#### JACKSONVILLE WINS THIRD STRAIGHT

Jerar Encarnacion matched a career-high with four RBIs to lead the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to a 9-5 victory over the Charlotte Knights in Tuesday's series opener from Truist Field. Xavier Edwards led off the ballgame with a single off Charlotte (5-5) starter Nate Fisher (0-2) bfore stealing second base. After a pair of outs, Encarnacion drilled an RBI double to center for the game's first run. Jacksonville drew 10 walks in the game, the club's most since 10 free passes on June 4, 2022 at Norfolk. Consecutive one-out bases on balls by Jordan Groshans and Encarnacion put two men on in the sixth. After a fly out, Burdick and Amaya each singled home a run to widen the gap to 6-1.

#### **FIRST THINGS FIRST**

For the ninth game in a row to start the season, Jacksonville got their leadoff man on to begin their first at-bats when **Xavier Edwards** singled in his first at-bat of the top of the first inning from Charlotte starter **Nate Fisher**. Of those nine leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch, with the lone exceptions being a single on an 0-1 pitch to **Garrett Hampson** on March 31 at Gwinnett and a 1-1 pitch to Edwards Friday night against Durham. Six of those eight leadoff baserunners have also come via hits; **Brian Miller** reached on an error to start the Jumbo Shrimp's contest on April 2 at the Stripers and Edwards walked to start the bottom of the first on Sunday against

Jacksonville's 10 walks last night, was the most since also walking 10 times on June 4, 2022 at Norfolk. The Jumbo Shrimp haven't had more than 10 walks in a game since June 15, 2019 at Birmingham, when the club was a member of the Double-A Southern League.

Since the club's first season back in Triple-A, Jacksonville owns a 29-23 record against the Knights. The two teams played each other to a razor thin margin last year (16-14). Against Charlotte, the Jumbo Shrimp hitters slashed .288/.367/.470 with an .837 OPS (2nd-highest) among 2022 division opponents. The pitching staff owned 4.51 ERA (3rd-lowest) among 2022 division opponents.

### THE ENDS JUSTIFY THE MEANS

Only three teams in the IL (Iowa, Omaha and Norfolk ) have scored more runs than Jacksonville through the season's first eight games. Despite the club's 64 runs scored, the Jumbo Shrimp are tied for seventh in average (.261), 13th in on-base percentage (.333), 11th in slugging percentage (.429) and 11th in OPS (.762). With runners in scoring position, though, Jacksonville's slash line jumps up to .277/.346/.464/.810, figures that rank third, ninth, fourth and fifth, respectively.

#### ON THE OTHER SIDE THOUGH...

While the Jumbo Shrimp are ranked fourth in the league in runs scored, they also have ceded the most runs in the IL by a huge margin. Jacksonville has yielded 68 runs, an average of 7.6 per game. Charlotte, is ranked 14th in the 20-team league entering play on Wednesday, has surrendered 57 tallies (5.7 per game) and are closer to 10th-place than to Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp have issued the sixth-most walks (47) in the circuit, while ranking 18th in batting average against (.272) and 17th in hits allowed (89). The club has surrendered at least five runs in all but two game so far.

### GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinojosa. Through six games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 11-for-27, slashing a robust .407/.414/.778/1.192 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 10 RBIs and four runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for sixth in the International League in RBIs, fourth in batting average, fifth in slugging and tied for seventh in OPS. He has knocked in at least one run in every game he's played so far this year, with hits in five of his six contests.

### ABOUT CHI CHI

-Gonzaalez was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected González in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, González attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles.

-González starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the Univeristy's Hall of Fame. He earned many accoldaes such as 2011 Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA Freshman All-American, 2x Pitcher of the Year (Summit League and Southland Conference) and finished second in the NCAA in 2013 with 126 strikeouts.
