THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 29, 2003, Pee Wee, the lovable Cy clones mascot named after Brooklyn Dodgers Hall of Fame shortstop Pee Wee Reese, makes his debut in Brooklyn, joining Sandy The Seagull...In 2004, OF Derran Watts became the second player in Cyclones' history to win the "Hit Sign / Win Suit Brooklyn. RHP Dillon Gee, joins the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment In two starts with Brooklyn, Gee went 0-1 with a 2.08 ERA ( 2 ER in 8.2 IP ) with two walks and 16 strikeouts...Gee was the first former Cyclone to be named the Mets' Opening Day starter and had his number honored at Maimonides Park in 2011.
RUSTED IRON: RHPs Dakota Hawkins (6.0 IP) and Josh Hejka (3.0) combined on a three-hit shutout in Friday's 7 -O win at Aberdeen...The shutout was the eighth of the year for the Cyclones' pitching staff and the first since Hawkins (5.0 IP), RHP Joey
Lancellotti (1.0), and RHP Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history vs. Aberdeen on June 4...Four of Brooklyn's eight deen on May 3 and 4 come against the IronBirds...The Cyclones also blanked Aberdeen on May
shutouts ( $42.11 \%$ ) have been against the 'Birds...Hawkins and Hejka combined to retire the final 19 batters in order in Friday's contest and did not allow a walk in the game.. It was the first time Cyclones' pitching did not allow a free pass in a contest since a 1-O loss at Greenville in Game 1 of a doubleheader on August 31,2023 ...It was the first
zero-walk performance by Brooklyn in a nine-inning game since an $8-5$ win at Asheville zero-walk performancer
on August 26,2023 .

NICK SQUARED: OF Nick Morabito and IF Nick Lorusso have been two of Brook lyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...The duo each put together multi-hit games in Sunday's win over Jersey Shore...Lorusso is seventh in the South Atlantic League in OPS (.867), eighth in slugging (.496) and total bases (113), tied for ninth in full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.867)...He is also third in slugging (.496), tied for third in extra-base hits (27), fourth in home runs (11) and RBI (40), tied for fourth in triples (3), and fifth in total bases (113)...Morabito is tied for 11th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (33) and tied for 12th in on-base percentage (.430)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for
second in the league in steals (22) and tied for eighth in runs scored (29)...The 21-yearold leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.324), on-base percent age (.430), and stolen bases (33)...He also is second in hits (78), tied for third in runs scored (43), fourth in OPS (.845), and fifth in walks (38).
EYES LIKE A HAWK: RHP Dakota Hawkins has been a revelation since joining the Brooklyn starting rotation...The 24 -year-old - scattered amongst the league leaderFriday's win over Aberdeen, tossing a career-high 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing only three hits...In his six games since transitioning to a starting role, Hawkins checks in
with a 3.42 ERA, while holding opposing hitters to a minuscule 202 batting average with a 3.42 ERA, while holding opposing hitters to a minuscule . 202 batting average...
The Chehalis, Wash. native has limited opponents to two runs or fewer in all but one start, and one run or fewer in all but two starts.
THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision on Wednesday night in Aberdeen...Since making in strikeouts (56) and fifth in ERA (3.38)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the year...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.19), third in strikeout rate
(35.9\%), sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8\%), and tied for seventh in strikeouts (92).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones will have just six home games over the next 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game
home series will take place from July $23-28$ vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is $1-3$ in the stretch...The Cyclones will play three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July $1-3$ and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star
break...Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season...After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Monday, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back-to-back days off on July 7 and 8 .
WELCOME TO CONEY ISLAND: INF Jesús Báez joined the Cyclones from Sin-gle-A St. Lucie on Monday and is 5 -for- 17 with a pair of doubles, two runs scored, and a stolen base through his first three games at the High-A level...Baez is the No. 15 pros-
pect in the Mets' organization according to Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...At 19 years old, Báez checks in as the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and will be the first player in franchise history born in 2005 ...In 64 games at the Single-A level, 39 RBI , and eight stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit...Báez was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and extra-base hits (25), fourth in rus scored (40), sixth in slugging (.444), and tied for sixth in doubles ( (26)...Among full-season Mets farmhands, the infielder is tied for first in doubles (16), tied for sec-

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road for its first sixgame series of the season's second half against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen boasts five of Baltimore's top 30 iNF Mac Horvath (11), LHP Luis De León (17), RHP Jackson Baumeister (18), and C Creed Willems (29)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Aberdeen in the first meeting (April 30-May 5) and split a six-game set in the most recent rendezvous (June 4-9)...Aberdeen does not return to Brooklyn in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 12 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn went $7-5$ against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and $4-5$ on Coney Island...In 251 meetings dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 134-121 (.525)
OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on Monday ferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (.136) at the plate with two runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases...Despite appearing in only two games for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos is still tied

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs Dakota Hawkins (5.0 IP), Joey Lancellotti (1.0), and Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only
previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP Brandon Moore tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen. first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP Joander Suárez hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP Sal Maglie tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching ap-
pearance in the process...The 27 -year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 63 caree outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a $6-3$ record with a 2.4

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS: Orellana set a season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome....It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out $10+$ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Colina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Orellana had his season-high 12.0-inning scoreless streak come to a close on May 5 vs. Aberdeen...During the stretch, he surrendered just three hits and fours walk, adding 13 strikeouts...The 22 -year-old started the season by tossing a bevvy of zeroes too...The right-hander did not allow a run over his first two appearances and 8.1 innings...Orellana yielded only four hits and three walks in that span, while striking out eight.
DOUGIE HOWSER: The Caraças, Venezuela native was untouchable out of the bullpen on April 24 vs. Wilmington...The 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced - striking out six - in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP Benito García ( $8 / 12 / 23 \mathrm{vABD}$ ), RHP Daison Acosta ( $6 / 21 / 22 \mathrm{vJS}$ ), and RHP Chris Schwinden ( 6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted $5.0+$ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all....However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP Nelson Pereira ( 5.0 IP ) was the last to do it in a $2-1$ win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

2023: Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager Gilbert Gómez and pitching coach Dan McKinney at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA (45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save...Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP Felipe De La Cruz (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and 16 K's.
