LAST TIME OUT

Allentown, PA (April 7, 2023) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders battled back once again for a 6-5 victory over the Lehigh Valley IronPigs. Jesus Bastidas drove in four runs, including two with his second homer of the season. Aaron McGarity took the win with 1.2 clean innings out of the bullpen and Greg Weissert recorded his third save of the season.

The Iron Pigs got on the board in the first inning. Three extra base hits including a triple from Dalton Guthrie to put them up 2-0 quickly.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre countered quickly in the second. Jamie Westbrook led off with a base hit. Bastidas followed with a two-run blast to deep left. Billy McKinney was hit by a pitch and Rodolfo Duran took a walk to reach. After a fly ball pushed McKinney to third, Wilmer Difo's sacrifice fly brought him in to take the lead 3-2. In the third, the RailRiders tacked one on with another sacrifice fly thanks to Bastidas for a 4-2 advantage.

Lehigh Valley came right back in the fifth when they loaded the bases with walks. And later a fourth walk pushed in a run to trail by just one. The IronPigs took control in the seventh. Jim Haley singled to start the frame and then stole second. After Dustin Peterson reached on a fielder's choice, John Hicks brought them both in with a two-run double. Lehigh Valley led 5-4.

The RailRiders were not done yet, bouncing back immediately in the eighth. Andres Chaparro took a walk and Elijah Dunham singled to reach. Back-to-back RBI base hits from Bastidas and McKinney sent them both home. SWB got back on top 6-5. In the bottom of the ninth, the IronPigs got the tying run to second base. A fantastic barehanded play from Bastidas at third helped seal the win for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

Tanner Tully made his season debut for the RailRiders letting up just two runs on six hits. Tully handed the ball to D.J. Snelten with a runner on in the fourth. Snelten induced a double play to get out of the inning clean. He worked through the fifth walking four, but teammate Michael Gomez was able to get the final out stranding the bases loaded. Gomez let up two runs in the seventh, but once again the bullpen had his back. Aaron McGarity (W, 2-0) finished out the seventh and took down the eighth 1-2-3. Greg Weissert (S,3) was there for the save in the ninth, slamming the door shut.

NEWS & NOTES

BASTIDAS IS BALLING - Jesus Bastidas has been instrumental so far in his first season in Triple-A. Last night, Bastidas had the game tying RBI in the eighth inning for the RailRiders. It was his third hit of the day after a two run home run, his second of the season. He also had a sacrifice fly to total four runs batted in on the evening. It jumps his season batting average up to .278. Bastidas also looked good at third base, helping to make an excellent play on the run.

OUTFIELD ASSIST - Michael Hermosillo recorded SWB's first outfield assist of the season. With one away and a runner on first, Hermosillo chased and caught a fly ball in center field. Esteban Quiroz was doubled up on first after misreading the play and heading to second without tagging up.

LEADING THE CHARGE - Only one RailRider has played in all seven contests. Elijah Dunham leads the way with a start in every game, splitting time between the outfield and at designated hitter. Manager Shelly Duncan has given a few players one day off this season.

THE WEISSERT WAY - Greg Weissert made his fourth appearance of the season last night to record his third save in as many attempts. He allowed just one base runner in the ninth on a hit by pitch. It took him only eight offerings to complete the three out save. Weissert had a phenomenal season in 2022 as the RailRiders closer. Greg Weissert also pitched his way into the record books. He became the third Scranton/Wilkes-Barre player and first RailRider to win the International League's top pitching honor. He was named as both the league's Pitcher of the Year as well as the top relief pitcher. Weissert appeared in 42 games for the RailRiders in 2022, going 2-1 with 18 saves and a 1.69 ERA while striking out 70 over 48 innings pitched. The Yankees signed the right-hander to a Major League deal on August 25 and he made his big league debut that night. With New York he pitched 11.1 innings and recorded three wins before returning to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

AARON'S AMAZING - Aaron McGarity has had two wins this season in his two appearances. His pair of wins leads Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. After joining the team on April 4, the righty has seen three and a third innings of work. He has not allowed a hit, just walking one batter and striking out three. McGarity has inherited three runners coming into the game and has not allowed any of them to score.

INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE - The team's pitching is fourth in the league with a low 3.00 earned run average. The staff is led by the bullpen which has tossed 57% of the innings. SWB has given up just 18 earned runs, while LHV has given up 19 but in one less contest. The Iron Pigs are just below them with a 3.72 ERA. Out of 30 teams in the league, the RailRiders are sixth from the bottom with a .232 team average. However, that is ticks above where they were prior to last night. The Iron Pigs have a team average of .237 at the plate.

BEHIND THE PLATE - Rodolfo Duran, Mickey Gasper, and Jose Godoy open the season as new manager Shelley Duncan's options behind the plate. Godoy has big league time with both Minnesota and Pittsburgh. Duran and Gasper are set to make their Scranton/Wilkes-Barre debuts. Gasper is one of just five players on the roster drafted by the New York Yankees. So far they have split time as catcher with all three getting featured in one game on Opening Weekend.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18), Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle, (#29) will both be essential parts of the pitching staff. Peraza made his big league debut at the end of last season and even aided the Yankees in their postseason race.

SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN: The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

DAY GAME EXPERIENCE: Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks and 15 strikeouts.

CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY: At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138H, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third) and strikeouts (sixth)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
- Attended the University of South Carolina-Aiken, where he started out as solely a reliever with all 16 of appearances coming out of the bullpen as a freshman in 2017. After posting a 7.56 ERA that year, Spence became a starter for the final two seasons (2018-19) of his college career, starting 28/31 appearances. He set career-best college marks as a sophomore with a 3.03 ERA and 117 strikeouts.

- Attended Green Hope High School in Cary, where he became the school's all-time leader in ERA and saves.
