Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, open a six-game series with the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, playing the 10th game in a 21-game season series. The Lugnuts are coming off winning five of six games at home against Peoria and have won three of their last four series overall, leaving Lansing in a three-way second-place tie with Great Lakes and West Michigan in the East Division, three games behind Lake County. 15 games remain in the first half of the season.

On the Air: Today's game can be seen on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with the audio stream via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** on the call.

Last Games, Sunday: Lugnuts 5, Chiefs 1 | Lugnuts 5, Chiefs 3. The Nuts swept a doubleheader from the Chiefs in record-breaking pace, winning Game 1 in a franchise-fast one hour and 23 minutes for a seven-inning game before completing the sweep with a one-hour and 47-minute victory in Game 2.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Dragons play through Sunday, and then Lansing returns home for a six-game series with 2023 champion Cedar Rapids from June 11-16.

LUGNOTES

Heating Up: The Lugnuts have won three of their last four series, taking four of six at Great Lakes, winning four of six at home against Lake County, losing four of six at Fort Wayne, and then winning five of six against Peoria. All told, the Lugnuts have won 15 of their last 23 games and six of their last seven.

Welcome to the Show: Southpaw **Brady Basso**, who pitched for the Nuts in 2021, underwent Tommy John, and returned successfully last season, pitched one scoreless inning Friday night against Atlanta, striking out Marcel Ozuna, in his Major League Baseball debut. Brady became the third former Lugnut this season to reach the Majors (joining **Max Schuemann** and **Brett Harris**) and the 187th Major League Lugnut in franchise history.

Master Mason: 2022 Lugnut **Mason Miller** leads all MLB rookies in saves (11), recording 51 strikeouts while allowing only 13 hits and nine runs (six earned) in 26 innings for the Athletics. Miller is averaging an MLB-best 100.8 mph with his fastball, ranking at the top of MLB in xERA, xBA, chase percentage, whiff percentage, and strikeout percentage.

Prospecting: Over the weekend, MLB Pipeline added Lansing outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** to the Oakland Athletics' Top 30 prospect list, giving the Lugnuts six MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 25), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 28) and outfielder Buelvas (No. 30).

Pride of Palo Alto: 20-year-old **Henry Bolte**, who was named to the MLB Pipeline Prospect Team of the Week after going 9-for-19 against Peoria with three doubles, one homer and four walks, is leading the Midwest League with 46 runs scored and 97 total bases. Bolte is tied for 2nd in the league in base hits (54) and, interestingly, is tied for 2nd in both extra-base hits (24) and doubles (13) with teammate **Brayan Buelvas**. Henry is also 4th in OPS (.947), 5th in slugging (.527), tied for 5th in walks (32) and tied for 6th in home runs (8).

Team Effort: The Nuts lead the Midwest League in triples (24) and are 2nd in walks (236), 2nd in runs scored (273), 2nd in hits (435), 2nd in total bases (672), 2nd in on-base percentage (.354), 3rd in slugging percentage (.397) and 2nd in team OPS (.751).

Without Missing a Beat: **Colton Johnson**, who did not pitch either of the last two years, is tied for 3rd in the Midwest League in appearances (18, with teammate **Yehizon Sanchez**) and tied for 2nd in saves (6).

Working His Way Back: Outfielder **Clark Elliott** spent the weekend rehabbing in the Arizona Complex League, going 2-for-4 with two singles and an RBI yesterday in a 5-4 win. Elliott played in 67 games for the Lugnuts last season, batting .195/.302/.247.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Drew Hutchison begins a stretch of four consecutive starts with six shutout innings (24 total IP, 3 BB, 35 K), allowing two hits and striking out nine Burlington Bees in a 6-0 Lugnuts win at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2017: No one had found a way to score against West Michigan ace closer Jason Foley (now starring with the Detroit Tigers) – until the Lugnuts scored three in the top of the ninth inning, including a tie-breaking Rodrigo Orozco squeeze (in Orozco's Lugnuts debut, no less!), to beat the Whitecaps, 8-6. It was the fireballing Foley's first blown save of the year. The game had seen the Nuts score five runs in the top of the first inning to knock out Eudis Idrogo, followed by four Whitecaps runs in the home half against Lansing starter Denis Diaz.

Retrospective: Signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023, and motored through four levels in his professional debut.

In a Nutshell: Glove this year is green and black to represent A's green and Lugnuts' black... opened 2024 on the Injured List, activated April 29... limiting right-handers to .195/.250/.268 (8-for-41, 3 BB, 10 K) compared to lefties (.257/.366/.400, 9-for-35, 1 HR, 6 BB, 8 K), though left-handed hitters are 1-for-their-last-10 against him... with bases empty: .302/.400/.465... with runners on base: .121/.171/.152.

Prospecting: Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... strikeouts high: 6, 6/20/23.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts.

2024 Notes: Opened the season in a piggyback tandem with Wander Guante, who was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 14... started May 18 and May 24 without a tandem-mate before piggybacking Luis Morales during last start... on May 24 at Fort Wayne, tossed one scoreless inning before game was suspended due to rain... in last appearance, May 29, needed only 39 pitches to fire five scoreless innings against Peoria... has a 9.20 ERA at home compared to 3.71 ERA on the road... lefties are hitting .319/.392/.493 with 2 HR, 9 BB, 10 K compared to righties (.218/.317/.309, 0 HR, 7 BB, 17 K)... with bases empty: .214/.304/.343, with runners on: .352/.429/.500.

Good Company: Shares March 3 birthday with Alexander Graham Bell (1847), Jackie Joyner-Kersey (1962), Herschel Walker (1962), Tone Loc (1966), Jessica Biel (1982), Camila Cabello (1997) and Jayson Tatum (1998).

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.
