FROM THE CROW'S NEST

ENDY'S GAME: Endy Rodriguez had a team-best eight-game hitting streak end in Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader, but the Dominican Republic native has still hit safely in nine of his last 10 games, batting .333 during that stretch. Rodriguez also leads the team with 15 multi-hit games, including a three-hit performance on Wednesday, which matched his season-high.

PRETTY STINGY: Since June 27 (an 11-game span), the Marauders pitching staff has allowed just 19 earned runs over 90.2 innings for a 1.89 ERA. Bradenton now owns the lowest team ERA (3.79) and the second-lowest WHIP (1.34) in the Low-A Southeast.

WALK THIS WAY: With 26 walks drawn in the series, the Marauders are now second in the Low-A Southeast with 333 walks, helping boost Bradenton's team OBP to .364 (third in the league). This comes despite facing a Clearwater pitching staff that has issued the second-fewest walks (258) in the league.

EXCELLENCE FOR ESCOTTO: Maikol Escotto has reached base safely in 18 straight games, his second-longest on-base streak of the season (19 games, May 5-June 1). He is batting .288 with a .400 on-base percentage during the streak, and ranks second on the team with 40 hits despite missing two weeks while on the injured list in the first half of June.

AMONG THE BEST: The Marauders rank second in the Low-A Southeast in runs (336), home runs (52), and slugging percentage (.383). Bradenton's pitching staff also owns Minor League Baseball's fifth-highest strikeout total (651), behind only San Jose, Modesto, Fort Myers, and Somerset.

THE OPPONENT: The Marauders and Threshers are facing off for their first head-to-head series this season, and are in town for their first of two visits to LECOM Park in 2021 (Clearwater will visit Bradenton again August 17-22). The Threshers won each of their last two series (4-games-to-2 at home against both Daytona and St. Lucie) and own the Low-A Southeast's closest run differential (-4).

TOP PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently includes eight prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#5), **Eddy Yean** (#12), **Jared Jones** (#16), **Sammy Siani** (#18), **Nick Garcia** (#20), **Endy Rodriguez** (#25), **Alexander Mojica** (#28), and **Daniel Lopez** (#29). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +70 (Tampa is third in all of MiLB at +139)... The team is also 18 games over .500 for the second time this season, matching their season-high... Five Marauders players rank within the league's top five in home runs: **Jase Bowen** and **Hudson Head** are tied for second in the league with 8; **Endy Rodriguez** and **Sammy Siani** are tied for third with 6 HR each, and **Alexander Mojica**'s 5 HR is tied for fifth... **Eli Wilson** is in the league's top 10 in batting average (.338, 7th), OBP (.486, 4th), and OPS (.986, 7th).
