YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 2-1, to open the series. Altoona took a 2-0 lead in the first inning with RBI singles by Nick Cimillo and Mike Jarvis. It was the only two runs allowed by Richmond starter **Manuel Mercedes**, who threw six innings and struck out three with no walks. The Flying Squirrels were held scoreless until the eighth inning, including six scoreless innings and eight strikeouts by Altoona starter Wilbur Dotel. In the top of the eighth, **Carter Howell** grounded into a forceout, scoring **Aeverson Arteaga** from third. The game was delayed prior to the bottom of the eighth inning for one hour and 34 minutes due to rain.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second and third of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The series marks the first meetings between these two teams this year. The Curve come to Richmond for a six-game series from August 12-17. The Flying Squirrels return to Altoona from September 2-7. The Flying Squirrels are 3-5 in doubleheader games this season. In their first three doubleheaders of the year, they won the first game and lost the second. They were swept in their last doubleheader at Binghamton on May 25.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,747 fans per home game, which ranks fourth among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 6-19-1 in their last 26 games. They had lost three straight games prior to Sunday's tie. Richmond went 1-4-1 in last week's series against Binghamton. Of Richmond's 44 losses this season, 24 of them have been by two runs or less (16 by one, eight by two). The Richmond offense is 11th in the Eastern League in runs scored (206). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.82 ERA.

THE CURVE have won four-of-five since Thursday. They split last week's six-game series against the SeaWolves. Altoona's roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including 2B Termarr Johnson (No. 5), OF/INF Mitch Jebb (No. 12), SS Jack Brannigan (No. 14 - on IL), RHP Wilber Dotel (No. 16) and RHP Alessandro Ercolani (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list features three Altoona players, including Johnson (No. 4), Brannigan (No. 11 - on IL) and Jebb (No. 13).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jack Choate** makes his 13th start of the season in Game 1 and the fourth of his career against the Curve. He last pitched last Thursday at The Diamond and allowed five runs (four earned) over 4.1 innings with six strikeouts. Choate made three starts against the Curve last season, going 1-2 with a 4.73 ERA (7 ER/13.1 IP). For the year, Choate ranks third in the Eastern League in K/9 (10.97), sixth in strikeouts percentage (28.2%), sixth in strikeouts (65) and 10th in BAA (.236). Last year, Choate spent most of the season with High-A Eugene, going 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in August and made eight starts for the Flying Squirrels, posting a 1-4 record with a 5.82 ERA to close the season. Choate finished 2024 ranked first among qualified, full-season Giants minor-league pitchers in BAA (.231) and WHIP (1.21) while ranking second in ERA (3.79). Choate was selected by the Giants in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Assumption University. He entered 2025 ranked by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. **For more on Choate, see page two.**

Right-hander **Nick Sinacola** makes his fourth start of 2025. All three of his previous starts have also been against the Senators. He last pitched on Saturday against the Rumble Ponies and threw three scoreless innings. In his last four appearances dating back to June 3, Sinacola has posted a 0.96 ERA (1 ER/9.1 IP). In 2024, he went 9-3 with a 3.56 ERA in 25 games (17 starts) between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond. He was promoted to the Eastern League on June 5, 2024 and made 15 Double-A starts, going 5-2 with a 4.08 ERA. After allowing four runs in 4.1 innings in his Double-A debut last June, Sinacola went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP) over his next five starts from June 12-July 4. Sinacola was selected in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine. **For more on Sinacola, see page three.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Jarod Bayless makes his eighth Double-A start of the season in Game 1. It is the first outing of his career against Richmond. Last time out, he threw 3.2 innings and allowed one run last Thursday against Erie. Bayless was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 33rd round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist University, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels infielder **Jimmy Glownke**. After being released by Seattle last August, he was signed by the Pirates in February.

Right-hander Po-Yu Chen makes his 13th start of the season for the Curve and the fifth of his career against the Flying Squirrels in Game 2. Last time out, he threw 4.2 innings and allowed one run with six strikeouts but tied a season high with five walks in a no-decision against the SeaWolves on Friday. In his four previous starts against Richmond, Chen has combined to go 1-1 with a 2.95 ERA (7 ER/21.1 IP) with 22 strikeouts and four walks. Chen signed with the Pirates as an international free agent in 2020. He is in his second season with Altoona.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey**, **Zach Morgan** and **Onil Perez** have combined to catch 35 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 23 runners caught stealing. Morgan, now with Triple-A Sacramento, is tied for fifth in the Eastern League with 12.

BERI'S BACK: Outfielder/first baseman **Victor Bericoto** returned to the Richmond roster on June 3. He was placed on the injured list with Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 and played six games with the ACL Giants on a rehab assignment before returning to the Flying Squirrels. Bericoto opened the season with Richmond and hits .319 with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs in 13 games before being promoted to the River Cats on April 20. In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Bericoto has homered 26 times, which is the eighth-most in franchise history, one behind a four-way tie for fourth place (**Devin Harris**, **Sean Roby**, **Shane Matheny** and **Will Wilson**).

TAKING THE JAIRO: Jairo Pomares has picked up at least one hit in 11-of-his-last-14 games dating back to May 29, batting .353 (18-for-51) with two homers, two doubles, seven RBIs and four walks, raising his season batting average from .185 to .225. That stretch includes five multi-hit games. He hit a solo homer on June 11 at Erie, his first since May 2, snapping a 25-game homerless streak. He went deep again June 8. Pomares is tied for the team lead with 22 RBIs this season.

YO ADRIAN: Adrian Sugastey has picked up eight RBIs over his last seven games dating back to June 8. In the series finale at Erie on June 8, he went 3-for-5 with a homer, two doubles and a career-best five RBIs. Last Tuesday, he drove in the Flying Squirrels' only run with a single. In last Wednesday's win, he belted his sixth homer of the year, a solo shot in the fourth, to set a new single-season career high.

NIGHT AT THE ROXBY: Reliever **Braxton Roxby** closed his second save of the season last Wednesday night, recording two outs in the eighth to strand two inherited baserunners before a 1-2-3 ninth. He followed with two scoreless relief innings in the ninth and 10th on Sunday afternoon before play was stopped and tossed a scoreless eighth in Altoona on Wednesday. Dating back to April 29, Roxby has pitched 13 consecutive games without allowing an earned run, spanning 18 innings with 23 strikeouts and four walks. The only two runs he has surrendered in that stretch were a pair of unearned runs in the 10th inning on May 27 against the Senators.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is fifth in hits (63), eighth in batting average (.288) and ninth in OBP (.379). **Seth Lonsway** is tied for sixth in innings pitched (61.0), 10th in ERA (3.25). **Jack Choate** is sixth in strikeouts (65) and 10th in BAA (.236). **John Michael Bertrand** is tied for third in innings pitched (66.0).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 221 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 5), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 10), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 21) and **Jack Choate** (No. 26). **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. **Adrian Sugastey** is ranked as the top defensive catcher. **Aeverson Arteaga** is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).
