Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Jack Leftwich** to the mound tonight, looking to untie the road (9-9) and night game (10-10) records. Iowa will counter with LHP **Doug Nikhazy**. Columbus is 3-9 (.250) versus left handers this year. Nikhazy has never faced the Clippers in his career, but pitched 35G for Columbus in the regular season ('24-25), going 12-10 with a 4.02ERA (also won only start of '24 playoffs).

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 18-17 opposing the I-Cubs (33-24 in the last 57G). Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has 5HR and 15RBI in 20G against Iowa in his career, while **Nolan Jones** has hit 9HR with 34RBI in 34G (.312, 39x125) and **Milan Tolentino** has 9HR and 20RBI in 24G (.329, 27x82). **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .320 (24x75) with 3HR and 9RBI in 20G.

Crazy Eighthths

Yesterday's 2-run 8th inning put the finishing touches on the 15th comeback win for Columbus (most in the IL, seven against Iowa). The Clippers have plated 35 in the 8th inning this year (most in the IL, 15 against Iowa), scoring in 18 of 34G with an at bat in the 8th (forced five ties and taken four leads). From the 8th on, Columbus owns the IL's best run differential (+30, 56-26) and HR differential (+10, 12-2).

At the Top

Stuart Fairchild will start things off for the Clippers, batting leadoff for the second time (5/2 vs. Toledo). Fairchild is hitting only .235 (4x17) since the calendar flipped to May, but has crafted a .435OBP (6BB; .435OBP in April, too). Following him will be **Juan Brito**, making his 167th start batting second (78G more than any IL player since debut). Brito has a hit in each of 6G this month (.308, 8x26).

Since the Option

George Valera is hitting just .185 (5x27) this month without any extra base hits (.294, 10x34 with 3XBH in 8G rehab last month). While he has only 7K in 28PA in May (25%), he has only 1BB. In fact, he has 4BB in 68PA (6%) with Columbus this season (130BB in 972PA, 13%, in 233G with Columbus from 2022-25). His season-long strikeout rate (15%) is also down (27% from 2022-25).

Good for What Ails Ya

Nolan Jones went 3x21 (.143) in 6G after hitting .407 (11x27) in the 8G prior (4/16-4/26), but is 4x14 with an RBI in 3G on the banks of the Raccoon River, where he owns a career line of .371/.488/.729 with 5HR and 22RBI in 18G (has reached base in all, at least twice in 14G). Despite the slump, Jones is still driving in runs, as he now has 89RBI in his last 98G in Triple-A (.310/.424/.596 with 24HR).

Eye is for Ingle

Cooper Ingle has drawn 22BB in his first 67PA (33%) this season, following 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .286 (36x126) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .477OBP and a +16 differential in the walk to strikeout department (43 to 27). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 43BB are tied for 5th most (**Travis Bazzana** leads, 47, and **Kahlil Watson** is 4th, 45).

Hot Huff

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with multi-hit games in each of his first 5G this month (.611, 11x18). He has an XBH in each of his last 4G and 10XBH in his last 17G (.625SLG since 4/16). Huff is dominating on the run production front, sitting at 21 runs and 26RBI through 30G (one of nine in the IL with 20+ of both; had 31 runs and a career high 47RBI in 101G last year).

POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .116/.269/.140 with 0HR and 0RBI in 12G (2x4 with a double on 4/28). Of 31 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off a LHP (102AB; 27HR in 403AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .364 (8x22) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

Frias Figures It Out

Dayan Frias scored for the ninth time in his last 12G Wednesday, entering as a pinch runner. Since 4/23, Frias is hitting .314 (11x35) in 12G (started the year 8x64, .125, through first 19G), reaching base in all 10G with a plate appearance (.415OBP). Unfortunately, he has 1RBI on his hot streak (5/3 vs. Toledo, snapped 14G streak without), as he is just 4x27 (.148) with runners in scoring position (0XBH).

This Date in Clipper History

5/8/2005

The Clippers blanked Indianapolis by a score of 9-0 at Cooper Stadium. **Mitch Jones** powered the offense, going 4x5 with 2HR and 4RBI. Jones would go on to hammer 27 for the '05 Clippers, the 7th highest total for Columbus since the turn of the millennium (**Fernando Seguignol**, 28, '03; **Eric Haase**, 28, '19; **Johnathan Rodriguez**, 29, '24; **Jesus Aguilar**, 30, '16; **Richie Shaffer**, 30, '17, **Bobby Bradley**, 33, '19).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 46-50 (.479) in pitch reviews, with batters going 29-35 (.453) and pitchers/catchers going 17-15 (.531). They have run out of challenges in 21G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 11th in the IL this year (.978), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 20G this season (11-9, .550), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Juan Brito moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 5/7 at lowa and that runner came around to score in a 2-run win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 85-23 (.787) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 2-2 mark this season (.500, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 405-423 (.489), 375-377 with Columbus (.499).
