**BIG BEN BUZZ:** Ben Hess enters today coming off his first quality start of the season and the third of his career at the Double-A level. On Sunday 8/2, Hess tossed a Double-A career-high 6.1 IP alongside a season-high 85 pitches. Hess worked 5.0+ innings for the fourth straight start. In that span, he's 2-2 with a 2.49 ERA, 0.92 WHIP and .211 BAA with 22 K to 4 BB in 21.1 IP. Over Hess' last six starts, he's posted a 2.97 ERA, 1.02 WHIP and .208 BAA with 29 K to 9 BB in 30.1 IP.

**BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS:** After Josh Moylan and Connor McGinnis both homered in the second inning on Thursday, Somerset now has 10 multi-home run innings this season. The Patriots have smashed multiple homers in 45 of 106 (42.5%) games this season. That surpasses Somerset's multiple homers in 35 of 138 (25.4%) games in 2025. Somerset's 151 homers this season are tied for the Double-A lead and rank eighth in MiLB.

**TWO-OUT TITANS:** On Wednesday and Thursday this week, Somerset scored the tying and winning runs in the 7th inning or later with two outs. Since the All-Star Break, Somerset's .324 AVG with two outs leads Double-A and ranks second in MiLB. Jackson Castillo's two-out homer in the eighth inning on Friday was Somerset's 14th two-out home run since the All-Star break resumption (7/17), tied for the most two-out homers in MiLB over that span.

**MR. DJ SONG PON DE REPLAY:** Fresh off winning Eastern League Player of the Week honors in his last series, DJ Gladney enters today on a team-high 10-game on-base streak. With hits in nine games during that stretch, Gladney is slashing .381/.409/.738 with 4 HR, 7 XBH and 12 RBI. On Friday, Gladney crashed his 19th home run of the season, tying his career-high mark for the third time (2022, 2023). Gladney's 19 HR and are tied for second among active Eastern League hitters and tied for third in the Yankees farm system.

**COBY, FOR THREE!** Coby Morales smacked his fourth triple of the season on Wednesday, before scoring on an RBI single from Luis Durango for Somerset's first run of the game in the eighth inning. Since the start of July, Morales' four triples lead Double-A and are tied for second in MiLB. Morales' 42 XBH rank second in the Yankees minor league system, while his four triples are tied for third.

**HOT ROD ROLLING IN:** Former top international free agent signing Roderick Arias was promoted to Double-A Somerset on Tuesday in his fifth minor league season. Arias, who signed for \$4 million out of the Dominican Republic in 2022 earned his first ever mid-season promotion by breaking camp with High-A Hudson Valley and slashing .271/.357/.441 with 12 HR, 32 XBH, 61 RBI, 54 R and 29 SB. Dating back to his time in Hudson Valley, Arias has hit safely in eight straight games over which he is slashing .394/.412/.606 with 6 XBH, 3 RBI with four multi-hit games.

**MOYLAN IS BOILING:** On Thursday, Josh Moylan clubbed his sixth Double-A home run and his career-high 19th overall home run this season, which ties him for the third-most among Yankees minor leaguers. With two hits in that game, Moylan registered his sixth multi-hit game with Somerset and 18th total this season. Across his last 16 games, Moylan is slashing .333/.354/.517 with 3 HR, 11 RBI, 5 XBH and four multi-hit games. During a five-game hit streak, Moylan is 6-for-19 at the plate.

**ACTON JACKSON:** Jackson Castillo ended a 29-game homerless drought on Friday night with his first home run since June 30th. He enters today on an eight-game on-base streak over which he has reached base in 14 of 35 plate appearances (.400 OBP).

**REAL COLE WORLD:** Cole Gabrielson returns to Somerset's lineup today for the first time since 7/26 @NH. Spanning to his two previous stints with the Patriots this season, Gabrielson has a seven-game hit streak (beginning on 6/14) over which he is 8-for-24 (.333) with 1 HR, 4 RBI and 8 R (.975 OPS). Gabrielson has reached safely in 14 of 17 games with Somerset this season, including 10 straight dating back to his June stint with the Patriots.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** Luis Durango snagged his career-high 40th stolen base of the season on Friday, ranking second in the Yankees farm system (Duke Ellis, 43). With a single in the game, Durango extended his on-base streak to eight games during which he's reached in 13 of 27 plate appearances (.481 OBP).

**CAREER YEAR:** DJ Gladney's 19th home run of the season on Friday tied a career-high mark for the third time in seven seasons of his career. Gladney is the 10th member of the Patriots this season to either match or surpass their career-high in home runs: Garrett Martin-21, Jace Avina-19, DJ Gladney-19, Josh Moylan-19, Coby Morales-18, George Lombard Jr.-12, Connor McGinnis-7, Kevin Verde-5, Owen Cobb-3, Manny Palencia-1. Roderick Arias and Jackson Castillo are both one homer away from tying career-highs.

**BULLPEN BUSINESS:** Across Tony Rossi's last nine outings, he has a 1.50 ERA, 2-0 record, 0.83 WHIP and .146 BAA with 11 K in 12.0 IP. Kevin Stevens has recorded four straight scoreless outings over which he's allowed 2 H with 6 K and 0 BB over 4.2 IP (0.43 WHIP, .133 BAA). Kelly Austin earned has posted five consecutive scoreless outings, over which he has allowed 4 H in 7.0 IP (.160 BAA). Across his last 17 outings since June 7 at Harrisburg, Austin has posted a 2.53 ERA, 1-0 record, 1.13 WHIP and .188 BAA with 20 K to 9 BB in 21.1 IP. Trent Sellers hurled two scoreless innings on Friday, marking his second straight scoreless outing. Across his last 10 appearances, Sellers has posted a 1.26 ERA and .157 BAA with 19 K in 14.1 IP.

## 2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

### JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

### MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

### DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.
