ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn left 10 men on base, including a pair in the bottom of the ninth, losing the opener to Winston-Salem 4-2 on Tuesday night. The Cyclones snapped a three-game winning streak. 2B **Nic Gaddis** went 2-3 with a walk, while C **Jose Mena** doubled in a run. OF **Stanley Consuegra** ripped an RBI single in the ninth inning, but OF **Alex Ramirez** struck out with runners at first and third to end the game. RHP **Luis Moreno** allowed three runs (two earned) over 5 2/3 innings in the loss.

FIRST ISN'T THE WORST: The Cyclones lead the North Division by 0.5 games heading into Wednesday's matinee. Brooklyn has won 11 of 16 games and has a division-best +27 run differential, ranking third-highest in the league.

THANKS FOR MEMORIES: With yesterday's trade between the Mets and San Francisco Giants, Brooklyn LHP **Nick Zwack** and RHP **Carson Seymour** were sent west along with INF J.D. Davis and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** for Giants 1B/OF **Darin Ruf**.

RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** took Hudson Valley by storm last week. After a quiet 0-4 Tuesday, Ramirez finished the series 7-19 with a double, three home runs, and seven RBIs. On Sunday, Ramirez cracked two long balls, collecting his second multi-homer game this year and first with Brooklyn.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU FINISH: The Cyclones have a 3.27 ERA in July, good for the best ERA in High-A and the fourth-best in Minor League Baseball. However, the Cyclones have five blown saves, ranking as the most for a team in High-A with an ERA sub-3.50. In the month, Brooklyn starters have a 2.61 ERA (41 earned runs in 141.1 IP), while the bullpen has a 4.48 ERA (40 ER in 80.1 IP).

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: The Chicago White Sox affiliate comes to Maimonides Park for the first matchup in history. The Dash host White Sox No. 1 prospect SS Colson Montgomery, No. 8 INF Bryan Ramos, and No. 10 RHP Matthew Thompson. In total, the Dash is home to seven of Chicago's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Winston-Salem ranks seventh in OPS and eighth with a 4.76 ERA among the 12-team South Atlantic League.

NIC KNOWS: Since June 21, 2019 draftee C/INF **Nic Gaddis** has been on base in 27 of his past 30 games, posting a .425 OBP and a .861 OPS. For his career, Gaddis has a .360 OBP and a .738 OPS.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 54 home runs in the past 63 games (0.9 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

MLB DRAFT: With Monday's deadline of signing 2022 MLB Draftees, the Mets announced the signing of 19 of their 22 picks, including their first four selections: C **Kevin Parada** (1st round - GA Tech), SS **Jett Williams** (1st round - Rockwall-Heath HS), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round - Tennessee), and OF **Nick Morabito** (2nd round comp - Gonzaga College HS).

BACK AT IT: Oscar Rojas makes his first start since June 17, taking Carson Seymour's spot in the rotation after the righty was dealt to San Francisco on Tuesday.

RETURN: The Mexican right-hander was on the injured list, keeping him from games between June 18-July 22. Rojas was injured on June 17 at Wilmington and returned July 23 at Jersey Shore.

GB RATE: Rojas has a 47.4% ground ball rate, the highest of his career. This year, Rojas' fly-ball rate is 25%. Last season, Rojas' ground ball rate was 35.6% and his fly ball rate was 37.9%. The reduction in fly ball has meant a reduction in home runs. Last year, Rojas allowed 18% of his fly balls to leave the yard, while just 5.3% of his fly balls have left the yard this season.

OSCAR THE GROUCH: Rojas' 2021 campaign with Low-A St. Lucie was impressive, collecting two shutouts and three complete games with the Baby Mets.

METS CAREER: Rojas has pitched 41 times over a Mets minor league career that began in 2017. The Mexican missed 2019 due to injury, but pitched in the Mexican Winter League the following season -- during the 2020 shutdown of the Minor League season -- tossing 35.1 innings over 13 appearances for Guasave.
