SATURDAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats completed a three-game sweep of the Altoona Curve with a 4-2 victory Saturday afternoon. Jimmy Robbins threw five shutout innings and allowed only two hits, two walks and struck out five, extending his scoreless inning streak to 17 consecutive innings dating back to last year. Luis De Los Santos hit the first home run of the season for the Fisher Cats, a two-run homer in the 5th. He ended the series with five extra base hits and six RBIs.

SERIES HIGHLIGHTS: New Hampshire pitching held Altoona to just four earned runs in 27 innings pitched, striking out 29 and stranding 32 runners. The four earned runs are the fewest allowed by an Eastern League pitching staff to start off the season. A big reason for the early success has been the performance from New Hampshire starting pitching. Starters Sem Robberse, Paxton Schultz, and Jimmy Robbins combined to pitch 13.2 innings of one-run ball with 19 strikeouts.

KING KLOFF: Tuesday night starter Adam Kloffenstein returns to New Hampshire for his second season with the Fisher Cats. Kloffenstein had a 5.54 ERA over 25 games (24 starts) across High-A Vancouver and Double-A New Hampshire last year, throwing 112 innings with 118 strikeouts over 55 walks. Kloffenstein arrived in New Hampshire on May 21 last year and finished out 2022 with the Fisher Cats, pitching 86 innings and striking out 88 over 19 games (18 starts). He threw the second-most innings and had the second-most strikeouts on the team last year.

STARTING STRONG: This is the fifth time in team history where the Fisher Cats have started out the season 3-0 (2004, 2009, 2010, 2018). The Fisher Cats record for best start is 5-0 back in 2018. New Hampshire has qualified for the postseason three of the four times after the Fisher Cats started 3-0. The Fisher Cats have made the postseason only four times in 18 seasons and won Eastern League titles in three out of the four postseason runs.

ROSTER AT A GLANCE: The Fisher Cats active roster features five of the Top 30 Blue Jays prospects, according to MLB.com: IF Orelvis Martinez (No. 4), RHP Sem Robberse (No. 7), IF Leo Jimenez (No. 19), RHP Adrian Hernandez (No. 23), and IF Damiano Palmegiani (No. 29). The roster is made up of 16 pitchers, four catchers, seven infielders and five outfielders. Players come from 14 different states, one US territory (Puerto Rico), and five countries outside the US (Dominican Republic, Venezuela, Mexico, Panama, Netherlands).

MUST-SEE MARTINEZ: IF Orelvis Martinez is ranked the No. 4 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2023 season. The 21-year-old Dominican Republic native hit a team-high 30 home runs last season, breaking the Fisher Cats single-season record of 27 home runs previously set by Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010). Martinez was second in the Eastern League in home runs and had four multi-homer games.

CESAR MARTIN LEADS FIELD STAFF: Manager Cesar Martin is leading the Fisher Cats for a third straight season. Pitching coach Drew Hayes and hitting coach Mitch Huckabay are in their first season in New Hampshire, while position coach Chris Schaeffer returns for his third season in Manchester. The Fisher Cats hit a team-record 166 home runs in 2022.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (April 11, 2018): Jordan Romano dazzled with seven scoreless innings in Trenton in a 4-0 win. He allowed three hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out seven. Vladimir Guerrero Jr., Lourdes Guerriel Jr., and Harold Ramirez knocked in runs for the Fisher Cats, who improved to 6-1.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: After a thrilling come-from-behind win on Sunday in extra innings to clinch a series victory at the Angels, the Toronto Blue Jays (6-4) come home to Rogers Centre for their home opening series against the Detroit Tigers...The Buffalo Bisons won both games of Sunday's doubleheader vs Worcester to take two of five from the Woo Sox. They hit the road to Rochester this week...All three games of Vancouver's home opening series was rained out. They host Tri-City this week ...Dunedin hosts their home opening series this week against Tampa after winning one of three at Fort Myers.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue the home schedule against the Future Red Sox (Portland Sea Dogs) at Delta Dental Stadium. The next game is Wednesday, April 11 at 6:35 pm and it is a Wear it Wednesday promotion. Other promotions this week include a hat giveaway courtesy of Delta Dental and Kids Run the Bases Sunday courtesy of the

New Hampshire Liquor Commission Division of Enforcement.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Finished up strong with six scoreless innings on 9/13 vs. Harrisburg, just his second quality start among 18 he made with the Fisher Cats.

**v. PORTLAND** – Made four starts against the Sea Dogs in 2022, going 0-2 with a 7.41 ERA. Allowed 25 hits in 17.0 IP, but did have 21 K's. Had a season-high ten strikeouts against Portland on 7/23 at Delta Dental.

 -Pitched season-high six innings in first quality start vs. Erie 8/10.

**2021:** Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.

**2019:** Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Jays in 2019. Klof made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, 23 BB, 64 K. WHIP 1.09. .204 average against.

**2018:** Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. (2.0 IP/2 starts)

**Obtained:** Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus.

**Personal:** Ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch.
