LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones fell to Aberdeen, 6-1, on Thursday night for their third-straight loss...With the defeat, Aberdeen clinched at least a series split of the six-game set...RHP **Kade Morris** kept Brooklyn in the game, hurling 6.0 innings of work, allowing two runs on four hits with eight strikeouts...The IronBirds took a 2-1 lead in the sixth and never looked back, plating four more in the eighth...2B **Junior Tilen** logged an RBI double, and SS **Jesús Báez** enjoyed his first High-A multi-hit affair...Aberdeen's 3B **Mac Horvath** collected two hits, drove in two runs, and scored two runs himself.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 29, 2003, **Pee Wee**, the lovable Cyclones mascot named after Brooklyn Dodgers Hall of Fame shortstop **Pee Wee Reese**, makes his debut in Brooklyn, joining **Sandy The Seagull**. In 2004, **OF Derran Watts** became the second player in Cyclones' history to win the "Hit Sign / Win Suit" contest reminiscent of Ebbets Field...In 2014, New York Mets' Opening Day starter and Brooklyn, RHP **Dillon Gee**, joins the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment...In two starts with Brooklyn, Gee went 0-1 with a 2.08 ERA (2 ER in 8.2 IP) with two walks and 16 strikeouts...Gee was the first former Cyclone to be named the Mets' Opening Day starter and had his number honored at Maimonides Park in 2011.

RUSTED IRON: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (6.0 IP) and **Josh Hejka** (3.0) combined on a three-hit shutout in Friday's 7-0 win at Aberdeen...The shutout was the eighth of the year for the Cyclones' pitching staff and the first since Hawkins (5.0 IP), RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and RHP **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history vs. Aberdeen on June 4...Four of Brooklyn's eight shutouts in 2024 have come against the IronBirds...The Cyclones also blanked Aberdeen on May 3 and 4 on Coney Island...Since the start of 2023, eight of the 'Clones 19 shutouts (42.1%) have been against the 'Birds...Hawkins and Hejka combined to retire the final 19 batters in order in Friday's contest and did not allow a walk in the game...It was the first time Cyclones' pitching did not allow a free pass in a contest since a 1-0 loss at Greenville in Game 1 of a doubleheader on August 31, 2023...It was the first zero-walk performance by Brooklyn in a nine-inning game since an 8-5 win at Asheville on August 26, 2023.

NICK SQUARED: OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...The duo each put together multi-hit games in Sunday's win over Jersey Shore...Lorusso is seventh in the South Atlantic League in OPS (.867), eighth in slugging (.496) and total bases (113), tied for ninth in extra-base hits (27), and 10th in RBI (40)...Lorusso is second among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.867)...He is also third in slugging (.496), tied for third in extra-base hits (27), fourth in home runs (11) and RBI (40), tied for fourth in triples (3), and fifth in total bases (113)...Morabito is tied for 11th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (33) and tied for 12th in on-base percentage (.430)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for second in the league in steals (22) and tied for eighth in runs scored (29)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.324), on-base percentage (.430), and stolen bases (33)...He also is second in hits (78), tied for third in runs scored (43), fourth in OPS (.845), and fifth in walks (38).

EYES LIKE A HAWK: RHP **Dakota Hawkins** has been a revelation since joining the Brooklyn starting rotation...The 24-year-old - scattered amongst the league leaderboard for relievers at the time of his move to the rotation - was near untouchable in Friday's win over Aberdeen, tossing a career-high 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing only three hits...In his six games since transitioning to a starting role, Hawkins checks in with a 3.42 ERA, while holding opposing hitters to a minuscule .202 batting average...The Chehalis, Wash. native has limited opponents to two runs or fewer in all but one start, and one run or fewer in all but two starts.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision on Wednesday night in Aberdeen...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the 21-year-old is tied for third in the circuit in strikeouts (56) and fifth in ERA (3.38)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the year...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.19), third in strikeout rate (35.9%), sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8%), and tied for seventh in strikeouts (92).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones will have just six home games over the next 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 1-3 in the stretch...The Cyclones will play three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season...After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Monday, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back-to-back days off on July 7 and 8.

WELCOME TO CONEY ISLAND: INF **Jesús Báez** joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday and is 5-for-17 with a pair of doubles, two runs scored, and a stolen base through his first three games at the High-A level...Báez is the No. 15 prospect in the Mets' organization according to *Baseball America* and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...At 19 years old, Báez checks in as the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and will be the first player in franchise history born in 2005...In 64 games at the Single-A level, Báez accumulated a .262 average (.66-252) with 25 extra-base hits, 10 home runs, 39 RBI, and eight stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit...Báez was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and extra-base hits (25), fourth in runs scored (40), sixth in slugging (.444), and tied for sixth in doubles (16)...Among full-season Mets farmhands, the infielder is tied for first in doubles (16), tied for second in total bases (119), third in hits (71), tied for first in extra-base hits (27), fifth in RBI (39) and slugging (.442), and tied for fifth in home runs (10) and runs scored (42).

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road for its first six-game series of the season's second half against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen boasts five of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (5), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (17), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), and C **Creed Willems** (29)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Aberdeen in the first meeting (April 30-May 5) and split a six-game set in the most recent rendezvous (June 4-9)...Aberdeen does not return to Brooklyn in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 12 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...In 251 meetings dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 134-121 (.525)

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on Monday from Double-A Binghamton...In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies after being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (.136) at the plate with two home runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases...Despite appearing in only two games for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos is still tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League with 26 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (63) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (135)...Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (133) is seventh.

HOME COOKING OR ROAD WARRIOR?: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...INF **Nick Lorusso** has mashed at Maimonides Park...In 27 home contests, the 23-year-old is hitting .357/.439/.684 with a 1.123 OPS on Coney Island with six home runs, 18 RBI, and 13 walks to 15 strikeouts...Lorusso leads all South Atlantic League qualifiers in home batting average (.357), on-base percentage (.439), slugging (.684), and OPS (1.123)...In 34 road affairs, Lorusso hits .200/.323/.354 with a .677 OPS, adding five home runs and 22 RBI with 24 walks to 41 K's...On the other hand, OF **Nick Morabito** is loving his time on the road...He is hitting .313/.414/.424 with a .838 OPS, adding two home runs, five RBI, and 21 stolen bases...Since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old is tied for second in the circuit in road hits (31) and runs scored (21) while swiping nine more bases (21) than any other player in the league...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .250/.314/.281 line with a .595 OPS, two extra-base hits, an RBI, and a stolen base over 15 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has also thrived at home posting a .300/.357/.420 mark with a .777 OPS, two home runs, and 13 RBI in 28 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .167/.269/.255 with a .524 OPS, a home run, and six runs batted in over 29 contests.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 63 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 6-3 record with a 2.41 ERA (28 ER in 104.2 IP) and eight saves, walking just 25 and striking out 95.

SO LONG, STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Monday...Consuegra departs Brooklyn as the franchise's all-time leader in numerous offensive categories...Last Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL **Jaylen Palmer** (204) for the most games played in franchise history (209)...Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (186) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI...Consuegra ended his time in Brooklyn with a bang, hitting .282/.389/.518 with a .907 OPS since May 17...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native had scored 16 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...In that time, Consuegra was tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14), tied for eighth in total bases (57), and ninth in slugging (.518).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Jesús Báez** (15), **Kade Morris** (15), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his first start in 23 days last Sunday at Jersey Shore...Did not allow a run on one hit, recording one out on a limited pitch count...Walked one and struck out one...Threw 15 pitches and six strikes (40.00%)...Relieved by LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** with runners at second and third and one out in the top of the first and the game scoreless...De La Cruz recorded back-to-back strikeouts to strand both runners...The Cyclones scored four runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to defeat the BlueClaws, 7-3, in the series finale.

WELCOME BACK: Orellana was reinstated off the Cyclones' 7-day injured list on June 23...The 22-year-old was placed on the IL back on June 6.

DOU NOT ENTER: Orellana enters the day with a stellar 1.47 ERA (6 ER in 36.2 IP)...Among South Atlantic League pitchers at least with 36.0 innings of work, Orellana is second in the circuit in ERA (1.47)...Rome's LHP **Samuel Strickland** (1.45) is first...Orellana's 1.47 ERA is the second lowest at the High-A level and tied for eighth lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 36.0+ innings on the hill.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS: Orellana set a season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome...It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a double-header for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Orellana had his season-high 12.0-inning scoreless streak come to a close on May 5 vs. Aberdeen...During the stretch, he surrendered just three hits and four walks, adding 13 strikeouts...The 22-year-old started the season by tossing a bevy of zeroes too...The right-hander did not allow a run over his first two appearances and 8.1 innings...Orellana yielded only four hits and three walks in that span, while striking out eight.

DOUGIE HOWSER: The Caraças, Venezuela native was untouchable out of the bullpen on April 24 vs. Wilmington...The 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced – striking out six – in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito García** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP **Nelson Pereira** (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

2023: Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager **Gilbert Gómez** and pitching coach **Dan McKinney** at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA (45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save...Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and 16 K's.
