Steven Wright: Right-hander Steven Wright makes his first start since 6/16/19 tonight vs. Toledo. He was signed by Pittsburgh in March as a minor league free agent after not playing in 2020.

Last Outing: Wright pitched two relief innings at lowa on 5/9 and surrendered one run (unearned) on one hit and two walks. He also struck out four batters in the outing.

Against the Mud Hens: Wright has faced Toledo five times in his career dating back to 2010. He is 1-1 in those games (three starts) with a 3.43 ERA (8er/21.0ip), 15 hits allowed, 14 walks and 21 strikeouts. His last appearance vs. Toledo came on 6/25/13.
