LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies shutout the Hartford Yard Goats, 5-0, on Saturday at Dunkin' Park to sweep the three-games in Luis Moreno, Cam Robinson, Trey McLoughlin, and Paul Gervase combined to spin the Ponies' fifth shutout of the season. Matt Rudick and Wyatt Young both drove in two runs. Ryan Clifford reached base four times.

JT SMODVE: First baseman JT Schwartz has been on a tear. Schwartz is riding an 18-game on-base streak, dating back to June 12, and he's slashing .403/.474/.522/.996 with one home run, eight runs batted in, and 10 runs scored in that span. Schwartz is also riding a 22-game on-base streak, dating back to June 8, and he's slashing .368/.455/.513/.968 with two home runs, nine runs batted in, 11 runs scored, and more walks (12) than strike-outs (8). The 24-year-old went 9-for-24 (.375) with five RBIs in six games against Hartford last week. Schwartz ranks among Eastern League hitters: 2nd in OBP (.409), 6th in AVG (.296), T-6th in BB (38), and 7th in OPS (.822).

**CLIFFORD CRUSH:** Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 71 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** went 2-for-3 with a double, two walks, and a run on Saturday. Clifford has now reached base in 31 of his last 33 games and in 36 of his last 39 games. Clifford is riding an eight-game hit streak, slashing .406/.457/.688/1.145 with two home runs, five runs batted in, seven runs scored, and three doubles. In six games in July, the 20-year-old is 11-for-28 (.440 AVG) with one home run and four runs batted in. Clifford is tied for the second-most walks (65) in Minor League Baseball.

**NO SLEEP TILL BROOKLYN:** Brooklyn native **Jaylen Palmer** singled and scored, as part of the Ponies' ninth-inning comeback on Friday. Palmer is riding a four-game hit streak, hitting .429 (6-for-14) with three doubles, one RBI, and six runs scored. Palmer was drafted by the Mets in 2018 out of Holy Cross High School in Flushing, which is about five miles from Citi Field.

**STAN THE MAN:** Outfielder **Stanley Consuegra** hit a game-tying two-run single in the ninth inning on Friday and doubled on Saturday. He is riding a four-game hit streak with five hits, three doubles, three runs batted in, and four runs scored in that span. He made his Double-A debut on June 25 and has played in nine games. He has six hits and three doubles in Double-A. At the time of Consuegra's promotion, he was the High-A Brooklyn Cyclones franchise leader in games played, home runs, RBIs, hits, doubles, and XBHs.

**FOREVER YOUNG:** INF **Wyatt Young** has had multiple hits and multiple RBIs in both of his last two games. Young is batting .500 (5-for-10) with a .583 OBP, four runs batted in, and two runs scored over his three-game hit streak.

**STEADY STUART:** Mets No. 18 prospect **Tyler Stuart** is slated to make his 15th start of the year for the Ponies tonight. Stuart recorded eight strikeouts over 5.2 perfect innings and took a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his last start. He struck out 11 batters over six no-hit frames, before allowing a pair of runs in the seventh inning against Hartford on Monday. Stuart returns to Delta Dental Stadium, where he struck out a career-high 12 batters over six innings, while allowing just one run on four hits and one walk on April 25.

He began his start with eight strikeouts over five perfect innings and 11 strikeouts over six no-hit innings....With two outs in the sixth, Stuart allowed his first base runner of the game after walking Ronaiker Palma...Ryan Ritter's leadoff double in the seventh broke up the no-hit bid.

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a Binghamton franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca). Brignac also was the Mets' representative on the Arizona Fall League coaching staff after that season, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas.

-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

YEAR WITH BNG: 2nd YEAR WITH NYM: 3rd -AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.

He is a two-time World Series champion ('90 Reds and '96 Yankees), one-time All-Star (with Philadelphia in 1994), and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008. He made his MLB debut for the Dodgers on April 9, 1975, at the age of 22. Duncan finished third for the National League Rookie of the Year.


