LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox grabbed the series finale against the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Sunday by a final of 4-2 from The Diamond. Samuel Basallo hit a pair of homers, his first two-homer game of the season, to help keep Bowie above .500. Down 2-0 heading into the sixth, the Baysox scored three on Basallo's two-run homer and a go-ahead RBI single from Frederick Bencosme. Basallo homered again in the eighth to extend the Bowie lead. Carlos Tavera threw five shutout innings with six strikeouts in relief to pick up the win and secure the series finale for the Baysox.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie Seawolves suffered their first series loss of the season this past week, dropping three of five to Harrisburg at home. Sunday's finale was postponed due to inclement weather. Entering this series, Erie owns the second lowest ERA (2.56) in the league but has scored the fewest runs in the league (71). The defending Eastern League champion's roster includes five of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 3), RHP Troy Melton (No. 11), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 14), RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 27), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Lael Lockhart makes his fourth start of the season and his 16th career start with Erie. The 26-year-old most recently pitched five scoreless innings with seven strikeouts last Tuesday against Harrisburg. In three starts, he has yet to allow an earned run. Lockhart is in his second season with the Seawolves after debuting with them in 2023. The Friendswood, Texas native struck out 89 batters over 73.2 innings to an ERA of 2.69 last year with Erie. Originally drafted by the Dodgers in the 9th round of the 2021 Draft, he was traded to the Tigers in May 2023.

BASALLO HITS BOMBS

On Sunday, C **Samuel Basallo** recorded his first multi-homer game of the season and his first multi-homer game in Double-A with two homers in Richmond. The Orioles No. 2 prospect now has four multi-homer games in his career and Sunday was his first multi-homer game since September 2, 2023 while with High-A Aberdeen. It was part of a three-hit, three RBI game for the 19-year-old, his first three RBI game at Double A.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** had his 15-game on-base streak come to an end on Saturday after going 0-for-4. The Orioles No. 7 prospect was one game away from matching his career-long on-base streak set back in 2022 with Single-A Delmarva. Beavers still owns the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League and already surpassed his season-long on-base streak from last season at 12 games, while with High-A Aberdeen. The 22-year-old is fifth in the league in AVG (.318) and OBP (.410).

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has barreled up the ball since arriving the Double-A level to begin the season. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is ninth in the Eastern League in batting average (.311), third in runs (15), fourth in hits (23) and fifth in total bases (37). The middle infielder has hits in 14 of his first 19 Double-A contests, including seven multi-hit contests. Bencosme has also already hit three homers on the season after hitting only two all of last year in High-A Aberdeen. Only 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

PHAM ON THE MOUND

RHP **Alex Pham** gets the starting nod for the Baysox tonight. This will be Pham's 14th career start with the Baysox and his fifth this season. The 24-year-old is coming off his longest start of the season where he went five innings, allowing three runs on three hits, three walks and a season-high six strikeouts in a no decision at Richmond last Wednesday. The Orioles 19th round pick in 2021 out of San Francisco has punched out at least five batters in his last three starts. The Orioles No. 24 prospect made one appearance against Erie in relief last year on August 25 and pitched five innings, allowing three runs on five hits with no walks and four strikeouts in a no decision.

CATCHER IN THE RYE

C **Silas Ardoin** has been arguably the best defensive catcher in the league, thus far. The 23-year-old has caught a league leading 11 base runners stealing and has allowed only eight stolen bases, tied for the lowest total amongst the top 10 Eastern League catchers. Ardoin has also not committed an error behind the plate nor has he allowed a passed ball. Last season, he caught seven out of 30 base stealers in his first 26 games at Double-A.

2023: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and Opening Night starter. **Struck out season-high six over season-long 5.0 innings at Richmond in a no-decision. Has struck out five or more batters in last three starts.**

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League.
