ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: A three-run first and a five-run fifth backed a solid outing from #9 Blue Jays prospect Adam Kloffenstein as the Vancouver Canadians took care of business with a 9-4 win over the Spokane Indians (Rockies) Friday night at Avista Stadium.

After getting shutout for just the second time this season in yesterday's game, the C's wasted no time scoring in this one. Consecutive walks started the game before Cameron Eden launched a three-run home run to left field that put Vancouver up 3-0.

Staked to a 3-0 lead before throwing a pitch, Kloffenstein (W, 2-3) turned in a sterling showing in which he allowed one run on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts.

The Canadians added to their lead with the second five-run inning of the series. Sebastian Espino started the fifth with a triple and scored on a Ronny Brito double. After an error brought Brito in, back-to-back singles from Tanner Kirwer and Phil Clarke loaded the bases before Eden worked a walk to force in a run. Tanner Morris followed with an RBI single before Ryan Gold made it 8-0 C's with a sacrifice fly.

Kloffenstein - whose lone earned run scored in the bottom of the fifth on a hit batter, a walk and a double - passed the baton to Marcus Reyes, who hung a pair of zeroes in the sixth and seventh before Vancouver added an insurance run in the eighth thanks to two singles, an error and a Brito sacrifice fly that gave the Canadians a 9-1 advantage.

Justin Maese faced the minimum in the eighth before running into trouble in the ninth. The right-hander saw the first six batters of the bottom of the ninth reach base and three runs come across before Parker Caracci (S, 4) was called upon with the bases loaded, no outs and Vancouver up 9-4. The Jackson, MS native caught a line drive on the first pitch he threw and turned it into a 1-3 double play after the runner at first was caught off the bag. A ground out followed, and Vancouver emerged with a 9-4 win.

HASTA AVISTA: Vancouver arrives in Spokane this week for the first of two visits to Avista Stadium and the second of five meetings with the Indians. These two teams last met May 11-16 at Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro, when the C's took the last five games of the series after dropping the home-away-from-home opener. The Canadians have outscored the Rockies affiliate 54-36 in the season series.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY: June 12, 1839 - Due to an erroneous eye-witness account, Abner Doubleday is given credit for establishing the first baseball game is played in America. Although it is doubtful the West Point cadet was ever there or ever watched a baseball game, the Hall of Fame, which opens a century later in Cooperstown, celebrates the origin of our national pastime in this small upstate New York town.

DID YOU KNOW?: C's skipper Donnie Murphy made his pro debut for Spokane in 2002 after he was drafted by the Royals in the 5th round that year. 19-year-old Murph hit .303 with 10 doubles, two triples, 12 runs scored and 15 RBI in 28 games before he was promoted to Low-A Burlington. He made his MLB debut with Kansas City in 2004 and went on to play in parts of nine seasons with five different teams.

BOP IT: Cameron Eden hit Vancouver's 17th home run of the year last night.

TURN IT: The C's turned a season-high four double plays last night, including a crucial 1-3 DP in the ninth to derail a Spokane rally.

SPLIT IT: Yesterday's win secured a series split for Vancouver. Through their first five series, the Canadians have won two (Spokane, Hillsboro), split two (Tri-City, Everett) and lost one (Eugene).

OUCH: Three hitter were plunked by Canadians pitching yesterday, a season high.

ON THE HILL: Right-hander Sam Ryan makes his first start of the year tonight for Vancouver after working exclusively out of the bullpen for the C's and for Double-A New Hampshire. Since returning from his stint with the Fisher Cats, Ryan has logged eight and innings and allowed five earned runs on nine hits with 1 strikeouts. Ryan, 22, last started a professional game on August 27, 2019 when he toed the slab for Rookie Bluefield and allowed four runs on seven hits with one walk and five strikeouts across five innings pitched. The VCU alum was a 12th round pick in 2019.

Southpaw Nick Bush goes for Spokane. He last faced the C's on May 12 in Hillsboro, when he tossed four shutout innings, scattered four hits, issued no walks and struck out eight.
