HELLO MR. CELERY: The Hudson Valley Renegades continue their 12-game span. The Somerset Patriots (NYY-AA) sit fifth with a 3.40 ERA. road trip with a six-game series against the Wilmington Blue Rocks this week. It's the second visit to Frawley Stadium this season for Hudson Valley who took four out of six games from them back in May. The 'Gades will make one more trip to Delaware this season at the end of August.

SIMPLY SOUTHERN: In 18 games in SAL South ballparks this year, the Renegades (39.8%) during their trips south, representing 17.0% of games played.

STARTERS FEAST: In the first three games of this series versus the Wilmington Blue Rocks, the 'Gades starting rotation has allowed just two earned runs in 17.1 innings tossed. That mark is good for a 1.04 ERA which ranks third in High-A behind the Tri-City Dust Devils (LAA--A+) and West Michigan Whitecaps (DET--A+) who have yet to allow a run.

ANOTHER ONE: On Tuesday, Luis Velasquez was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for the week of July 24 - 30. The right-hander had a dominant week out of the bullpen, tossing 5.2 scoreless frames across two games versus the Hickory Crawdads. He earned the win in both of the Renegades' shutout victories and he punched out an impressive 47.1% of batters faced last week. Velasquez are averaging 8.00 runs/game. > WIDE MARGINS: In the last series against the Hickory Crawdads, the Renegades outscored the Crawdads 51-21 (+30). Hudson Valley shut out the Texas Rangers High-A affiliate twice in the series, including a 6-0 victory on Sunday.

> **NEW KID ON THE BLOCK:** Since his promotion from Single-A Tampa on June 29th, Agustin Ramírez is 39-for-103 (.379) with 10 doubles, eight home runs, 21 RBIs, eight walks, and 20 runs in 25 games. He recorded a hit and reached base safely in his first six games while also already collecting 12 multi-contests in his brief time in High-A.

> HE GETS ON BASE!: Ben Cowles currently holds the Renegades longest active on-base streak at 21 games. The former Maryland Terrapin has reached base in every game since July 4 in Jersey Shore. He surpassed Rafael Flores who held the longest on-base streak by a Renegade hitter prior at 18 games. It's currently the longest streak in the South Atlantic League, and the fifth-longest in High-A.

> HOME RUN BUG: After hitting 11 home runs in their first nine games out of the All-Star break, the Renegades hit 19 in six games versus the Hickory Crawdads. The team's 34 home runs since the All-Star Break are the most in High-A and second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. The Syracuse Mets (NYM--AAA) lead the way with 36 blasts.

LIGHTS OUT: The Hudson Valley Renegades blanked the Wilmington Blue Rocks 3-0 on Wednesday night for their 11th shutout of the season. The 11 shutouts are tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. The West Michigan (34), doubles (10), total bases (62), slugging percentage, and OPS (1.223). The backstop tallied 11 multi-hit games in 20 games. Whitecaps (DET-A+) lead the way with 13. The 'Gades pitching staff has blanked a team four times over the last 11 games, which is tied for the most with the Tri-City Dust Devils (LAA--A+) during this span.

.....RENEGADES STARTING PITCHER.....

DREW THORPE · RHP · 6'4" · 190 LBS · 22

LAST TIME OUT: Thorpe suffered through the worst start of his professional career last Saturday at Hickory, getting touched up for eight runs on nine hits, including three home runs in an 8-6 loss. The Crawdads jumped on Thorpe for four runs in the first and two more in the second, and in total had seven extra-base hits against the right-hander. After falling behind 6-0 early, the Renegades were mounting a comeback when intense rain came and ended the game early after only five innings.

THOU SHALL NOT PASS: From the start of June through July 22, Thorpe was 7-0 with a 0.65 ERA (4 ER/55.2 IP) with 27 H, 13 BB and 72 K. In that span he led Minor League pitchers in IP, K, and ERA (min. 30 IP).

YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON THORPE: "The first thing that sticks out in my mind about Thorpe is he's just a competitor. You always want those kinds of guys. New York is a really tough place to play so you want to draft and sign guys that have a makeup that says that this guy is going to be able to handle pitching there and Thorpe hands down has that. He's really impressive out there, nothing rattles him. And then on top of that the secondary pitches are great. The changeup was a weapon to both hands in college, he's a high raw spin guy, the slider is disgusting. He throws two kinds of sliders — he does throw the sweepier one and he has the shorter, tighter one and he just has such command of the zone with those offspeed pitches. It makes it really tough when you've got three different shapes there that are all going in different directions and he can move them around in the zone. As a hitter you can't really sit on anything and it's been awesome to watch."
