YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox dropped their third straight in a 6-3 loss to the Hartford Yard Goats on Wednesday night. Five of the six Yard Goats runs came in the fifth against starting right-hander **Trace Bright**, including a grand slam from Hartford's Cole Carrigg. Bright struck out a season-high six in five innings pitched. **Hudson Haskin** collected a pair of doubles and an RBI and **Adam Retzbach** tripled in a run. Chesapeake has now lost eight of its last 11.

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** hit his eighth double of the regular season last night, which puts him in a tie for the league lead. The Orioles No. 12 prospect has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games. His 10-game hit streak and 15-game on-base streak ended on Tuesday, which is fourth-longest and third-longest in the league, respectively. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

ACTION JACKSON

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is tied for 11th in the Eastern League in hits (22) and is tied for the league lead in doubles (8) to start the season. Jackson has struck out only 11 times in 93 total plate appearances (11.8% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career. **The former Angels and Mets farmhand is three homers away from 100 on his career.**

ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 18 of the 23 games played this season, which is second-most in the Eastern League lead behind Erie. **The Baysox staff has punched out the fourth-most hitters in the league (225) while the bullpen has the third-lowest ERA in the circuit (2.84).** The Baysox are also the only Double-A team that has yet to blow a save (9 saves in 9 chances).

WALK THIS WAY

C **Silas Ardoin** drew nine walks last week against Altoona pitching, which was the most by any Double-A hitter. Ardoin has drawn 10 walks over his last seven games played. The 24-year-old currently leads the Eastern League in walks (18) which has bumped his OBP to 12th-best in the league (.386).

GOING LONG

RHP **Ryan Long** is set to make his fifth start of the season and the second of his career against Hartford. The 25-year-old has thrown five innings in three straight starts and has walked only one batter in that span. On the season, Long has allowed just three walks in 18.2 innings. The Orioles 17th rounder in 2021 faced Hartford once last year and gave up six runs (five earned) on nine hits in 3.2 innings of work.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (67), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with **eight** so far this season. Last year, the Baysox had the third-most one-run wins in the Eastern League (25).

THE GOATS ARE GOING YARD

The Hartford Yard Goats are the Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. The Yard Goats most recently split their road trip in Somerset. Hartford won the first half of the season last year but lost in the Northeast Division Finals to Somerset. Hartford's active roster features five Rockies' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): OF/SS Cole Carrigg (No. 3), OF Benny Montgomery (No. 15), RHP Gabriel Hughes (No. 16), IF Kyle Karros (No. 20) and RHP Jack Mahoney (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Mason Albright makes his fifth start of the season and the second of his career against Chesapeake. The 22-year-old has pitched at least five innings in three consecutive starts and has not allowed more than two runs in each of those outings. Last time against the Baysox, Albright could not get past the first inning as he recorded only two outs while allowing six runs on three hits and three walks. The Frederick, MD native threw the eighth-most innings in the Rockies system last year (115.2).

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasma De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasma de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
