THREE-HIT NIGHTS FROM GROSHANS AND VICUNA LEAD FISHER CATS: Jordan Groshans went 3-for-5 and Kevin Vicuna went 3-for-4 to lead the Fisher Cats to an 8-5 win over Hartford last night. Vicuna gave the Fisher Cats a 2-0 lead in the first thanks to a two-run single, then added a run when Vicuna stole second and Chavez Young came home from third. Samad Taylor made it 4-0 with an RBI single in the fourth. Elehuris Montero tied the game at 4-4 with a two-run homer in the seventh. New Hampshire responded with three in the bottom of the game. Young doubled to make it 5-4 and Vicuna hit another double to make it 7-4. Vinny Capra added a solo homer in the eighth.

UP NEXT: The Fisher Cats will head on their second 12-game road trip of the season following this week. They will first visit Harrisburg (Washington Nationals) before heading to Hartford to close out the season series with the Yard Goats.

CLOSING IN ON .500: New Hampshire is two games under .500 for the first time since May 21 when they were 7-9. The high-water mark was +1 after beating the Sea Dogs on opening night. New Hampshire reached the low-water mark at 10-21 on June 9.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 7, 2018—Jon Harris improved to 10-4 in New Hampshire's 8-3 win to start a roadtrip in Bowie. Gunnar Heidt and Andrew Guillotte hit homers for the Fisher Cats and Harold Ramirez drove in three runs with a pair of doubles. The losing pitcher that night was Baysox starter Brian Gonzalez, who pitched in relief here for Hartford last night.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays scored nine times in the bottom of the fifth and went on to a 12-4 win over the Red Sox. For Hartford, Nate Harris is scheduled to make his fifth start. 26-year old was selected by the Rockies in the 21st round of the 2017 draft (Louisiana Tech). Had a solid start July 16 at Dunkin Donuts Park against the Fisher Cats when he allowed just one earned run in five frames in a game New Hampshire won 5-2. The Fisher Cats are expected to turn to Reilly Hovis in the series finale on Sunday.

Hovis, recently signed by the Blue Jays out of independent ball, made his seventh start for New Hampshire against Hartford on Tuesday night, earning the win in the Fisher Cats 8-2 victory. He allowed two runs, one earned, in five innings.

Hovis was drafted by the Miami Marlins in the ninth round of the 2015 draft (North Carolina). Made 76 appearances (seven starts) in Marlins organization, advancing as far as Double-A Jacksonville in 2018. Was released in March 2019. Was pitching for Gastonia Honey Hunters (Atlantic League) when offered to join Blue Jays.
