LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox could not hold their early three run first inning lead in a 6-4 loss to Altoona on Wednesday night. **Dylan Beavers** grounded in the first run of the game and **Samuel Basallo** and **Matthew Etzel** both scored on wild pitches to make it 3-0 Bowie. However, Altoona scored six unanswered runs from the second inning to the eighth thanks to a Sammy Siani solo homer and a Joe Perez bases clearing double. Altoona's bullpen combined for 8.1 innings of one-run ball to record the victory.

BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached base safely in 22 of his last 24 games dating back to May 21. His 19-game on-base streak from May 21 to June 12 is the longest Baysox on-base streak this season and is tied for the fifth-longest in the Eastern League. After another multi-hit performance last night, the 19-year-old leads the team with 19 multi-hit games on the season. He currently has the fourth-most hits (66) in the Eastern League and the ninth-most in all of Double-A.

RHODES IS ROLLING

In the month of June, OF/1B **John Rhodes** is batting a team-high .349 with a team-leading 13 RBI after going 3-for-4 with a homer last night. It's the fourth game of the year where Rhodes has collected three or more hits. The Orioles No. 23 prospect drove in a career-high six RBI on a career high five hits on Father's Day Sunday.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** has made quite a first impression since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen on June 11. Etzel has collected a hit in all seven games played for the Baysox thus far and has five stolen bases. His 36 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is third most in all of MiLB. He is the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of Southern Miss.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is now the Eastern League's active leader in home runs (12) after the promotions of Somerset's Agustin Ramirez and Ben Rice. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has four thus far in June - including three last week in Harrisburg. He's hitting .243 through 55 games after hitting just .176 in 64 AA games last season.

SHOVING THE SHOVE

Bowie's pitching staff has recorded the second-lowest ERA in the Eastern League in the month of June at 3.18 behind league-leading Hartford (3.02). The Baysox own the third-lowest WHIP (1.13) in all of Double-A this month and own the fourth-lowest ERA this month.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (308.1) and strikeouts (356). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.19 WHIP, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A.

ASSESSING ALTOONA

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve sit in last place in the Southwest Division at 24-39 on the season. However, the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates has won their last four in a row and eight of their last 10, including back-to-back series victories over Richmond and Erie. Altoona's roster includes six of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometa (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Sean Sullivan takes the hill for Altoona for the 14th time this year (12th start). The 23-year-old is coming off a six inning start against Erie last Friday where he scattered two runs on seven hits across one walk and four strikeouts to record the win. Sullivan has thrown the third-most innings in the Pirates system this year (60.2). The 8th round pick by the Pirates in 2021 is in his second season with the Curve. Sullivan pitched collegiately at Cal and was college teammates with Baysox OF **Dylan Beavers**.

In last home outing, threw shortest start of Double-A career where he recorded just one out and gave up **5 R** on **3 H** (including **2 HR**) and **3 BB** on **Sat. 6/8 vs BNG**. Holds a **3.18 ERA** as a starter in seven starts this season. Baysox are **5-2** when he starts. Threw first 6.0 inning start by a Baysox pitcher this season with 6.0 shutout, no-hit innings and 6 K on Sun. 6/2 @ SOM. Began season in rotation for three starts before being bumped into long relief role for five straight outings. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made four rehab appearances between FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen before being sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) with Baysox and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

2022: Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

2021: Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 K over 60.2 IP and an ERA of 3.86.

2019: Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

Personal: Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
