**YESTERDAY...** The Hot Rods earned their second-straight win at the expense of Rome with a 9-5 victory on Friday. Jacson McGowan extended his hitting streak to five games with a multi-hit game and a homer while Grant Witherspoon had three hits in the win. Six Hot Rods hitters had multi-hit efforts while eight players had at least one knock in the game. The Hot Rods held off multiple rallied by the Braves to take a 9-5 win.

**BACK-TO-BACK BOMBERS...** The Hot Rods have launched back-to-back homers six times this season. Jordan Qsar and Hill Alexander hit consecutive round-trippers in the second game on Thursday. This marks the fourth time in 2021 Qsar has been a part of back-to-back home runs. Qsar has been the first hitter twice and the second hitter twice, adding on to the massive power in the Hot Rods lineup.

**DOUBLE-DIGIT DINGERS...** With his 10th long ball on Thursday, Greg Jones is the fifth Hot Rod to reach double-digits this season. He joins Ruben Cardenas, Niko Hulsizer, Jordan Qsar, and the most recent member of the club, Grant Witherspoon with 10 or more homers. These four-baggers have helped the Hot Rods reach the top five in the MiLB for home runs. Bowling Green sits in fourth place in all of the minors with 96 homers and are the only team in the top five that aren't in AAA. Jacson McGowan is knocking on the door with nine homers, including the one he hit last night to center.

**FORMER HOT RODS IN THE OLYMPICS...** Joe Ryan and Shane Baz have been named to the U.S Olympic Team for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. Ryan, pitched in six games with Bowling Green in 2019, posting a 2-2 record with a 2.93 ERA. Baz played the entirety of his 2019 season with the Hot Rods, finishing with a 3-2 record with a 2.99 ERA over 81.1 innings pitched. Both pitchers are currently playing at the AAA level with the Durham Bulls and open the Olympic Games on Friday, July 30, against Isreal.

**YESTERDAY'S NOTES...** McGowan has a five-game hit streak... Four of those efforts a multi-hit games... Friday was also his eighth multi-hit effort of the season... He's had seven multi-RBI games in 2021... Jones made his second appearance of the season batting in the lead-off spot... He had his eighth multi-hit game of the year too... Jones has five multi-RBI games in 2021... Alexander had his fifth multi-hit game of the season... He also has four multi-RBI games... Qsar had his 10th multi-hit games of the year... Witherspoon has seven multi-hit efforts...

**NOW PITCHING IN GAME ONE: MICHAEL MERCADO...** Mercado is still looking for his first win of the season in his 11th start. The righty is 4-0 with a 6.03 ERA in his first action since 2018 thanks to recovery from surgery and the pandemic sidling him. The righty has a 9.64 K/9 and is throwing strikes 65% of the time, but is throwing over 17 pitches per inning during the 2021 season.

**NOW PITCHING IN GAME TWO: COLBY WHITE...** White makes his second appearance in the series and first start of his professional career on Saturday. White is 0-2 with the Hot Rods after his promotion from Low-A Charleston last month. The righty hadn't allowed an earned run in 11 appearances for the River Dogs, but has let up five during his time in BG. Between the two levels, White has thrown 70% strikes with a 17.64 K/9.



### TODAY IN HOT RODS HISTORY

July 10, 2017

On this day in Hot Rods history, we look back at a historic day as the Hot Rods won 10-straight games for the first time in franchise history. This one had little drama as the Hot Rods scored four runs in the second and three in the third to ut the game away early. Miles Mastrobuoni and Eleardo Cabrera each drove in two runs while Josh Lowe and Michael Brosseau each had two hits. On the mound, Willy Ortiz allowed one run on just three hits in 7.0 innings, earning his fourth win of the season, while improving the Hot Rods to 43-43.

2019: Did not pitch in 2019 due to injury... Was placed on the injured list June 14, 2019.

**2018:** Mercado made 11 appearances for the Hudson Valley Renegades in 2018... All of his appearances were starts, finishing with a 1-2 record and a 5.22 ERA... Mercado worked through 50 innings, fanning 38 and walking 16... Opponents batted .274 against him, driving in 29 earned runs.

**2017:** Mercado's first showing in the MiLB was successful, posting a 1.69 ERA over 21.1 innings... He had eight showings, making eight starts, and finished with no decisions... Opponents hit a .256 clip against, bringing across four earned runs... He struck out 14 batters and walked four, maintaining a 1.17 WHIP.

**High School**: During his senior year at Westview High School Mercado dominated opponents... He finihsed his final year of high school with nine wins, holding a 0.69 ERA... He tossed 70.2 and struck out 97 batters over that span... He held opponents to a stunning .120 batting average... Boasted a 1.000 fielding percentage... Finished high school at 6'5" and 165 pounds... Was ranked the 1,507 player in the nation and the 164th player in the state of California by MaxPreps.

**Personal:** Full name is David Michael Mercado... Is one of seven drafted players out of Westview High School and the first since 2015... One of 592 players drafted with the hometown of San Diego... During high school his fastball sat at low 90's, getting up to 94 his senior year... Shares a baseball birthday with Danny Jansen, Chris Tillman, and Adeiny Hechavarria.

2019: LaSorsa's 2019 minor league season was spent with Hudson Valley after being signed by the Rays in June... He appeared in 17 games, logging a 5-3 record... All of his appearances came from the bullpen... LaSorsa posted a 2.23 ERA, giving up nine ER to his opponents on 29 hits and nine walks... Made his debut with the Renegades on June 18th, pitching one perfect inning on 10 pitches. 2019 (NCAA): As a junior, LaSorsa was taken 548th overall in the 2019 MLB Draft by the Tampa Bay Rays... During his junior season, he made 15 appearances with 14 being starts... He posted a record of 6-5 with a 1.66 ERA... In his one outing that wasn't a start, he recorded a save... He led St. Johns in inning pitched with 86.2, holding opponents to a .199 batting average... During those innings he struck out 67 and walked 33... Held opponents to a team best .199 batting average... Made his first career start on February 17th, striking out seven and surrendering just three hits against No. 3 UCLA... Logged a career best eight strikeouts in just seven innings against Saint Louis on March 29th... Pitched 7.1 innings while giving up 5 hits to open the BIG EAST tournament against Xavier on May 23rd. 2018 (NCAA): LaSorsa marked the team high for appearances with 26, all in relief...
