### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils continue the first series of the second half of the season at Richmond. It is the fourth-of-six games against the Flying Squirrels this season and the fourth of six games at The Diamond, the final six games Reading will ever play at The Diamond. Richmond captured the 2024 series over Reading 5-1. The Flying Squirrels don't return to Reading this season and have not played at FirstEnergy Stadium since June 28-July 3, of the 2023 season.

### Game 70 Recap

The Fightin Phils pitching led them to a 1-0 shutout win over Richmond on Thursday night. Reading's only run came on a solo home run from Hendry Mendez in the top of the third inning. Koyo Aoyagi made his first start with Reading, and he did not allow a run or hit over four innings of work, despite issuing four walks. Mitch Neunborn followed with four-scoreless frames, on two hits with five strikeouts, while earning his third win. Andrew Walling struck out two in a scoreless ninth inning to earn his fourth save and secure the second win of the week for the Fightin Phils.

### Shutting Them Down

Reading's pitching staff turned in its second shutout of the season on Thursday night. The last shutout came May 27 against Erie, when Reading also won 1-0. Mitch Neunborn also pitched in that shutout win for the Fightin Phils, tossing three-scoreless innings. The Fightin Phils turned in 10 shutout wins in 2024, but have only tossed two so far this season. A big help in the shutout win was Richmond hit into four double plays on Thursday night. The R-Phils entered the night last in the league in double plays turned, and after flipping four on Thursday, now sit tied for eighth in the league in the category.

### Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas continued his recent surge with a two-run home run on Wednesday. Since June 10 (13 games), Binelas is slashing .386/.442/.750 (1.192 OPS). He's added 11 runs, four doubles, four home runs and 15 RBI. In June, Binelas holds the following Eastern League ranks: 8th AVG (.316), T-7th RBI (15), 5th SLG (.614) and 6th OPS (1.011).

### Welcome to Baseballtown, Koyo

Koyo Aoyagi made his Reading debut on Thursday night. The 31-year old started and did not allow a run or hit over four innings. He did issue four walks, but was aided by inducing multiple double plays on the night. Aoyagi signed with the Phillies in January out of Japan and has been with Lehigh Valley (AAA) since the start of the season. His four innings of work on Thursday night were a season high. 2025 is his first season pitching in the United States as Aoyagi has played in Japan from 2016-24.

### King of the Hill

Chuck King is slated to make the start on Friday night for the Fightin Phils. King is in the midst of his best stretch of the season, as he's picked up back-to-back wins, while tossing quality starts over his last two outings. King did not start in his pro career prior to this season, and he's turned into a workhorse in the R-Phils rotation. The 27-year old has tossed five-plus innings in his last six starts, and seven of his last eight. He's also gone six innings in back-to-back starts, along with four of his last six starts on the mound. King enters play tonight ranked 12th in the Eastern League in innings pitched (62.1), but since May 22 (six starts) King ranks third in the league in innings pitched (34.0).

### Hendry Making History

It is believed that Hendry Mendez hit for the first cycle in R-Phils history last Friday night. Mendez had four hits, three runs and three RBI. He hit a triple in his first at bat, then singled his next time up. Mendez then launched his fifth home run of the season in the sixth inning. Then, Mendez stepped up in the bottom of the eighth a double shy of the cycle, and he lined a 3-1 pitch to right-center field and stopped at second base to complete the historic feat. Dating back to 2005 (as far back as MLB's research tool keeps MiLB stats), no R-Phil has hit a cycle. Records prior to 2005 show no prior cycles were ever hit by an R-Phil, but data is incomplete. But, it is believed that Mendez now holds the distinction of the first cycle in R-Phils history, dating back to 1967.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 27, 2016:** At Reading, Jake Fox swats a walk-off solo HR in the 9th to give the Fightin Phils an 8-7 win over Erie. Dylan Cozens hits his 20th homer to tie Rhys Hoskins for the league lead and ends up going 2-for-4 with 4 RBIs and 2 runs scored.

### Rolling into Richmond

Richmond finished the first half of the season with an Eastern League-worst 21-46 record. The Flying Squirrels took four-of-five games at Altoona last week in the Trey Wilson bowl to finish the half. Following this week, Richmond remains home and hosts Chesapeake for three games before hitting the road to continue the series with the Baysox. Richmond's roster features five of the Giants' top-30 prospects: Joe Whitman (6), Diego Velasquez (15), Aeverson Arteaga (16), Sabin Ceballos (23) and Jack Choate (27).

### Squirrel on the Bump

Lefty, and Giants No. 6 prospect, Joe Whitman makes the start tonight for Richmond. This season, Whitman is 2-7, with a 5.56 ERA (35 ER, 56.2 IP). Whitman has struck out 62 batters over 56.2 innings pitched (9.85 SO/9.0 IP). At Altoona last Saturday, Whitman suffered the loss, allowing one run on two hits over 3.2 innings, but did issue four walks. He's suffered losses in back-to-back starts, along with three-of-four appearances. Whitman split 2024 between San Jose (A) and Eugene (A+), combining to go 3-8, with a 4.63 ERA. He began his pro career in 2023 between the ACL-Giants (ROK) and San Jose. The 23-year old was drafted by the Giants in the 2C round of the 2023 draft out of Kent State. Whitman pitched at Purdue in 2021-22 and then Kent State in 2023.

**LAST OUTING:** 6/21 vs HFD: W, 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 SO, 78 pitches (52 strikes)... Reading beat Hartford, 12-2, at FirstEnergy Stadium. King turned in his sixth-straight outing over five innings, as he proves to be a reliable arm in Reading's rotation. For the second-straight start, King earned a win, while spinning a quality start (6.0 IP, 2 ER). He matched a season-high with six innings, which was the fourth time in the last six outings King has gone six innings. He was efficient too, throwing 78 pitches and 52 of them for strikes (67%). He allowed a run each in the second and fifth innings, but managed to post zeroes in the other four innings he threw on the night. King was relieved by Daniel Harper in the top of the seventh inning.

### 2025 Season:

- After not starting, nor pitching more than 2.0 IP in a game prior to this season, King has started 11-of-13 games this season and has gone over two innings in each outing
- First win of season came on Apr. 13 at Somerset when he pitched in relief (3.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 5 SO)
- Tossed a season and career-high six innings twice in back-to-back starts: May 22 at Portland and May 29 vs Erie
- On May 22 at Portland: 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 3 SO
- Allowed a season and career-high 11 hits May 29 vs Erie over six innings
- Has allowed a career-high three home runs three times this season: May 2 vs HBG, May 17 vs NH and May 29 vs ERI
- Went five-shutout innings Apr. 24 at Portland
- Issued a career-high three walks June 9 at Harrisburg
- Struck out a season/career-high five batters four times this season, including back-to-back starts on June 3 & 8 at Harrisburg
- Earned second win of season, while matching season-high with six innings and five strikeouts on June 14 vs New Hampshire
- Spun second-straight quality start, winning second-consecutive game June 21 vs Hartford (6 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, BB, 3 SO)
- Has gone 5+ innings in his last six starts and seven of his last eight starts on the mound
- Over seven away games, has a 3.00 ERA (11 ER, 33.0 IP), which is compared to a 7.06 ERA (23 ER, 29.1 IP) over six home contests; also 12-of-14 home runs have been allowed at home
- Posted a 3.60 ERA (6 ER, 15.0 IP) in four April outings and a 7.11 ERA (20 ER, 25.1 IP) across five May appearances (all starts); has a 3.27 ERA (8 ER, 22.0 IP) over four June starts
- With RISP, opposing hitters slashing .164/.169/.239 (.408 OPS)
- Has allowed the most home runs (14) of any pitcher in the Eastern League, leading second place by five home runs
- Ranks 12th in the Eastern League in innings pitched (62.1); since May 22 (six starts), he is third in the league in IP (34.0)
