EXPRESS TOPPLE RAINIERS, 8-1

The Express earned back-to-back wins over the Rainiers with an 8-1 win on Thursday night. Round Rock started the scoring in the bottom of the second. RF Trevor Hauver got aboard with a single then 2B Alan Treio cleared the bags with a two-run homer. Later, LF Alex De Goti drove DH Billy McKinney in with a single and the Express led 3-0 after two. The Express plated two more in the sixth on Trejo's RBI double and an RBI single from C Cooper Johnson, extending Round Rock's lead to 5-0. Tacoma got on the board in the top of the seventh. CF Leody Taveras singled and DH Austin Shenton drew a walk, setting up C Blake Hunt for an RBI single. In the bottom of the seventh, Round Rock PH Cody Freeman delivered a two-run single through the left side to scratch two more runs across. 1B Blaine Crim, who reached via an intentional walk, later scored on a 2B Samad Taylor throwing error moving the E-Train advantage to 8-1. RHP Codi Heuer shut the door for Round Rock tossing a scoreless ninth as the E-Train took a series lead in Thursday's 8-1 victory.

PLASS TAKES THE BUMP

Round Rock LHP Michael Plassmeyer is scheduled for his 16th apearance and sixth start tonight. Plassmeyer has been in a starting role in three of his last four outings. As a starter, the 28-year-old is O-1 with a 5.71 ERA (11 ER/17.1 IP) compared to 3-0 with a 3.71 ERA (11 ER/26.2 IP) as a reliever.

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

After dropping eight of their last nine going into Wednesday's game, the Express have won back-to-back games and have combined for 21 runs on 29 hits in the two victories. With a win tonight, the E-Train will collect their fourth winning streak of three games or more. They are looking for their first series win since April 15-20 at Reno and their first home series win since April 1-6 vs Toledo.

ALAN IS ON IT

Round Rock INF Alan Trejo is 5-for-12 with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, three runs scored and two strikeouts in the first three games of this series. It's the first time he has had a home run in consecutive games since August 19-20, 2022 while playing for Albuquerque in Tacoma. The 29-year-old has eight home runs against the Rainiers in 18 games for his career since 2021.

Round Rock's offense is averaging 6.9 runs per game this month. They own an .831 OPS in June. They entered the month with an OPS of .744. They have seven players in June with an OPS over .800.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
