two runs in the third inning before Gorski doubled home Gilberto Celestino from first base with a hard-hit liner into the left-field corner. The Mud Hens then scored one in the top of the fifth and one in the seventh to send the game to extra innings. After Toledo plated four runs in the top of the ninth inning to break a 4-4 tie, Matt Gorski launched a 451-foot home run out onto the concourse in left field – the second of two Indians homers in the game – to spark a comeback attempt that fell short. With two outs and runners at the corners, Jake Lamb then sent a long fly ball out to right-center field to end the game.

ABOUT GAME 2: Liover Peguero and Malcom Nuñez each homered as the Indianapolis Indians defeated Toledo in the nightcap of a doubleheader on Thursday afternoon at Victory Field, 5-3. Seven of eight total runs in Game 2 came via the long ball. With a 1-0 lead, Peguero brought home three runs on his second homer of the season in the fourth inning. The Indians then erased a solo home run by Parker Meadows in the bottom of the sixth on a homer by Malcom Nuñez. Former Indianapolis outfielder Bligh Madris then launched a two-run shot in the seventh inning to cap the scoring.

ABOUT THE HOME RUNS: Both games of yesterday's doubleheader featured a pair of home runs by the Indians offense, marking the second and third times this season they have hit multiple home runs in a game at Victory Field and the first since April 6 (2) vs. Memphis. It was also the first time the Indians have hit multiple homers in back-to-back home games since July 22-23, 2023, vs. St. Paul.

HANK'S TANK: Henry Davis led the Indians offense for the day yesterday, going 3-for-4 with two runs, a double, homer and two RBI in the doubleheader opener. He opened the contest with his first home run of the season between Indianapolis and Pittsburgh, giving Indy a 1-0 lead in the first inning and extending his on-base streak to seven games since joining the Indians last week in Louisville. He then did not reach base safely in three at-bats in Game 2. In eight games with Indianapolis this season, he is hitting .231 (6-for-26) with a .429 on-base percentage and .814 OPS.

THE LONGEST BALL: To cap the scoring for Indianapolis in Game 1 yesterday, Matt Gorski launched the longest home run by an Indians batter this season with a 451-foot bomb out onto the left-field concourse. It was the third-longest home run by an Indian since distance started being officially tracked in 2021, trailing Joshua Palacios' walk-off home run on July 26, 2023, vs. Louisville (466 FT) and a home run by Canaan Smith-Njigba on Sept. 20, 2023, vs. Rochester (456 FT). Gorski's long ball also is the eighth-longest home run hit in the International League this season, the longest coming courtesy of Buffalo's Orelvis Martinez (469 FT).

JAKE ON BASE: The International League's leading hitter Jake Lamb extended his current on-base streak to 18 games since April 18 with hits in both games of yesterday's doubleheader. During that streak – which is the second-longest by an Indian this season (trailing Nick Gonzales, 21 games) and the longest active team streak – he is hitting .383 (23-for-60) with 11 runs, eight doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, .461 on-base percentage and 1.028 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 29 of 30 games this season and leads the International League in batting average (.364, 36-for-99) while also ranking fourth in on-base percentage (.455) and ninth in OPS (1.000).

MALCOM ON BASE: Malcom Nuñez extended his on-base streak to 14 games with a walk in Game 1 and two hits – including a solo homer run – in Game 2 yesterday. He launched his fourth home run of the 2024 season in the sixth inning of yesterday's nightcap, erasing a solo homer hit by the Mud Hens in the top half of the frame. In those 14 games since April 24 at Omaha, he owns a .275 batting average (14-for-51) with three runs, two extra-base hits, seven RBI and six walks. His on-base streak is the fourth-longest by an Indians batter this season and trails only Jake Lamb (18) as the second-longest active streak.

BAE ON BASE: Ji Hwan Bae joins Jake Lamb on the International League leaderboards, pacing the pack with a .461 on-base percentage across 23 games this season. In total, he is hitting .337 (28-for-83) with 20 runs, six extra-base hits, 11 RBI, 18 walks and six strikeouts, while also ranking among league leaders in batting average (7th, .337).

TODAY: The Indians and Mud Hens will face off in the third contest of the six-game series and begin a weekend of four games in three days today at 7:05 PM at Victory Field. Toledo took five of six games in their first meeting at Fifth Third Field from April 9-14, after the Indians won the season series a year ago, 14-4. Taking the mound tonight in his first start as an Indian is RHP Daulton Jefferies (0-0, ---), who made four appearances (two starts) with Triple-A Sacramento earlier this season and went 1-0 with a 3.44 ERA (7er/18.1ip) in the Pacific Coast League. Countering for the Mud Hens will be LHP Bryan Sammons (4-2, 3.74), who has pitched at Victory Field three times since 2021 with a 0-2 record, 11.32 ERA (13er/10.1ip) and 13 strikeouts.

JEFFERIES JOINS THE CLUB: After being traded from San Francisco to Pittsburgh on May 10 in exchange for minor league outfielder Rodolfo Nolasco, Daulton Jefferies will make his Pirates-organization debut today against Toledo. The right-hander was originally selected by Oakland in the first round (37th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft and made his MLB debut on Sept. 12, 2020 (1) with the A's at Texas. He has made six appearances (three starts) between San Francisco and Triple-A Sacramento this season, logging a 3.44 ERA (7er/18.1ip) and 17 strikeouts in four Triple-A games (two starts).

THIS DATE IN 1946: Paul "Duke" Derringer tossed a four-hit shutout vs. Kansas City as Indianapolis earned a 7-0 win in seven innings. He also led the offense with two singles and two RBI. Derringer's 15-year major league career ended in 1945 as a 223-game winner with the Cardinals, Reds and Cubs.
