Lake County led MiLB with an 86.8% stolen base 86.8% percentage last year. The Captains stole a franchiserecord 204 bases, while being caught just 31 times.

11 players join the Captains for the first time to begin the 2025 campaign. This group includes 5 of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 CLE prospects: OF **Jaison Chourio** (#3/#58 MLB), LHP **Jackson** Humphries (#18), LHP Michael Kennedy (#19), LHP Josh Hartle (#23), and OF Alfonsin Rosario (#26).

> 3 coaches join the Captains for the 2025 season in: Bench Coach Yan Rivera, Pitching Coach Andrew Moore, and Assistant Athletic Trainer Laura Gutiérrez-Sogel. Rivera was LC's Bench Coach for its 2022 MWL runner-up squad.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On Wednesday, Sept. 18, 2024, Lake County scored 5 runs in the 6th inning and 3 more in the 8th to power past Wisconsin 9-4 in the winner-take-all Game 3 of the 2024 Midwest League Championship Series at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake. This win secured the Captains' 2nd championship in franchise history, and 1st since 2010.

PLAYOFF DeLUCIA DELIVERS: RHP Dylan DeLucia (ND), the 2022 College World Series MOP at Ole Miss, had a strong start in Game 3 with a championship on the line for Lake County. The righthander pitched 4.2 scoreless innings, allowing just 3 hits and 1 walk, while throwing 5 strikeouts in 84 pitches (55 strikes). He also helped turn a 3-6-1 double play to end the top of the 4th inning and keep the game scoreless.

JOLTIN' JONAH: After hitting a go-ahead 2-run home run in Game 2 of the MWLCS, RF Jonah Advincula hit a game-tying solo shot in the bottom of the 5th inning. Advincula ranked 2nd on the Captains with a .500 AVG (4-for-8) and .667 OBP during the series, while leading the team in: R (6), TB (10), HR (2), SB (2), SLG (1.250),

WRECK-IT RALPH: 1B Ralphy Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 5 Cleveland prospect, hit a 3-run home run in the bottom of the 6th inning to extend Lake County's lead to 6-1. This was his 1st home run at Classic Auto Group Park, and the 1st of his professional ostseason career. The 19-year-old's 5 RBI were T-most in the 2024 Midwest League Playoffs.

TUNED IN: OF Wuilfredo Antunez went 1-for-4 with a go-ahead RBI double in the bottom of the 6th inning. He hit .462 (6-for-14) with 4 RBI in the MWLCS, and hit safely in each of Lake County's 5 postseason games. The 22-year-old's 8 hits were tied for most in the 2024 Midwest League Playoffs with Captains teammate

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: Tonight, the Captains begin their journey to potentially win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. *Lake* County will look to record the 7th instance of a franchise vinning consecutive MWL titles.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

THE 14-YEAR VOYAGE IS COMPLETE: The Captains won their 2nd championship in franchise history, and their 1st since 2010, the team's 1st year in the Midwest League. This year marked Lake County's 4th Midwest League Championship Series appearance, and 2nd in the last 3 seasons. The Captains also appeared in the 2003 South Atlantic League Championship Series in their 1st season as a franchise.

REGULAR SHOW: Lake County went 77-53 during the 2024 regular eason, owning the best winning percentage in the MWL for the 2nd time in the last 3 seasons. The Captains' 77 wins were tied with the 2010 MWL Championship team for the 2nd-most in a season in franchise history.

IO SCORE ZONE: Lake County led the Midwest League with a 3.55 ERA, securing its 2nd league ERA title and 1st since leading the South Atlantic League in 2003. Former Captain and current Double-A Akron RHP Trenton Denholm won the MWL individual ERA crown with a 3.29 RA, while fellow former Captain and current Double-A Akron RHP Carter Spivey finished 2nd with a 3.32 mark. Denholm was the 1st Captain to ead the MWL in ERA since the team joined the league in 2010.

TUGBOAT CRUISE: Last year, LHP Matt Wilkinson led MiLB with an average of 13.20 K/9 across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg. He also ranked 2nd in MiLB with 174 strikeouts, a 1.90 ERA, a .169 opposing AVG, and a 0.91 WHIP. Wilkinson nearly became the 1st Minor League pitcher to win both the MILB ERA and strikeout titles since eventual 3-time MLB All-Star and 2-time World Series Champion Josh Beckett did so in 2001 across Class A-Advanced Brevard County and Double-A Portland.

WELCOME BACK, OMIR!: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would be returning for his 3rd season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains franchise history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (**Ted Kubiak**, 2010). With a 142-117 (.548) record at the helm, **Santos is 29** victories away from becoming the winningest manager in Captains

CHAMPS BACK FOR ANOTHER: 17 of the 28 players on Lake County's 2025 Opening Day roster return from the Captains' 2024 Midwest League Championship team. This group includes 2 of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 CLE prospects in 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez and C Jacob Cozart.

M-V-P! M-V-P!: OF Jaison Chourio, MLB Pipeline's No. 3 Cleveland and No. 58 MLB prospect, had a remarkable season last year with the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The 19-year-old was named the 2024 Carolina League IVP and Top MLB Prospect, while also being named Baseball America's 2024 Cleveland Guardians Minor League Player of the Year.

NEW FACES FROM NEW PLACES: 3 players on Lake County's 2025 Opening Day roster were acquired in offseason trades. OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 26 Cleveland prospect, was acquired from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for former Captains and Guardians RHP Eli Morgan on Nov. 20, 2024. Then, on Dec. 10, LHP Michael Kennedy and .HP Josh Hartle, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 and 23 Cleveland prospects, respectively, were acquired from the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Guardians also received RHP Luis Ortiz as part of a trade package in exchange for

LAST TIME OUT: With the Captains facing elimination in Game 2 of the Midwest League Championship Series on September 17 vs. Wisconsin, **Matt Wilkinson** (1-0) pitched a pro career-high 6.2 innings, allowing 7 hits, 2 earned runs, and 2 walks, while throwing 5 strikeouts in an eventual 6-2 win. The left-hander's 2 earned runs allowed were courtesy of a pair of RBI singles, and his 96 pitches and 60 strikes were both pro career-highs as well.

A HISTORIC 2024 CAMPAIGN: Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, Wilkinson led qualified Minor League pitchers with 13.20 strikeouts per 9 innings and a 37.6% strikeout rate. He ranked 2nd in MiLB in: strikeouts (174), ERA (1.90), opposing AVG (.169), and WHIP (0.91). Wilkinson became the only MiLB pitcher with a 0.95-or-lower WHIP, 1.90-or-lower ERA, and at least 170 strikeouts in a season since at least 2005.

2024 HONORS: Wilkinson was named to the 2024 All-MiLB Prospect Second Team and Baseball America Second Team Minor League All-Star Team. He was also named a 2024 Midwest League All-Star, as well as MLB Pipeline's 2024 Cleveland Guardians Pitching Prospect of the Year. From his High-A debut on May 25 through the end of the regular season, Wilkinson led High-A in ERA (2.30) and opposing AVG (.174), while leading the Midwest League in strikeouts (103). He also finished 2nd in both the Midwest League and High-A in WHIP (0.98) during this span, going 5-5 in 16 regular season starts for Lake County.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Wilkinson is currently the No. 18 Cleveland prospect according to Baseball America. Baseball America on Wilkinson: "He's a functional mover on the mound despite his size and creates plenty of deception thanks to a low release height and crossfire landing. Wilkinson has a three-pitch mix that is uninspiring in a vacuum but effective in practice."

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels," MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote. "I love it, I love being called Tugboat," Wilkinson said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, 2024, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MiLB.com's Jesús Cano, Wilkinson became the 5th MiLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hit. The MLB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom Wilkinson said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (2015).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April 2024 as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing AVG. Wilkinson also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO), where he was 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year. In 2023, he went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts), and won the NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series in 2022. Following his 2023 campaign, Wilkinson eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat. "(The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," Wilkinson told The Daily Sentinel's James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

MORE ON WILKINSON: Wilkinson grew up in Ladner, British Columbia, the same hometown former longtime MLB LHP James Paxton. Has 2 Australian Kelpie dogs, Reggie and Mookie, named after Baseball Hall-of-Famer Reggie Jackson and 8-time MLB All-Star Mookie Betts.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains made their MLB debut during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006. Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, LHP Raymond Burgos made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. Burgos made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

INF Angel Martínez: On Saturday, June 22, **INF Angel Martínez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Toronto Blue Jays. He started at designated hitter and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. **Martínez** played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

INF/OF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
