**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** OF **Matt Rudick** ripped a line drive over the leftfielders head, plating OF **Jaylen Palmer** in the bottom of the ninth en route to a 3-2 walk-off victory over Hudson Valley to vault into first place by a half game. RHP **Trey McLoughlin** pitched a career-high 4 1/3 innings of relief in his High-A debut, striking out 33% of the batters he faced. Palmer cracked his eighth home run of the year, a solo shot, early in the game and finished with two runs scored. After the four games, the series is tied a two games apiece.

**SUBWAY SERIES:** For the final time in 2022, the Cyclones face the Hudson Valley Renegades. Last series, at Dutchess Stadium, the Cyclones won four out of six, winning a series at the home of the Renegades for the first time since the 2019 season. This year, Brooklyn has won 14 and Hudson Valley has won 14 game and with the run differential favoring Brooklyn by +3.

**DIVISION ON THE LINE:** Including today, the Cyclones have 20 games remaining and four series: two more vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting atop the division by a half game over Hudson Valley and a game over Aberdeen.

**HOW RUDE!:** In August, OF **Matt Rudick** has a whopping .439 on-base percentage and a .873 OPS over 14 contests. Rudick has been on base in nine consecutive games and is hitting .321 (17-53). In the stretch, Rudick has raised his batting average from .205 to .232.

**PEROZA PRODUCING:** Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .860 over his past 32 games with an 19-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 30 of the past 32 games, hitting .296 with a .390 OBP. The current

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The New York Yankees affiliate host five of the Bronx Bombers' Top 30 prospects, including two in the top 10. OF Jasson Dominguez ranks second in the system and 42nd in baseball. SS Trey Sweeney ranks No. 6, LHP Yoendrys Gomez ranks No. 12, LHP Edgar Barclay ranks No. 29, and RHP Juan Carela ranks No. 30. The Renegades finished the first half nine games behind division-winner Aberdeen.

active streak leader is Rome C **Tyler Tolve** who has a 24-game on-base streak.

**PALMER POP WHEN IT COUNTS:** OF Jaylen Palmer has come alive in the head-to-head series against Hudson Valley. Palmer has an .811 OPS against the Yankees affiliate, hitting five of his eight home runs, stealing eight of his 20 bases, and scoring 11 of his 31 runs.

**MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN:** The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks second in the North Division with a +12 run differential with Hudson Valley +20 at the top. The Cyclones have allowed just 183 runs over 46 games (4.0 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.3 runs per game in the second half.

**THAT'S OFFENSIVE!:** The Cyclones have scored just 440 runs in 112 games (3.9 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and fifth-worst in Minor League Baseball in fewest runs.

**TOUGH STRETCH:** Moreno has only thrown 5 2/3 innings combined over his past two starts, facing Winston-Salem and Wilmington. Moreno has struggled with command, walking five with just three strikeouts.

**AGAINST HV:** Moreno has made two starts against Hudson Valley, allowing just one earned run over 12 innings (0.75 ERA) with a 40% strikeout rate and a 3% walk rate (one walk against 40 batters).

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Luis Moreno won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the week for his performance at Hudson Valley between July 25-31.

**MORE-K-NO:** Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters at Hudson Valley on July 2 in his first appearance against the Yankees affiliate.

**WELCOME:** Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

**BIG YEAR:** The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as "quality starts."

**2022:** With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

**ELIMINATING HOMERS:** Moreno's 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

**JUMP IN:** Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
