NOTES AND NUGGETS

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

- Carter Jensen** joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he's hitting .274 (17-for-62) ... he leads the club with 7 homers and 21 RBI since arriving and ranks 2nd with 42 total bases, with 11 of 17 hits going for extra-bases.
- Dairon Blanco** is hitting .304 (17-for-56) since June 24 ... 10 of his 17 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 5 doubles, 1 triple and 4 home runs.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

- Omaha has successfully stolen 122 bases this year, and only been caught 22 times ... 122 steals rank 6th in the International League and 8th in Triple-A.
- 122-for-144 in steal attempts is a 84.7% success rate, the 2nd-best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and tied 5th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 86.6%, 84-for-97).

KICKSTART MY GAME

While Omaha's starting pitchers have combined for the 2nd-highest ERA in the league (5.95 ERA), there have been many good outings this year from Chaser starters.

- Omaha starters have pitched to a 2.30 ERA (11 ER in 43.0 IP) over the last 9 games (since July 9), with no starter allowing more than 3 ER in a game in that stretch.
- Thomas Hatch's** 6.2 innings of 2-run ball on Sunday marked his team-leading 7th quality start of the season, Omaha's 14th quality start of the year ... his 6.0 scoreless innings the start prior, July 11 vs. Toledo, marked the 11th time in 2025 a Storm Chasers starting pitcher threw 5.0 scoreless innings or more.
- When Omaha starters go at least 5.0 innings this year (45 times), the Storm Chasers are 22-23 ... the Chasers are 21-15 when the starter allows 3 runs or less. ... in the 2nd half (22 games), Omaha has gotten 11 starts of at least 5.0 innings from their starting pitcher, representing 5 of the team's 7 wins in the 2nd half.

JETTING OFF WITH JENSEN

Carter Jensen has been one of the hottest hitters in the Minors since the calendar flipped to July, after a slow start to his time in Triple-A.

- Among 910 full-season Minor League players that have taken at least 40 plate appearances in July, Jensen ranks 1st in slugging percentage (.950) and OPS (1.460), 7th in on-base percentage (.510) and 11th in batting average (.400).
- In 11 games since July 1, Jensen is hitting .400 (16-for-40) with 4 doubles, 6 homers and 20 RBI, while drawing 9 walks ... his 20 RBI this month are tied for the 3rd-most of any Minor League player and the most in the IL.
- Over his first 5 games with Omaha, Jensen went 1-for-22 (.045) with 1 homer and 10 strikeouts, between June 24 and 28 at Indianapolis.

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP

Dallas Keuchel made his Storm Chasers debut July 12, becoming the latest player with significant Major League service time to appear in a game for Omaha in 2025.

- With 10 years and 30 days of MLB service, Keuchel is the 2nd most experienced MLB pitcher to play for Omaha this year, trailing the recently promoted **Rich Hill** (14 years, 141 days MLB service) ... Keuchel is the 11th player to appear in a game for the Chasers this year with 4 or more years of MLB service (through 2024).
- Keuchel is the 14th player to appear in a game for Omaha this year at the age of 30 or older ... he is the 10th pitcher and the 6th to start a game on the mound for the Chasers ... by comparison, Omaha had 9 players in their 30's appear in a game both last year and in 2023.

MEET THE METS

This week, the Omaha Storm Chasers and Syracuse Mets face off for just the second time since Omaha joined the International League in 2021, after Omaha traveled to Syracuse from July 26 to 31, 2022 and the two teams split the series.

- In the July 2022 series, **Salvador Perez** played in 3 games with Omaha on Major League rehab, going 4-for-8, with 2 plate appearances against fellow MLB rehabber **Jacob deGrom**, who struck Salvy out twice, but allowed a 3-run homer to **Drew Waters**.
- In that previous series against the Mets, Waters went 8-for-22 (.364), leading Omaha on the week with 3 homers and 19 total bases, with 5 RBI and 7 walks ... he is 1 of 3 active Omaha players that played in that series (also: **Michael Massey** & **Dairon Blanco**).

TODAY'S START

- Gant is making his **10th start with Omaha** this season ... in May, the Royals purchased his contract from the independent Atlantic League's Long Island Ducks, where he began the season.
- Playing his **13th professional season this year** ... Royals are Gant's 5th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Mets, Braves, Cardinals and Twins ... as well as in Japan and Indy Ball ... has appeared in 173 Major League games from 2016 to 2021, debuting with Atlanta but pitching for St. Louis and Minnesota too.
- Originally drafted by the New York Mets out of high school in 2011, was traded twice over the span of 17 months to the Braves and then Cardinals ... has spent more time with the Cardinals than any other franchise.
- Prior to signing with Omaha in May, Gant last pitched in the Minor Leagues on June 15, 2018, making a quality start for the Memphis Redbirds on the road against the Albuquerque Isotopes ... last pitched in the Majors on October 1, 2021 for the Minnesota Twins.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, JULY 10 vs. TOLEDO

Made his 3rd scoreless start of the year, his 2nd straight shutout start, for a season-high 10.0 innings scoreless streak ... for the 2nd straight start, saw 3 double plays turned behind him, including one on the ground (4th inning) and a pair of flyout double plays (1st and 3rd innings) ... Toledo also had a runner caught stealing in the 5th ... put runners on in every inning but did not allow a run ... did not get any runs of support, exited the game in a 0-0 tie.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed with the Long Island Ducks (independent Atlantic League) in March 2025 ... over 4 starts with the Ducks, pitched to a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts, to just 5 walks ... his last 2 starts were quality starts.
- On May 17, the Long Island Ducks announced his contract has been purchased by the Royals organization ... joined the Storm Chasers this week for the road trip in Salt Lake City.
- Earned his first win with Omaha and threw a quality start on June 11 @ Toledo (DET), allowed a run on two hits to open his start and retired 11 of his last 12 batters, allowing just the 1 run.

CAREER NOTES

SINCE 2022

- Was outrighted off of the Twins' 40-man roster following the 2021 season and elected free agency ... signed with the Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan on December 10, 2021.
- Dealt with injuries and did not pitch with the Fighters in 2022, but re-signed a one-year contract extension in November 2022 ... only made 3 appearances for the farm team in 2023, with 11 strikeouts in 9.2 innings.
- Released by the Japanese team on July 1, 2023 and did not pitch in a professional game again until April 2025.

MAJOR LEAGUE CAREER

- After being traded from the Braves to the Mets in the summer of 2015, Made Atlanta's 2016 Opening Day roster, despite never having pitched above Double-A ... threw a scoreless inning in his MLB debut on April 6, 2016 against the Washington Nationals, in the second game of the 2016 season.
- After making his MLB debut in 2016, made just 39 Minor League appearances (36 starts) between 2016 and 2018 ... exclusively pitched in the big leagues from June 2018 through the end of the 2021 season (139 games).
- Led all MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins in 2019 ... was the most wins by a relief pitcher in the National League since Tyler Clippard had 11 for the Nationals in 2010.
- A starting pitcher coming up through the Minors, opened the 2019 season in the Cardinals' bullpen and made 81 consecutive relief appearances between 2019 and 2020, before moving back to the rotation to open 2021.
- Has 2 hits in the Major Leagues ... both were home runs and came in a 4-start span, the only pitcher in MLB to hit multiple home runs in the month of August 2018.
