RIDERS DROP HEARTBREAKER TO TRAVS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were edged out by the Arkansas Travelers 6-5 on Saturday at Dickey-Stephens Park. In the top of the third inning, **Cam Cauley** lined an RBI single to put Frisco (15-23, 53-53) in front 1-0. **Aaron Zavala** then drove in two on a double in the top of the fifth to increase the lead to 3-0. In the following frame, **Luis Mieses** powered a home run to build Frisco's advantage to 4-0. Arkansas (20-18, 55-52) responded in the bottom of the eighth when Colt Emerson hit a three-run homer to make the score 4-3. Bill Knight followed with an RBI single to tie up the game 4-4. In the top of the 11th, Frainyer Chavez scored on a bases-loaded walk by **Keyber Rodriguez** to restore the Riders' lead 5-4. In the home-half of the 11th, Blake Rambusch guided a walk-off, two-RBI single to secure a walk-off win for Arkansas, 6-5. Travelers reliever Jimmy Kingsbury (4-2) earned the win. Riders reliever **Joey Danielson** (1-1) was tagged with the loss, yielding two runs in the eleventh inning.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In eight games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 2.45 ERA, but they are 4-for-7 in save opportunities.

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). Frisco's starting ERA of 3.96 in the second half is second in the Texas League, while it is 3.66 since the start of July, which is also second in the league. In the last 11 games, Frisco has a 2.30 ERA for starters which is second in the league and Frisco leads the league with a 1.89 ERA in eight August games.

For the first time since midseason 2023, the RoughRiders were blanked in back-to-back games on offense on Sunday and Tuesday. Frisco ended their scoreless streak with Aaron Zavala's two-run double in the 10th on Wednesday, stopping the streak at 29 consecutive innings without a run. In the first eight games in August, Frisco has scored just 19 total runs while hitting .186/.252/.262/.514 as the plate as a team with two home runs. Zavala has scored or driven in nine of the 19 runs in the month for Frisco.

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.982) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (69). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .983 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They committed two errors on Saturday, just their ninth game since May 1st committing multiple errors.

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO: In their last 25 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 18 of the 25 games, but they are 11-14. The Riders have blown nine saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they allowed 54 earned runs, they also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been solid for the RoughRiders on offense in 2025. In his last 73 games since May 7th, he is batting .265/.330/.449/.779 with 20 doubles, four triples, eight home runs, 30 RBIs and 17 stolen bases. In his last 37 games, he is slashing .273/.331/.474/.805 with 10 doubles, three triples, five home runs, 20 RBIs, 25 runs scored and 10 steals. He is tied for sixth in the league in hits (94), tied for third in doubles (21), tied for second in triples (six), third in extra-base hits (36), tied for fourth in total bases (154), fourth in runs scored (60) and sixth in steals (27).

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.4 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively. base defensively.
