LAST NIGHT: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (11-12) defeated the Midland RockHounds (17-6), 10-2, on Wednesday night at Momentum Bank Ballpark. Amarillo struck first this evening, using an **Angel Ortiz** sac fly for the 1-0 lead. The RockHounds equalized as Ryan Lasko tripled and later scored on a balk. In the third, **Junior Franco** scored on a **Drew Jones** triple to right-center. **Cristofer Torin** followed with a sac fly for the 3-1 Amarillo advantage. A trio of base knocks led off the top of the fifth, resulting in a Torin RBI single that extended the Amarillo lead. With the bases chucked and two away later in the inning, **Gavin Conticello** came through with a single to center, bringing two more runs across for the 6-1 edge. **Antonio Menendez** two perfect innings in the fifth and sixth innings. While Midland scratched a run in the seventh, the four-run Amarillo eighth inning was highlighted by a Jones two-run bomb that completed the first cycle in Sod Poodles history and a Torin solo blast to go back-to-back, pushing the run total to 10 and evening the series with the RockHounds.

SUMMARY

- ▶ Traded along with LHP Brandyn Garcia from the Seattle Mariners to the Arizona Diamondbacks on July 24, 2025 in return for Josh Naylor.
- ▶ Selected by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round (126th ovr.) of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oswego East High School...agreed to a \$1.10 million signing bonus.
- ▶ Was committed to play college baseball at Wichita State.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Turned in his worst start in his young Double-A career, allowing season-highs in runs (5), earned runs (5), hits (7), and walks (3) over 5.0 innings pitched.
- ▶ Has still yet to earn a decision with the Sod Poodles as Amarillo took the lead for good on a two-run error by San Antonio in the top of the sixth.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Started the season with the Everett AquaSox...made his first start on May 1, where he threw three scoreless innings against the Eugene Emeralds.
- ▶ Earned his first win of the campaign three starts later...he blanked the Hillsboro Hops over five full frames, allowing just three hits and striking out five.
- ▶ Finished the month of May with a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP).
- ▶ Matched the longest outing of his career on August 19...tossed 6.2 innings, allowing four runs (two earned).
- ▶ Set a career-high in strikeouts on September 2 by punching nine tickets and allowing just two baserunners over six full frames.
- ▶ Started all 18 games he appeared in, finishing with a 3-6 record and a 4.80 ERA.

BRINGING HOME HARDWARE

- ▶ Won the Northwest League Pitcher of the Week award for the week of September 7, 2025 after setting a career-high in strikeouts (9) five days prior.
- ▶ Took home the California League Pitcher of the Week award for the week of June 2, 2024...tossed 5.0 no-hit innings on June 2 as he earned the win for the Single-A Modesto Nuts in a 7-6 victory over the Stockton Ports.

BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

- ▶ At Oswego East High School in Illinois, Izzi shared a spot in the rotation with fellow 2022 MLB Draft pick Noah Schultz...the latter was picked 26th overall to the Chicago White Sox and made his major league debut with the South Siders on April 14, 2026.
