LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn captured Tuesday night's series opener, 9-2, over Aberdeen...The Cyclones erupted for seven runs in the bottom of the first inning, sending 11 batters to the plate...The seven runs were the most for Brooklyn in the first inning since the Minor League stat portal began in 2005...The 'Clones started the game with five straight base hits and six consecutive batters reaching safely...CF Omar De Los Santos capped the inning with a two-run home run...All nine Brooklyn batters reached base at least once...2B Wilfredo Lara, 1B Ryan Clifford, and 3B Nick Lorusso all picked up two hits and reached base three times...Lorusso added a double, a triple, and a season-high-tying three RBI...RHP Douglas Orellana tossed 4.1 scoreless innings in a no-decision, while RHP Jordany Ventura went 3.2 innings of spotless relief to earn his second victory.

COUNTDOWN TO 1K: After Tuesday's 9-2 win over Aberdeen, the Brooklyn Cyclones are now six wins shy of their 1,000th in franchise history...Brooklyn holds a record of 994-838 (.543) in 1,832 games since 2001...Brooklyn captured its 900th victory in franchise history with a 6-5 triumph vs. Wilmington on August 14, 2022... Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown... Since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021, the Cyclones are 196-207 (.486) in 403 games.

NICK THE STICK: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native reached base three times on Tuesday, adding a pair of extra-base hits and a career-high-tying three RBI..Lorusso is one of two Cyclones with a multi-extra-base hit contest in 2024 and the only one to accomplish the feat on multiple occasions...Coming into Wednesday's contest, the 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), third in slugging (561), fifth in OPS (.943), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (9), eighth in RBI (13), and 10th in total bases (32)...Lorusso trails only Triple-A Syracuse's OF Ben Gamel (10) for the most extra-base knocks in the Mets' farm system.

DOOGIE HOWSER: RHP Douglas Orellana celebrates his 22nd birthday on Wednesday and continued his impressive pitching to start the year on Tuesday, hurling 4.1 scoreless innings in his first start of 2024...Last Wednesday in relief, the 21-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced — striking out six — in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP Benito García (8/12/23 vABD), RHP Daison Acosta (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP Chris Schwinden (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Entering play on Wednesday, is third in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.02), sixth in batting average against (161), and seventh in WHIP (0.96).

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday...INF Jefrey De Los Santos was also reinstated from the 7-day injured list, while RHP Jordan Geber was transferred to Double-A Binghamton and UT Jaylen Palmer was reinstated from their injured list...In four appearances (two starts) in the Florida State League, the 20-year-old was 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 18.2 IP)...The only run Tong has allowed is unearned, in addition to racking up 36 strikeouts to only five walks...Entering play on Tuesday, the Markham, Ont. native is third among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout rate (52.9%) trailing only Single-A Lynchburg's LHP Matt Wilkinson (56.2%) and Single-A Palm Beach's LHP Quinn Matthews (53.5%)...Tong's 45.6% strikeout-to-walk rate is second-best in MiLB behind Wilkinson (47.9%)...Tong is one of three qualifiers who has not allowed an earned run and his 36 strikeouts are tied for eighth-most in the minors.

ROAM-AR DE LOS SANTOS: OF Omar De Los Santos enters Wednesday's contest 13-for-14 stealing bases to start the season...The 13 swipes are third in the South Atlantic League...After swiping two bases on Sunday, De Los Santos is tied with UT Jaylen Palmer for first on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (50)... Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for sixth across the Minors for swipes (120)...He broke INF Walter Rasquin's (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023

LOVE THE DRAKE!: C Drake Osborn has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...The 25-year-old has collected an eye-popping 389 (14-36) with a 1.083 OPS, adding four doubles, a home run, and four RBI...Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 45 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in on-base percentage (.479) and OPS (1.017)...He is also second in batting average (.359) and ninth in slugging (.538).

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington last Wednesday...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn continues its first two-week homestand of the season against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds possess six of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (6), INF Mac Horvath (11), RHP Jackson Baumeister (18), RHP Juan Núñez (26), RHP Carter Baumler (28), and C Creed Willems (29)...Bradfield Jr. is currently on the 7-day injured list...In 18 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 10-8 record against Aberdeen, including a 7-5 record at Maimonides Park...Since 2002, the Cyclones and IronBirds have met 240 times with Brooklyn leading the all-time series, 127-113 (.529).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs Jordan Geber, Brett Banks, and Jus-TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs Jordan Geber, Brett Banks, and Justin Lawson united on a one-hit shutout of Wilmington in Friday's 3-0 victory...The one-hitter marked the first time the Cyclones held an opponent to one or fewer hits since May 22, 2022...Brooklyn bested Hudson Valley, 3-1, in Game 2 of a doubleheader... It was the first one-hitter in a nine-inning game since a 6-1 rout vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...RHP Conner Grey carried a no-hit bid into the ninth inning that night...It was Brooklyn's second shutout of the series and third of the year after RHPs Nolan McLean, Dakota Hawkins, and Joey Lancellotti combined on Brooklyn's 5-0 win vs. Wilmington on Tuesday...RHPs Brandon Sproat, Jordany Ventura, and Justin Lawson registered a five-hitter vs. Asheville on April 9...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP Justin Lawson has started his 2024 with a bang... The reliever notched a three-inning save in last Friday's shutout of Wilmington, good for his fourth of the season (and second that spanned three full innings)...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4)...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least nine innings pitched, the 23-year-old has the lowest WHIP (0.33) and opposing OPS (.136) in the circuit and has permitted the fewest hits (1).

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Jordany Ventura, Sean Reid-Foley, Justin Lawson, and Ben Simon united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in April 14's walk-off victory...RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Josh Hejka, Dakota Hawkins, and Joshua Corneilly also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP Justin Dunn (5), LHP Kyle Regnault (2), and RHP Nabil Crismatt (11) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over nine linnings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

KING STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 65 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 99 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Álvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

YOUTH IS SERVED: Gilbert Gómez takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, Dariel, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League... Older brother, José, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, Héctor, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: Ryan Clifford (No. 5), Brandon Sproat (11), Nolan McLean (15), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF Wilfredo Lara (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all 6.0 innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP José Butto accomplished the feat, tossing 6.0 innings in a 7-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final 8 appearances (7 starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkinson** (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
