TODAY'S GAME

After evening the series at 1-1 with a victory last night, the Bulls face the Jumbo Shrimp for the 3rd game of their 6-game series at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. LHP **Dalton Moats** (0-0, 0.00) is scheduled to start for Durham, with Jacksonville expected to turn to RHP **Jeff Lindgren** (0-0, 7.71).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

Durham defeated Jacksonville 10-5 to even the series thanks to a season-high 4 home runs. 3B Isaac Paredes (2-5, 2 R, 2B, HR, 2 RBI), RF Ruben Cardenas (2-3, 2 R, 3B, HR,3 RBI), C Ford Proctor (2-4, R, RBI) & 2B Miles Mastrobuoni (2-4, 2B, RBI) each posted multi-hit efforts in the victory, with 8 of 9 batters in the order tallying at least 1 knock. LF Niko Hulsizer homered in his 1st Triple-A at-bat, with SS Tristan Gray joining Paredes and Cardenas in crushing longballs in the win. Bulls righty Calvin Faucher (2.0 IP, 2 H, R, 0 ER, 2 K) earned the victory, while Jumbo Shrimp starter Braxton Garrett (5.0 IP, 7 H, 6 R, 6 ER, BB, 4 K) suffered the defeat. Jacksonville 2B Erik Gonzalez (3-4, R, HR, 2 RBI) posted a game-high 3 hits.

BULLS VS. JUMBO SHRIMP

After facing the Jumbo Shrimp 36 times in 2021, Durham begins their 2022 home slate versus Jacksonville. The Bulls posted a 21-15 record against the Jumbo Shrimp last year, including a 10-8 clip at the DBAP. In 14 games versus Jacksonville last year, INF **Miles Mastrobuoni** hit .311 (14-45) with 6 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple & 4 RBI, along with 7 walks & a .404 OBP. C **Rene Pinto** hit .318 (14-44) with 8 runs, 3 doubles, 5 homers & 11 RBI in 11 tilts with the Jumbo Shrimp. INF **Tristan Gray** bashed 5 of his 8 total longballs last year against Jacksonville.

BILL ET POINT

- 6 of INF **Tristan Gray**'s 10 career home runs at the Triple-A level have come off of Jacksonville pitching dating back to last season.
- 3 of Gray's last 4 longballs going back to 2021 have also come against Jacksonville.
- ■25 of Durham's 34 runs scored this season have come in the 5th inning or later.
- The Bulls have outscored their opponents 25-16 in the 5th inning or later, while their adversaries have outscored Durham 17-9 in the 1st 4 innings of contests this season.
- Durham designated hitters have combined for a .161 batting average (5-21) in 8 games thus far.
- Bulls catchers have tallied a .345 clip (10-29) in 2022, which ranks 2nd-best among Triple-A squads.
- Bulls relievers have combined for a 3.49 ERA (49.0 IP) this season, compared to a 5.59 ERA for starting pitchers thus far in 2022.

CHICKS DIG THE LONGBALL

Durham clubbed 4 home runs last night, their highest single-game total of the 2022 campaign. Bulls batters had totaled 4 roundtrippers through their 1st 7 games of the year prior to last night. Durham last season smashed 4 or more big flies in 7 contests, and finished 3rd among Triple-A East clubs with 183 home runs.

SOCKING ISAAC

With his home run last night, INF **Isaac Paredes** has collected at least 1 hit in 5 of his 1st 6 games with the Bulls since being acquired by Tampa Bay in a 4/4 trade from Detroit. He has also reached base via a hit or walk in all 6 contests. 5 of Paredes' 8 knocks have gone for extra bases, including 2 doubles, 1 triple & 2 homers. Overall he has reached base in 13 of his 28 plate appearances, good for a .464 OBP, along with a .783 SLG & 1.247 OPS. Paredes enters play today ranked 5th in the International League in OPS, 6th in SLG & 9th in OBP.

WELCOME TO THE TEAM!

OF **Niko Hulsizer** bashed his 1st career Triple-A home run in his very 1st at-bat with the Bulls last night. Prior to Hulsizer, the last Durham player to homer in his 1st Triple-A at-bat was C **Rene Pinto** on 7/7/21 at Norfolk. Hulsizer last season crushed 21 home runs between Bowling Green (A+) & Montgomery (AA), which ranked 7th-most among Rays minor league players.

CRUSHING CARDENAS

OF **Ruben Cardenas** also smashed his 1st Triple-A home run of his career in last night's victory. Last season he combined for a career-high 25 big flies between Bowling Green (A+) & Montgomery (AA), which ranked 2nd-most among all Rays minor league players behind only former Durham INF/OF **Dalton Kelly** (27). In his career he has totaled 39 roundtrippers in 327 games dating back to 2018.

FORD TOUGH

C Ford Proctor has reached base via a hit or walk in 5 of his 1st 6 games with the Bulls this year. Overall he has recorded a hit or walk in 12 of his 24 plate appearances, posting a .400 average (8-20) along with a .500 OBP, .450 SLG & .950 OPS. Proctor enters play today ranked 5th in the International League in batting average & 7th in OBP.

No Place Like Home

C Rene Pinto in 28 games at the DBAP between 2021-22 has combined for a .330 average (34-103) with 14 runs, 9 doubles, 6 homers & 13 RBI. Pinto has recorded at least 1 hit in 23 of his 28 career contests at Durham Bulls Athletic Park, which included at least 1 knock in 15 of his 1st 16 games in Durham.
