LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox hit four homers and nearly overcame a seven-run deficit in a 13-12 loss to Somerset on Wednesday to even the series. Bowie trailed 10-3 through two and a half innings after Somerset scored seven in the top of the third. The Baysox trimmed the deficit down to two before Somerset tacked on three more for good measure. **TT Bowens** hit two homers and drove in six RBI, including a grand slam. **Frederick Bencosme** tallied four hits and **Ryan Higgins** homered for the third time in five games.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for the 10th-most hits in the Eastern League (86). On Tuesday, Basallo recorded his fourth three-hit game at Double-A with three singles. The No. 2 O's/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 4th-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (13) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit homers in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in '18.

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is the Eastern League's active leader in home runs and is tied for fifth in all of Double-A after hitting his 16th of the season on Tuesday. The O's No. 8 prospect has 31 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** registered his first multi-homer game of his career last Wednesday in Akron with his 10th and 11th homers of the season, matching his season total from last year. The 22-year-old has reached base in 67 of 83 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (45) and stolen bases (23), tied for 6th-most and tied for 4th-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

BOWENS BATS 'EM IN

1B/OF **TT Bowens** delivered arguably his best performance of his career on Wednesday. The 26-year-old recorded his first multi-homer game, his first grand slam and his first six RBI game of his career. His 51 RBI and 31 extra base hits this season are both tied for 9th-most in the Eastern League.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** recorded his first four-hit game at Double-A with a 4-for-5 afternoon on Wednesday, including his fifth homer of the season. The Orioles No. 24 prospect is on a seven-game hitting streak. During his hit streak, he's batting .407 (11-for-27) with four doubles, a homer and four RBI.

YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** has been one of the best strikeout throwers in the Eastern League and in Double-A. The Orioles No. 20 prospect has 102 strikeouts on the season, which is 5th-most in the Eastern League and 9th-most in all of Double-A. He earned Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors on July 15 after pitching six scoreless innings over one hit and six strikeouts on July 11 at Altoona. Pham holds a 3.21 career ERA in three starts against Somerset.

PREVIEWING THE PATRIOTS

Entering this week, the Somerset Patriots are 0.5 game out of the Northeast Division lead with a second-half record of 16-11. The Patriots share the league lead for the most homers this season and own the third-best OPS. Five of the Yankees top 30 prospects are on the Patriots active roster - OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 19), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 20), IF Tyler Hardman (No. 25), RHP Danny Watson (No. 27)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Zach Messinger makes his 19th start of the season for the Patriots. The Yankees No. 19 prospect is tied for the third-most innings thrown in the Eastern League (107.2), has struck out the fourth-most batters in the circuit (106), and owns the fifth-lowest WHIP (1.15). Messinger has gone at least six innings in six starts this season. Against Bowie on May 29, Messinger dealt 5.1 innings and struck out a season-high 10 over one run on six hits and two walks in a no decision.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
