**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost their sixth straight game with a 8-0 shutout against the SeaWolves. Erie struck for three runs in the third inning, snapping **John Michael Bertrand's** 17-inning scoreless streak. The SeaWolves added two runs with a double by Hao-Yu Lee in the fifth, part of his four-RBI performance. In the eighth, Trei Cruz hit a solo homer and the SeaWolves added a pair of RBI singles to open an 8-0 lead. For Richmond, **Hunter Bishop** and **Jimmy Glowenke** each had two hits. **Evan Gates** and **Eric Silva** combined for 2.1 scoreless innings out of the bullpen. Richmond went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the fifth of a six-game series at UPMC Park. Richmond and Erie have met in the Southwest Division Series each of the last two seasons. Erie has won each of those series, including en route to winning the franchise's first Eastern League championship last season. This series is the first this year between the Flying Squirrels and SeaWolves. Erie comes to Richmond for six games from May 28-June 2. The Flying Squirrels return to Erie for six games from August 27-September 1.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have dropped 10-of-11 dating back to April 28, including nine-of-10 in the current road trip to Akron and Erie. The lone win in that stretch came last Friday in a shutout at Akron. In the previous series at home, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. The current losing streak is the longest for the Flying Squirrels since they lost seven consecutive games from May 25-June 1, 2023.

**THE SEAWOLVES** are the defending Eastern League champions. This year, they are in second place in the Southwest Division standings. They went 2-3 in last week's series against the Baysox in Bowie, with the series finale being canceled due to rain. After starting the season 9-4, the SeaWolves have gone 8-7 in their last 15 games since April 21. Erie's roster includes two of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Troy Melton (No. 10) and 2B Hao-Yu Lee (No. 12). Three Erie players are on MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Melton (No. 11), Lee (No. 14), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Carson Ragsdale** makes his seventh Double-A start and his first against the SeaWolves. In his last start last Saturday at Akron, Ragsdale allowed a season-high four runs over 3.1 innings with four walks and five strikeouts, his shortest outing of the year so far. For the season, Ragsdale is fifth in the Eastern League in K/9 (11.22), sixth in strikeout percentage (30.8%) and 10th in opponents' batting average (.209). Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (42) and ranked third in innings pitched (27.2). In 2022, he made five appearances in the Arizona Complex League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. **For more on Ragsdale, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander **Austin Bergner** makes his second Double-A start of the season. He last pitched last Friday at Bowie and was charged with a loss after allowing four runs over five innings in his first Double-A outing this year. Bergner began the season with Triple-A Toledo and posted an 11.57 ERA (18 ER/14.0 IP) in his five starts. He is in his third season with the SeaWolves. In his career, he has made six appearances (two starts) against the Flying Squirrels, going 1-1 with a 3.50 ERA (7 ER/18.0 IP/21 SO/8 BB). For his SeaWolves career, Bergner is 10-5 with a 3.25 ERA in 22 games (16 starts). Bergner was selected by the Tigers in the ninth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of the University of North Carolina, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels catcher **Brandon Martorano**.

**AWESOME APRIL:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,923) and Worcester (7,453).

**RISPY BUSINESS:** In their last 14 games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .100 (8-for-80) with runners in scoring position, averaging 1.86 runs per game (26 total runs). On the current road trip to Akron and Erie, Richmond is batting .067 (4-for-60) with runners in scoring position and averaging 1.5 runs per game (15 total runs). In last week's series, the Flying Squirrels were shut out in the Tuesday opener and then scored their only runs on solo homers last Wednesday. Their only runs last Saturday came on a second-inning grand slam by **Grant McCray**. They did not have an at-bat with a runner in scoring position on Sunday in the finale at Akron. So far in the series in Erie, the Flying Squirrels went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position on Tuesday night, 0-for-3 on Wednesday, scoring their only run in that game on an error, 0-for-6 on Thursday and 0-for-6 in Friday's shutout loss. In the last five games since Sunday, Richmond is 0-for-24 with runners in scoring position.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** There are three relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 14 IP), three Richmond pitchers rank in the top six in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (6th - 1.10 ERA - 2 ER/16.1 IP), **Tanner Kiest** (7th - 1.26 ERA - 2 ER/14.1 IP) and **Wil Jensen** (5th - 1.27 ERA - 3 ER/21.1 IP). Jensen also leads the league in relief innings pitched (21.1).

**HIT HUNTER:** Over his last eight games since April 27, **Hunter Bishop** is batting .355 (11-for-31) with a homer, four doubles, one RBI, four runs scored and two stolen bases. That stretch has raised his season batting average from .210 to .258. Since May 1, Bishop has picked up multiple hits in four-of-five games, batting .400 (8-for-20). Bishop's .258 batting average leads qualified Richmond batters.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Hayden Birdsong** is 10th in ERA (2.49), tied for fourth in strikeouts (35), second in BAA (.148) and seventh in WHIP (1.07). **Ryan Murphy** is first in games started. **John Michael Bertrand** is first in innings pitched (36.1). **Carson Ragsdale** is 10th in BAA (.209).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Reggie Crawford** (No. 9), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Seven players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

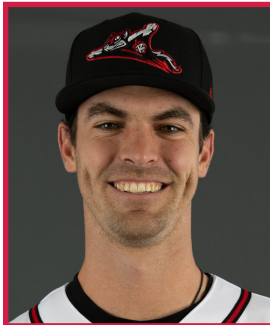
### IN OTHER WORDS...
