TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open their final series of the season with the Richmond Flying Squirrels.

LAST TIME OUT: Nick Cimillo and Jase Bowen each homered in a 9-5 win at Hartford to earn a series split with the Yard Goats.

ENDY'S RETURN: Altoona will welcome Pirates C Endy Rodriguez on major league rehab during their week-long series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels to wrap up the season. Rodriguez is recovering from Tommy John surgery and played 31 games with the Curve in 2022 batting .356/.442/.678/1.120 with 14 2B, 8 HR and 32 RBI. He made his major league debut on July 17, 2023 against the Cleveland Guardians and hit .220/.284/.328 with 7 2B, 3 3B, 3 HR, and 13 RBI in 57 major league games.

YOYNER ON TOP: When batting in the leadoff spot this season, outfielder Yoyner Fajardo has been at his best, batting .278 with a .395 on-base percentage in 49 games. Since June 1, he ranks second in the Éastern League in batting average (.294) and on-base percentage (.401).

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS: For the first time since the adoption of the 6-game series in 2021, Altoona won all six games in a sixgame series from August 25-Sept. 1 against New Hampshire. Altoona is one of three Double-A clubs (Birmingham, Springfield) to sweep a 6-game series and be swept in a 6-game series this season (vs Akron April 25-30).

LEFT-HANDED PUNCHES: Lefties Jaden Woods and Cy Nielson have racked up strikeouts since arriving from High-A Greensboro during the summer. Woods has struck out 39 batters in 29.2 innings since his Curve debut on June 22, during that time are the fifth-most among Eastern League relievers. Nielson has struck out 25 batters in his first 18.0 innings since being promoted from Greensboro on July 30

UNCHAPPED: Emmanuel Chapman has fulfilled a critically important role on Altoona's pitching staff throughout the season. Since June 19 he's recorded a 2-2 record and a 2.89 ERA (53.0 IP / 17 ER), 51 strikeouts and a .193 BAA in his last 19 appearances (6 starts). In that time he's matched his career-long outing of 4.0 innings four times.

A YOUNG MAN'S ARRIVAL: Infielder Termarr Johnson joined the Curve on Tuesday, August 27 ahead of their series with the Fisher Cats. At 20 years, 2 months and 16 days, <u>Johnson is the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose Tabata and An</u> drew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve. At High-A Greensboro this season, Johnson helped the Grasshoppers earn a First Half title and batted .238/.372/.385/.757 with 17 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR, 46 RBI and 20-24 SB. He earned 78 walks in 110 games played. He ranked first in the SAL in walks (78) and runs scored (73), fifth in OBP (.372) and eighth in hits (94). Johnson's first Double-A hit was a two-run homer off New Hampshire's Nick Fraze on Wednesday, August 28. Johnson's 83 walks this season are sixth-most in the minors this season.

SIR SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has heated up at the plate since July 30 (28 games), he's batting: .311/.397/.434/.831 with 6 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 11 RBI, 4-5 SB.

ROAD Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng has one of the most dramatic home/road splits of any Eastern League player. In 63 road games, Cheng is batting .244 with a .747 OPS, totaling 10 2B, 10 HR, 31 RBI and 25 BB. In 56 home games, Cheng is batting .170 with a .531 OPS totaling 7 2B, 1 HR, 19 RBI and 33 BB. Overall, Cheng has done a majority of his damage at the plate on the first pitch of his plate appearance where he's batting .347 with a 1.067 OPS in 49 at-bats that he's put the ball in play in an 0-0 count.

THE SQUIRRELS IN FLIGHT: Dennis Pelfrey returns for his third season as Manager for Richmond. Pelfrey led Richmond to the postseason in 2023, their first appearance since 2014 and enters this season ranked second on the club's all-time Managerial wins list. The Flying Squirrels just received 2023 1st round draft selection Bryce Eldridge to their roster.

THE FIRST IN FLIGHT: Jack Choate takes the ball for the Squirrels tonight. Choate was San Francisco's 9th round pick in 2022 out of Division II Assumption College. Born in Miami, Choate was the Northwest League's best arms this season, recording a 2.90 ERA at High-A where he walked just 19 baters in 77.2 IP, but since arriving at Double-A he's been letting everyone on-base for free, issuing 17 walks in his 24.0 innings. Choate racked up video game numbers in his final season of college baseball, playing in the highlycompetitive wood-bat league The Northeast 10, he struck out 127 batters in 70.1 innings. That included a 19-K game and an 18-K game, he struck out at least 10 batters in 7 of his 13 appearances as a Junior.
