**TODAY'S GAMES:** Winners of their last five games, the Space Cowboys continue their final six-game series of the season... Sugar Land has already secured the series by winning the first four games against the Chihuahuas... This is El Paso's third trip to Sugar Land this year and the Space Cowboys own a 14-8 record versus the Chihuahuas this year, going 10-3 in 13 games at Constellation Field so far.

**ABOUT FRIDAY NIGHT:** After falling behind 2-0 in the first inning, Corey Julks walked, stole second and moved to third on a wild pitch before scoring on an RBI double from Will Wagner... A Wagner RBI fielder's choice tied the game at 2-2... El Paso took the lead on a solo home run in the top of the sixth... Andrew Knapp hit a game-tying home run to lead off the bottom of the ninth, and Julks doubled to put the winning run in scoring position... Wagner collected his fourth hit of the night to give Sugar Land their second straight walk-off win, a 4-3 victory.

**ROSTER MOVES:** 9/22 - RHP Spencer Arrighetti placed on the IL... RHP Ryne Stanek completes his ML Rehab... RHP Joel Kuhnel optioned to Sugar Land... 9/20 - RHP Logan VanWey promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi... RHP Rhett Kouba placed on the Development List... 9/19 - INF Will Wagner promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi... OF Marty Costes placed on the Development List... RHP Ryne Stanek assigned to Sugar Land on Major League rehab...

**HOME GROWN TALENT:** Sugar Land's active roster has 11 players drafted by the Astros, 1 player signed as non-drafted free agents in 2020 and 7 international signings

**PROSPECTING:** With the re-ranking of MLB Pipeline's Prospects, Sugar Land now has eight of the Astros' Top 30 prospects on their roster, including RHP Spencer Arrighetti (#3), OF Joey Loperfido (#6), LHP Colton Gordon (#7), RHP Rhett Kouba (#9), OF Pedro Leon (#13), INF Will Wagner (#15), INF Shay Whitcomb (#25) & RHP Misael Tamarez (#30).

**SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING:** Sugar Land is 6-15-2 in sixgame series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-1 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 4-8-1 overall at Constellation Field in 2023.

**THAT'S ONE WAY TO CELEBRATE:** On the same day that he was recognized as the *Astros' Minor League Player of the Year by Baseball America*, OF Joey Loperfido hit a walk-off two-run homer in the 11th on Thursday night... Loperfido also drove in the tying run in the seventh to help force extra innings.

Loperfido has reached safely in 18 of his last 24 games with 4 doubles, 4 home runs, 13 RBI and 8 walks and has hit safely in 16 of his last 23 games.

The 24-year-old leads the Astros' organization in doubles (27) and extra-base hits (55), is tied with Shay Whitcomb for the organizational lead in hits (129), 2nd in Home Runs (25), Total Bases (237) & RBI (78), 3rd in Avg (.280), OPS (.884) & SLG (.514), 4th in OBP (.370), T-4th in Walks (63) and 5th in Runs Scored (77) & Stolen Bases (26).

### **Upcoming Probable Pitchers**

**SLAY SHAY:** INF Shay Whitcomb is tied with Minnesota Twins Farmhand Yunior Severino for the MiLB lead in home runs, launching 35 total homers between Corpus Christi (12) and Sugar Land (23)... With 2 games remaining, Whitcomb has a chance to win the Joe Bauman Award, given annually to the Minor League leader in home runs.

His 35 home runs are the most home runs for an Astros' Minor Leaguer since Kyle Tucker hit 34 in 2019 with Round Rock, and Whitcomb has a chance to match or surpass George Springer's 37 home runs in 2013, the most home runs in a season by an Astros' Minor Leaguer since 2003.

Additionally, with 102 total RBI, Whitcomb is just the 7th Astros' farm hand with over 100 RBI since 2014 (Justin Dirden, 101 in 2022; AJ Reed in '18 (108), '17 (104) & '15 (127); Matt Duffy, 101 in 2015; J.D. Davis, 101 in 2015)... He's also one of just 10 players in MiLB with at least 100 RBI this season.

**QUIET A FIRST IMPRESSION:** INF Will Wagner was promoted to Sugar Land on Tuesday and made his Triple-A debut that evening, going 2-for-4 with a double... Wagner followed it up with a four-hit night on Wednesday, and collected four more hits on Friday night, including a game-winning single... The 25-year-old has reached safely in each of his first four games in Sugar Land and has totaled 10 hits already this week, the most in MiLB.

**HISTORY FOR BLANCO:** On 9/12, RHP Ronel Blanco rewrote the Sugar Land history books, striking out 12 batters in 6.0 scoreless innings of work... The 12 strikeouts broke the previous Space Cowboys record for strikeouts in a game (11 - Bielak, 2023; Endersby, 2022) and also set a new career high for Blanco, who had struck out 9 batters in an outing on two occasions in his career... Blanco was on the front foot all night, throwing a first pitch strike to 15 of the 22 hitters he faced.

During the week, Blanco led MiLB in strikeouts and was third in MiLB, second in the PCL, in innings pitched.

**SEEING 20-20-20:** Both Pedro Leon (23 2B, 21 HR) and Joey Loperfido (27 2B, 25 HR) have posted seasons in which they have at least 20 doubles and 20 home runs while stealing at least 20 bases (Leon - 21; Loperfido -25)... They are two of just 23 players in Minor League Baseball to have at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 20 stolen bases, with Corpus Christi OF Kenedy Corona joining them (21 2B, 22 HR, 32 SB).... INF Shay Whitcomb is also just one double shy of joining the 20-20-20 club

**STREAKING SPACE COWBOYS:** Several Space Cowboys are riding long on-base streaks, with INF David Hensley reaching in 19 straight games, INF/OF Pedro Leon reaching in 17 straight while Bligh Madris has a 14-game on-base streak.

RIDE THE BIKEL: On 6/24, Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

**LAST TIMES OUT:** Started on Sunday in the finale against Sacramento... Gave up a lead-off single to Wade Meckler, the only hit he allowed on the day, but retired the next five straight hitters... Worked around a pair of two-out walks in the second... Retired 10 of the final 11 batters he faced including eight straight to end his day... Got the win in a 7-0 Space Cowboys shutout victory.

**SCORELESS STREAK:** Currently on a 13.0 game scoreless inning streak that began in the fourth inning on 9/6 vs. OKC.

**REKKKKORD SETTING:** With 12 strikeouts in 6.0 innings on 9/12 @ SAC, Blanco set a new-single game franchise record for the Space Cowboys and new career best strikeouts in a game (previous for Blanco, 9)... That night, Blanco threw a first pitch strike to 15 of the 22 batters he faced.

**STARTING WITH THE 'STROS:** As a starter with Houston this year, is 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA, hurling 38.0 innings and allowing 20 runs, all earned, on 21 walks with 35 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .226 batting average against.

**MOVES IN 2023**: Optioned on 8/27... Recalled on 8/25... Optioned to Sugar Land on August 3... Recalled and started for Houston on August 2... Optioned to Sugar Land on July 8... Was recalled by Houston on July 6 and started that day against Seattle, throwing 6.0 innings and allowing three runs... Had been slated to start for Sugar Land that day but was recalled... Was optioned to Sugar Land on July 2... Originally recalled by the Astros on June 1.

**NO RUNS FOR YOU:** Hurled 16.0 scoreless frames with Sugar Land from his outing on May 9 to the second inning on July 15, spanning four appearances... His 16.0 inning scoreless streak is the longest streak for a Space Cowboys pitcher in 2023.

**FIRST START SINNNNCCE**: When Blanco started for Sugar Land on May 9, it was his first start since July 26, 2019 while he was with Tri-Cities.... Even then, Blanco only threw two innings.. He last worked as a full time starter in 2017, making 11 starts in 22 total appearances with Quad Cities, hurling 84.2 innings.

**DEBUT SZN:** Made the Opening Day Roster with the Astros in 2022 and made his Major League debut on April 8.

**HOLD ME CLOSER**: Has totaled 27 saves in 38 total save chances between 2021 and 2022 with Sugar Land.

**WELCOME TO THE 'STROS:** Signed as an international free agent when he was 22 on April 27, 2016... Began his carer as a corner infielder and outfielder with a strong arm... Converted to pitching at the age of 18.
