### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Comets (Los Angeles Dodgers) are set for game four of their six-game series at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark on Friday night. Round Rock took a one-game lead after their 6-5 win on Thursday. The Comets took a 2-0 lead in the first on 1B Ryan Ward's two-run single. Round Rock tied it at two behind RBI singles from 1B Jonah Bride in the third and CF Tyler Wade in the fifth. 3B Ryan Fitzgerald belted an RBI in the bottom of the fifth for a 3-2 lead. Express C Willie Maclver hit a solo homer and 2B Justin Foscue hit a two-run double in the top of the sixth. Wade drove in another run in the seventh for a 6-3 advantage. The Comets plated two runs in the bottom of the frame but the Express couldn't be caught. RHP Gavin Collyer pitched a scoreless ninth, earning the save in Round Rock's 6-5 win.

### BROADCAST INFORMATION

### HOW ABOUT THIS BULLPEN?

Express relievers own a 3.13 ERA (22 ER/63.1 IP) which is third in the PCL and sixth in Triple-A. Their 4.26 BB/9 is the fourth-lowest figure in Triple-A while they are tied for the fourth-most innings. As an entire staff, Round Rock pitchers own the fourth-highest whiff rate in the PCL at 26.4%.

### MARRIED TO TWO STRIKES

INF Jonah Bride has 10 hits this season and nine have come with two strikes. He owns a three-game hitting streak and a five-game on-base streak. With two strikes, Bride is slashing .300/.364/.500 with two homers, six RBI, two walks and 13 strikeouts. For his professional career, he is a .221 hitter with two strikes. The Triple-A league average with two strikes is a .162 batting average.

### THE BATS ARE HOT

After recording a season-high 12 hits on Wednesday, the Express topped it with 13 on Thursday. Their 25 hits in back-to-back contests are the most since recording 29 at St. Paul on Aug. 23-24, 2025. With 32 hits this week, over one-third of the team's 93 base knocks this season have come against the Comets. Round Rock's average has increased to .234 after entering the week batting .210. They are hitting .303 with RISP this week. They entered this series with a .237 average with RISP through the first nine games.

### TOSSING CHAIRS

Round Rock's pitching staff matched their season-high of 14 strikeouts in Thursday's win over Oklahoma City. There have been five PCL contests this season with at least 14 strikeouts, two of which have come from the E-Train (4/9 at OKC, 3/31 vs GWN).

### THE HAUVER HOUR

OF Trevor Hauver has back-to-back multi-hit games and is 6-for-13 with an RBI, run scored, a walk and two strikeouts in three games this series. His 4.722 pitches per plate appearance is sixth in the PCL. With RISP, Hauver is batting .417 (5-12)/.588/.667 with a homer, seven RBI, five walks and two strikeouts.

### ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - SATURDAY, APRIL 10, 1976

At Anaheim Stadium, 29-year-old Nolan Ryan faced 26-year-old Vida Blue for the first time ever as starting pitchers. Their first meeting came in 1972, though Blue appeared out of the bullpen in that game. Blue got the better of Ryan on this day despite the Athletics collecting just one hit against him. Oakland defeated California 6-2 as Ryan worked 7.0 innings, allowing one hit and two earned runs while issuing six walks and striking out seven. Blue tossed 5.0 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the 1976 season.

Rollie Fingers recorded his second save as the A's improved to 2-0 while the Angels dropped to 0-2. Neither starter went deep into the game as both were still building up following a shortened Spring Training due to labor issues.

2B Phil Garner delivered the decisive blow in the fifth inning with a two-run double which was the only hit allowed by Ryan. Oakland later added three runs in the eighth against rookie Paul Hartzell to pull away. "Against Ryan," Garner said postgame, "you just hope you hit the ball. He just didn't get that curveball down far enough."

Ryan, coming off offseason surgery to remove bone chips from his elbow after the 1975 season, said, "My fast-ball was adequate when my rhythm was good, but I had trouble with my curve today. I was hanging it." Angels manager Dick Williams added, "120-some-odd pitches -- and he probably threw more than he should have."
