## HICKS HOMERS TWICE, RIDERS BLANK CORPUS FOR SECOND-STRAIGHT GAME:

The Frisco RoughRiders shut out the Corpus Christi Hooks for a second-consecutive night, winning 8-0 on Friday night from Whataburger Field. Frisco (36-19) has now thrown 21.0 consecutive scoreless innings extending back to game two of the series on Wednesday. Starter **Nick Krauth** (5-2) was strong over his six innings, allowing just five hits while striking out six and walking one. **Ricky DeVito**, **Seth Clark** and **Andy Rodriguez** then all threw one scoreless inning of relief to complete the shutout. At the plate, Frisco scored in each of the first five innings with **Liam Hicks** pacing the Riders offense with a pair of home runs, his first multi-home run game of his professional career. His first, a solo shot, came in the first inning to make it 1-0. In the second, Hicks smacked an RBI single up the middle and **Frainer Chavez** double home a run for a 3-0 lead. Chavez collected three hits on the night for his fifth multi-hit game during his seven-game hitting streak. **Keyber Rodriguez** continued the homer barrage in the third with a solo blast of his own before Hicks hammered a two-run shot in the fourth to increase the lead to 6-0. The Riders added two more runs in the fifth when Rodriguez scored on a wild pitch and **Geisel Cepeda** drove in another run with a fielder's choice. Corpus Christi (21-34) starter Michael Knorr threw 3.2 innings, allowing six runs, in the loss. Frisco has now won 11 of their last 13 games and leads the Texas League South by 4.0 games with 14 games remaining in the first half.

## PLAYOFFS IN SIGHT:

Entering into Saturday's game, the RoughRiders have the best record in all of Double-A at 36-19 and they have a season-best 4.0-game lead on the Midland RockHounds in the Texas League South. The RoughRiders are looking to make the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and win the first half for the first time since 2014.

## FIRING BLANKS:

The Riders have combined to throw 21-consecutive scoreless innings over the last three games, including back-to-back shutouts for the first time this season. The franchise record is 30-consecutive scoreless innings, which Frisco accomplished last year from July 2nd through July 5th. Frisco has the third-best ERA in the Texas League during the month of June, at 3.12 through the first six games.

## HICKS IS THE PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 21 games, batting .380 (27-for-71)/.477/.535/1.012 with five doubles, two home runs, 14 RBIs, 11 walks, six strikeouts and 13 runs. In his last nine games, he is hitting .441 (15-for-34)/.525/.735/1.260. On Friday, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

## CHAVEZ RACKING UP THE HITS:

In his first two seasons with the RoughRiders combined, **Frainer Chavez** just played 44 games with Frisco, but having played his 46th game of the season with the Riders on Wednesday, he is on fire at the plate. Over a seven-game hitting streak, he is hitting .556 (15-for-27)/.571/.667/1.238 with a double, a triple, a walk, five steals and eight runs scored. In his last 20 games, he is slashing .368 (25-for-68)/.419/.485/.904.

## MAY FLOWERS:

With the month of May coming to an end, the RoughRiders have tied their franchise record for most wins in May with 19 (third time in franchise history, tying 2003 and 2010). Their 19 wins were the most in the Texas League and tied for the most in Double-A. Frisco's 3.45 team May ERA was second in the Texas League and their bullpen has dominated to the tune of a 2.62 ERA. **Emiliano Teodo** went 3-0 with a 0.82 ERA over four starts in the month.

## WELCOME TO THE ROAD TRIP OF YOUR DREAMS:

The RoughRiders are in the midst of a two-week, 13-game road trip against the San Antonio Missions and the Corpus Christi Hooks. Having started the trip 9-2, Frisco is now 23-5 combined against their two division opponents and 13-14 against everyone else in the Texas League this season. On the mound against Corpus Christi and San Antonio, the Riders have a 2.79 ERA (76ER/245.0 IP).

## RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 20 games, they are 13-7, but are hitting .245 (39-for-159) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .278 with RISP.

## MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

**Keyber Rodriguez** has been tearing up the baseball over the last couple of weeks. In his last 18 games, Rodriguez is hitting .369 (24-for-65) with eight multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, two triples, two home runs, 13 RBIs, five walks, nine runs scored and two steals. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .295 and OPS from .371 to .847 over the last 18 games.

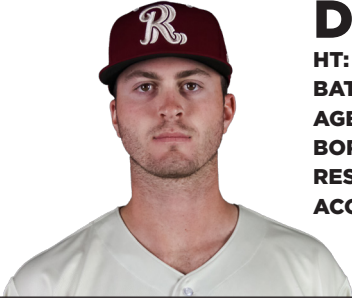

### ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrienes College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

### 2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 28 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In first start at Wichita on Opening Day, threw 3.2 no-hit innings before allowing his first hit. Finished with 4.2 innings, allowing just one run in a 6-4 Riders win.

### 2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

-Made best start of MiLB career on August 30th against CC with 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 5 K.

### 2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

### 2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
