LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn captured Tuesday night's series opener, 9-2, over Aberdeen...The Cyclones erupted for seven runs in the bottom of the first inning, send ing 11 batters to the plate...The seven runs were the most for Brooklyn in the first inning since the Minor League stat portal began in 2005...The 'Clones started the game with five straight base hits and six consecutive batters reaching safely...CF lyn batters reached base at least once 2B Wilfredo Lara, 1B Ryan Clifford and 3B Nick Lorusso all picked up two hits and reached base three times...Lorusso added a double, a triple, and a season-high-tying three RBI...RHP Douglas Orellana tossed 4.1 scoreless innings in a no-decision, while RHP Jordany Ventura went 3.2 innings of spotless relief to earn his second victory.

COUNTDOWN TO 1K: After Tuesday's 9-2 win over Aberdeen, the Brooklyn Cy clones are now six wins shy of their 1,000th in franchise history...Brooklyn holds a record of 994-838 (.543) in 1,832 games since 2001..Brooklyn captured its 900th victory in franchise history with a $6-5$ triumph vs. Wilmington on August 14, 2022 Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown. 403 games.

NICK THE STICK: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native reached base three times on Tuesday, adding a pair of extra-base hits and a career-high-tying three RBI...Lorusso is one of two Cyclones with a multi-extra-base hit contest in 2024 and the only one to accomplish the feat on multiple occasions...Coming into Wednesday's contest, the 23 -year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), third in slugging (.561), fifth in OPS (.943), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (9), eighth in RBI (13), and 10th in total bases (32)...Lorusso trails only Triple-A Syracuse's OF Ben Gamel (10) for the most extra-base knocks in the Mets' farm system.

DOOGIE HOWSER: RHP Douglas Orellana celebrates his 22nd birthday on Wednesday and continued his impressive pitching to start the year on Tuesday, 21-year-old retired all 15 ings in his first start otriking out six - in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP Benito García ( $8 / 12 / 23 \mathrm{vABD}$ ), RHP Daison Acosta ( $6 / 21 / 22 \mathrm{vJS}$ ), and RHP Chris Schwinden (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted $5.0+$ innings, but allowed only one hit...Entering play on Wednesday, is third in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.02),

YOUTH IS SERVED: Gilbert Gómez takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cy clones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gomez came the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the sec ond-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younge brother, Dariel, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summe and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League. Older brother, Jose, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager fo er...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a . 662 OPS in er...Gómez al

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by Baseball America.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA ( 5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all 6.0 innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville....After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP José Butto accomplished the feat, tossing 6.0 innings in a 7 -inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final 8 appearances ( 7 starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP Danny Wilkinson (49) who was second...De La Cruz went $1-2$ with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP ) with 18 walks (11.4 BB\%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1\%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22 -year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7\%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5\%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
