

WELCOME BACK, WELCOME BACK: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats, three-time Eastern League **2023 AT A GLANCE** Champions, begin their 19th season tonight against the Altoona Curve at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The Fisher Home 0-0 Road 0-0 Cats will play a 138-game season, with 108 games against Eastern League Northeast opponents and 30 games Day (Before 6pm) 0-0 against Eastern League Southwest opponents. The Fisher Cats will play the Altoona Curve six total times with Night (After 6pm) 0-0 the next meeting from July 14-16 at Delta Dental Stadium. The roster is made up of 16 pitchers, four catchers, seven infielders and five outfielders. Players come from 14 different states and Last 5 Games 0-0 six countries outside of the United States (Dominican Republic, Venezuela, Mexico, Panama, Puerto Rico Last 10 Games 0-0 Netherlands). Long. Win Streak Long. Losing Streak CESAR MARTIN LEADS FIELD STAFF: Manager Cesar Martin (SAY-zar Mar-TEEN) will lead the Fisher Cats 0-0 for a third straight season. Pitching coach Drew Haves and hitting coach Mitch Huckabay enter their first season April 0-0 May in New Hampshire while position coach Chris Schaeffer returns for his third season in Manchester. Last year, June 0-0 the Fisher Cats hit a team record 166 home runs in 2022. 0-0 July 0-0 August GOOD TO SEE YA AGAIN: Opening Day starter RHP Sem Robberse is one of 14 returning pitchers for the September 0-0 Fisher Cats. Robberse had a 3.65 ERA in five starts with New Hampshire and threw 24.2 innings and struck out 19. RHP Alejandro Melean is scheduled to pitch after Robberse. He made eight starts for the Fisher Cats, Lead after 6 0-0 pitching 30 innings and striking out 24 across a 5.10 ERA. The Fisher Cats will start Paxton Schultz against the Curve tomorrow. Schultz led the Fisher Cats with 20 starts in 2023, compiling a 7-6 record. He also led the team with 99 strikeouts.

The 25-year old RHP was originally drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 14th round of the 2019 draft out of Utah Valley. Blue Jays acquired Schultz from the Brewers prior to the 2021 season – this is his third in the Toronto organization.
