Today's Game

The Reading Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is the fourth-of-six matchups this season between the teams, with all six meetings coming at FirstEnergy Stadium. Erie traveled to Reading from Sept. 3-8, last season, and after Reading won the first two games, the SeaWolves won the last four contests. The Fightin Phils haven't traveled to Erie since July 26-21, of the 2022 season.

Game 45/46 Recap

The Fightin Phils fell in both ends of Thursday's doubleheader, losing 7-2 in game one and 5-4 in the second game. Chuck King started the first game and matched a season and career-high with six innings pitched, but also allowed a career-high 11 hits and five runs. Reading's offense came on a home run from Cade Fergus and an RBI double from Keaton Anthony. In the second game, Braeden Fausnaught battled to only allow two runs on six hits over four innings of work. Eiberson Castellano, making his first appearance since Apr. 29, struggled as he allowed three runs on two hits over an inning of work. Reading was down 5-2 in the seventh, but a two-run single from Keaton Anthony cut the deficit to one, but Erie held on for the one-run win. In the second game, Aidan Miller, Keaton Anthony and Alex Binelas all had two hits. Anthony drove in two runs in game two as well.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller has seen his average climb steadily throughout the month of May. After hitting just .203 in April, Miller has posted a .266/.356/.380 (.736 OPS) slash line over 22 May games, along with 10 runs, three doubles, two home runs and six RBI. Miller has proved to be a threat on the bases this season as well, as he ranks tied for third in the Eastern League with 16 stolen bases. He is well on track to blow pass Reading's season-high in stolen bases from 2024, which was 20 from Gabriel Rincones Jr.

Anthony Keeps Rolling

Keaton Anthony enters today with a team-best seven-game hit and 15-game on-base streak. His 15-game on-base streak is second-longest active in the Eastern League, trailing only Erie's Max Anderson. Anthony also trails Anderson for the best average in the Eastern League as well, with Anderson hitting .341 and Anthony posting a .326 average. His other Eastern League ranks are: 6th OBP (.386), 6th SLG (.511), 5th OPS (.897), T-5th hits (46), 1st 2B (18) and T-3rd in XBH (21). Anthony has been red-hot in the month of May, slashing .386/.449/.614 (1.063 OPS) over 20 games, along with 11 runs, 11 doubles, one triple, one home run and 11 RBI.

Pineda's May

After a slow start to the season that saw Leandro Pineda hit just .104 in April, he has been red-hot in May. Over 24 games this month, Pineda is slashing .296/.351/.451 (.802 OPS), with 10 runs, eight doubles, one home run and six RBI.

Rolling Reyes

Felix Reyes matched a season-high with three hits, and a double in the first game of Thursday's doubleheader. Reyes joined Reading on April 17 and over 23 games is slashing .329/.333/.579 (.912 OPS), with 11 runs, seven doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI. Reyes does not qualify for the league rankins in average, but his .329 mark would be second in the league if he did qualify.

Pitching Powers

Tuesday was Reading's first shutout win of the season, with the Fightin Phils last shutout coming on Sept. 14, 2024, at Harrisburg, on the penultimate day of the regular season. The R-Phils tied a season-low in hits allowed, with two, and the last instance was Apr. 9 at Somerset. The excellent pitching on Tuesday led to the shortest game of the 2025 season, being played in just two hours and four minutes.

Putting the Fight in Fightins

Reading's come from behind win on Sunday marked the third time this season that the Fightin Phils won a game when trailing entering the ninth inning. The other two instances were April 8 and 13 at Somerset. This all comes after Reading won just once in 2024 when trailing entering the ninth inning.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 30, 1998: At Akron, Reggie Taylor goes 4-for-6 with two runs and three RBI in Reading's 7-5, 10-inning win.

From One Corner of the State to the Other

Erie enters tonight tied with Akron for first place in the Southwest Division, and for the best record in the Eastern League. The SeaWolves took five-of-six from Hartford at home last week, winning the first five and losing on Sunday. After this week, Erie returns home and welcomes Richmond. Erie's roster fetures 10 of the Tigers' top-30 prospects: Thayron Liranzo (5), Jaden Hamm (7), Jake Miller (15), Joseph Montalvo (17), Roberto Campos (20), Max Anderson (21), Justice Bigbie (25), RJ Petit (28) and Yosber Sanche (30).

SeaWolves Pitcher

Righty Jaden Hamm makes the start tonight for Erie. Over nine starts this season, Hamm is 1-2, with a 4.42 ERA (19 ER, 38.2 IP). He has additionally allowed 35 hits, walked 13 and struck out 42 (9.78 SO/9.0 IP). Hamm last pitched on Saturday at Hartford, allowing two runs on three hits over five innings, with five strikeouts, in a no-decision. Hamm spent all of 2024 with West Michigan (A+), going 5-4, with a 2.64 ERA (29 ER, 99.0 IP) over 24 games/23 starts. The 22-year old was a fifth round pick of the Tigers in 2023 out of Middle Tennessee State., where he played from 2021-23.

Russo bounced back nicely in his second Double-A start, despite taking the loss. He allowed a run in the first and fifth, but settled in nicely to post zeroes in the second, third and fourth frames. He limited Portland to just three hits, but did run into some trouble with three walks issued. He was the victim of lack of run support, as he exited the game, with Reading down 2-0. Russo was relieved by Jack Dallas in the bottom of the sixth.
