Rumbling into Binghamton

The Fightin Phils are back on the road and continue a six-game series at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies today. It is the fifth of 18 matchups with the Rumble Ponies this season, with 12 at Mirabito Stadium and six at home. Reading and Binghamton played 18 times last season and the Rumble Ponies took the season-series 14-4. Noah Skirrow makes the start for Reading, opposite Justin Jarvis for Binghamton.

Two in a Row

Reading won its second-straight game 8-2 Friday night, in what was the most complete effort of the season. R-Phils pitcher set a new season high with 16 strikeouts, including nine by Robinson Pina. Reading was also 5-11 with RISP, which had been a struggle spot this season. Additionally, Reading scored first for just the third time this season and won its first game when doing so (1-2). Reading's 11 hits were also a season-high.

Lazar'd In

Max Lazar tossed two more shutout innings on Friday night's win. Through four games, he remains the only Fightin Phils pitcher to not allow a hit, nor run this season. He also owns a 12-0 strikeout to walk ratio over six-innings pitched.

Rincones Rolling

Gabriel Rincones Jr. stayed hot Friday night with a hit and run scored. Over his last five games, Rincones Jr. is slashing .350/.409/.600 with a 1.009 OPS, while adding a homer, two doubles and two RBI. Rincones Jr. also currently has an nine-game on-base streak.

Can't Stop Carson

Carson Taylor's hot start to the 2024 season continued on Friday night. He went 3-5, with a run scored, double and three RBI. Over his last five games, Taylor is hitting .474, and is .407 in his last 10 contests. He now owns a seven-game hitting streak, three multi-hit games and three multi-RBI game as well. Taylor is also hitting .667 with runners in scoring position and .400 with two outs.

Lee Sang's Night

Marcus Lee Sang had a strong night Thursday night in the doubleheader. Between the two games, he went 2-5, with three runs scored, a triple, homer, a RBI and two walks. His homer and triple were both his first of the season for each. The triple also marked the first triple hit by a member of the R-Phils in 2024. Lee Sang has now reached base in 12-of-13 games he's played in this season.

Good Night for Razorbacks

Former Arkansas teammates Casey Martin and Robert Moore had a strong Friday night for the Fightin Phils. The duo combined to go 3-9, with two runs scored, a homer and two RBI. Martin's homer and two-hit game snapped a 1-21 start to the season for the 2020 first round pick. Moore has now reached base in seven-straight games and owns an eight-game hit streak.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 20, 2012: At Reading, the R-Phils rally from a 3-0 deficit after seven innings to beat Akron, 4-3 in 10. Troy Hanzawa's 2-out, 2-run single in the 9th ties it and Steve Susdorf doubles home Darin Ruf with one out in the 10th to give Reading its 11th win in 15 games.

Breakdown on Binghamton

Binghamton enters tonight with a 5-7 record, after going 2-3 at Erie last week. After this week, the Rumble Ponies head to New Hampshire. Binghamton finished 74-61 last season and ultimately lost to Erie in the Eastern League Championship. Seven of the Mets' top-30 prospects are on Binghamton's roster, featuring: Jett Williams (1), Kevin Parada (9), Blade Tidwell (10), Alex Ramirez (16), Tyler Stuart (18), Joander Suarez (28) and Rhylan Thomas (30).

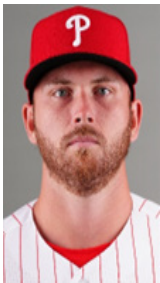
Ponies Pitcher

Righty Justin Jarvis makes the start today for Binghamton. In his first appearance of the season on Apr. 14 at Erie, Jarvis suffered the loss, going 2.2 innings and allowing two hits and one run in relief. Jarvis was traded from the Brewers to Mets last season for Mark Canha. He split 2023 between Double-A Biloxi, Triple-A Nashville and Triple-A Syracuse. He combined to go 6-11, with a 5.31 ERA over 26 starts. The 24-year old was drafted by the Brewers in the fifth round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

2024 Notes: Started season on Triple-A Lehigh Valley's Development List. Activated off Development List and transferred to Double-A Reading Apr. 9. Made first start same night against Portland. Roughed up by Sea Dogs, surrendering seven hits and four-earned runs in just 2.1 innings of work. Threw strikes on 60% of pitches in no decision. Early-season struggles continued on Apr. 14 vs Portland, when he lasted just two innings, and allowed three-earned runs on seven hits. Fell victim to defensive miscues as well in loss.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by the Philadelphia Phillies as an undrafted free agent to a minor league contract on June 16, 2020.

2023: Pitched the entire season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley. Led the team in wins, strikeouts and innings pitched.

2022: Spent majority of the season with Double-A Reading. Amongst all Phillies minor league pitchers, ranked first in games started (25) and innings pitched (119.2) and was second in strikeouts (133). Was on the injured list with a right ankle contusion from May 12-20. Promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5.

2021: Began professional career with High-A Jersey Shore. Was on the injured list from June 18 through July 16 with right biceps tendinitis, which included a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Phillies (ROK). Promoted to Reading on July 23 and transferred back to Jersey Shore on September 7. Overall, he struck out 60 over 58 innings pitched. In eight relief appearances, he posted a 3.13 ERA (8 ER, 23.0 IP)

2020: Did not pitch as season was cancelled due to COVID-19 Pandemic. Participated in the Florida Instructional League.

Appeared in 16 games and started 15 for Liberty in 2019 and went 5-6 with a 3.76 ERA. In 2019, led the Atlantic Sun Conference with 11.50 strikeouts per nine innings pitched (98 SO/76.2 IP).
